4. Whether Mr. Clinton may file more than one motion to dismiss under Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 12(b)(6) without answering the Complaint.







MOTION BY UNITED STATES AS AMICUS CURIAE
FOR LEAVE TO EXCEED PAGE LIMIT

The United States of America hereby moves for leave to file an amicus brief in excess of the 20-page limit imposed by Eighth Circuit Rule 29A. This case presents important issues regarding the amenability of the President of the United States to suit, during his term of office, based on private claims arising prior to his Presidency. Because of the public significance of these issues, the United States participated as amicus curiae in the district court, and intends to do so again in this Court. The United States does not believe that the issues can be addressed adequately within the page limit established by Rule 29A. The United States therefore seeks leave to file an amicus brief in excess of the page limit, but no longer than 30 pages. The grounds for this motion are as follows:

3-20-95

1. This is a private action for damages by a former Arkansas state employee, Paula Jones, against President William Clinton and an Arkansas state trooper. Jones's principal claim is that in May 1991, the President, at that time the Governor of Arkansas, sexually harassed her. The plaintiff filed suit in May 1994, three years after the alleged harassment and over one year after the President assumed his current office.

2. The President, represented by private counsel, moved to dismiss the suit without prejudice, on the ground that Presidents are immune from suit during their terms of office for private claims arising before their Presidencies. Because the United States has an important interest in protecting the office of the President, and ensuring the President's unencumbered ability to discharge his constitutional duties under Article II, the United States filed a statement of interest under 28 U.S.C. § 517 addressing the issues raised by the President's motion. The United States agreed that this suit should not be allowed to go forward during the President's term of office, but suggested that a stay of proceedings, rather than dismissal without prejudice, was the most appropriate remedy.

3. In December 1994, the district court denied the motion to dismiss and granted a partial stay, deferring trial proceedings until after the President leaves office but permitting pretrial discovery to go forward immediately. The President and Jones have filed cross-appeals from the district court's order. The President's opening brief is due on April 5, 1995.

4. The United States intends to file an amicus brief in this Court addressing the issues raised by the pending cross-appeals. The brief for the United States will address the general legal principles governing private suits against sitting Presidents for "pre-Presidential" conduct, and will also discuss the application of those principles to the circumstances of this case. In connection with this discussion, the United States will address the reasoning behind the district court's decision to enter a partial, rather than full, stay of proceedings.

5. In light of the nature and importance of the issues in this case, the United States does not believe that it can adequately present its views to this Court within the 20-page limit set by Rule 29A. In the proceedings below, the United States filed a 24-page brief addressing the legal issues raised by the President's motion to dismiss. In this Court, the United States' brief must take on the added task of addressing the district court's reasoning, which does not coincide fully with the views expressed by any of the litigants below. Although the United States will present its views as concisely as possible, it does not believe that it can do justice to the legal issues, which are ones of first impression in this Court, within the confines of a 20-page brief.

6. For these reasons, the United States seeks leave to file an amicus brief in excess of Rule 29A's page limit. Specifically, the United States seeks leave to file a 30-page amicus brief. The additional 10 pages requested by the United States will ensure that this Court receives the benefit of a full discussion of the issues, without materially increasing the total volume of briefing in this case.
