SUBJECT: LEGISLATIVE REPORT

Yesterday, the Balanced Budget Amendment (BBA) was introduced in the

Senate as

S.J.Res. 1, with 62 sponsors -- all 55 Senate Republicans, plus Democrats Baucus, Breaux, Bryan, Graham, Kohl, Moseley-Braun, and Robb. The Amendment does not include the Nunn language from last year, which retained Congress's authority to determine the extent that courts can get involved in enforcement. Lott's likely intention is to add the Nunn language on the Floor if it is required to lock down a vote. The language of S.J.Res. 1 is identical to the House resolution.

Also on Tuesday, the Senate passed H.J.Res 25, Technical Amendments to the Omnibus Appropriations Act, by Unanimous Consent. In addition, Senators Murkowski and Craig reintroduced the Yucca Mountain Nuclear Waste legislation.

Hearings:

Today, the Senate Judiciary Committee held their second hearing on the Balanced Budget Constitutional Amendment. Witnesses included Senators Craig, Conrad, Dorgan, Lautenberg, Bryan, and Graham, former Senator Paul Simon, and former AARP President Gene Lehrman.

Tomorrow, Jack Lew will testify before the Senate Budget Committee on the Administration's Medicare Plan.

S. 3: The Omnibus Crime Control Act of 1997

Transfer of Alien Prisoners: Requires renegotiation of treaties so consent of alien to be transferred back to country of origin is not necessary. Requires withholding of foreign aid and visas for countries that refuse to accept their nationals or sufficiently incarcerate them.

Exclusionary Rule Reform: Evidence obtained by “objectively reasonable” search or seizure shall not be excluded under the fourth amendment in federal court cases.

Violent Crime, Drugs and Terrorism

- Criminal Penalties and Procedures: Provides special protection for Olympic Games. Mandatory minimum penalties for crimes committed with explosives. Criminal forfeiture for chemical weapons violations.
- International Terrorism: Revision to State Department Rewards Program for informants on international terrorism and drug trafficking cases.
- Commission and Studies: Establishment of National Commission on Terrorism.

Community Protections

- Law Enforcement Assistance: Exemption for current and former police from state laws prohibiting carrying concealed firearms.
- Citizens’ Assistance: Authorizes states to enter into compacts to enable individuals to carry concealed weapons. Permits federal grant \$ to be used for firearms training and education to the public.

Criminal Procedure Improvements

- Equal Protection for Victims: Amends federal rules of criminal procedure and evidence on trial procedures to assist prosecutors and victims.
- Firearms: Mandatory minimum sentences for criminals possessing firearms. Mandatory death penalty for repeat violators of international drug trafficking laws.
- Federal Death Penalty: Adds aggravating factors in determination of death penalty sentence. Establishes death penalty in District of Columbia.

Increased Penalties for Trafficking and Manufacture of Methamphetamine and Precursors

Violence Against Women and Children: Makes religious organizations eligible for VAWA grants. Establishes death penalty for fatal interstate domestic violence cases. Provides for HIV testing of defendants in sexual assault cases.

Violent Crime and Terrorism: Expands coverage of antiterrorism statutes and increases penalties.

Prison Reform:

- Prison Litigation Reform: Makes more difficult to remedy prison conditions.

- Federal Prisons: Prohibits certain prisoner amenities. Requires prisoners to work.

Violent and Repeat Juvenile Offenders

- Juvenile Justice Reform: Treatment of juveniles age 14 and older as adults for violent crimes and drug crimes (prosecutor discretion) in federal court. Expands availability of juvenile records, fingerprints and photographs.
- Juvenile Gangs: Provides \$100 million for hiring of U.S. Attorneys and attorneys in Justice Department to prosecute juvenile gangs. Creates federal penalty with mandatory minimums for solicitation or recruitment of criminal gang activity. Increases sentencing guidelines for participation in crime as gang member.
- Juvenile Crime Control and Accountability: Revokes OJJDP and creates Office of Juvenile Crime Control and Accountability. Establishes state incentive block grants (\$3.25 billion/5 years) to encourage: use of graduated sanctions, hiring of prosecutors and police to control juvenile crime, curfews, and prosecution of juveniles as adults.

Miscellaneous:

- Schedule I Drugs: Requires Attorney General to promulgate rules to revoke DEA license of physicians prescribing a Schedule I drugs.
- Anti-drug Use Public Service Requirement: FCC to encourage priority use of public service resources to promote youth drug abuse prevention and education.
- Child Porn: Secretary of State required to review all extradition treaties to ensure offenses involving child pornography is are extraditable offenses.
- 2,000 Boys and Girls Clubs Before 2000: Authorizes resources for 1,000 new clubs.
- Cellular Telephone Interceptions: Adds penalty of imprisonment of up to 1 year.

Education Issues

Q. Last week in Chicago you called for national standards in education. You said they should be national, but not federal. Why do we need them, and, if the federal government shouldn't establish them, how do you propose to create them?

? I am convinced that we need national standards for what students should learn because every student, every parent, every teacher and every school must know what is expected of them, and must be able to measure their progress against these standards. While I believe in local control of education -- and we have local control right now -- there must be common expectations for students throughout the country. Algebra ought to be the same no matter where it is taught.

? I will be talking in greater detail over the coming weeks and months about how we can accomplish this, and how the federal government can help states and local school systems carry out their responsibilities for determining what should be taught.

? Let me say now though that there is much available that we can use right now. The National Council of Teachers of Mathematics have developed widely accepted standards for math. There are similar standards for science. And last week Secretary Riley and I announced that an international test in math and science -- one which shows clearly what world class achievement levels are -- will be available for local school systems and states to use. This will enable them to tell clearly if their students are performing at high levels, and, more importantly, if they have a curriculum in place that can help students reach these high standards. I urge as many school districts and states as

possible to take advantage of this unique possibility.

Q. Last week you announced that students in some wealthy suburban Chicago communities scored very high on an international test in math and science, called for national standards, and urged other school systems to test their students in the same way. Don't we know already that students in low income communities will score much lower than the rich students? If all students are held to these same high standards, what will you do to make sure that low income students in our cities, who don't have the advantages that those suburban students have, can do well on the test?

? First, let me say that the point of giving this international test to more students, including those in our urban systems, is not to see who wins and who loses. It is to make sure that the people leading those systems, and who send their students to those schools or who teach in them, have an honest assessment of how well they do compared to tough international standards.

? Let me also say that I firmly believe that every child in America, no matter what their family circumstances and even if they live in our poorest rural areas or cities, can learn to these world class standards. You just need to think of all those students in inner city Los Angeles that Hymie Escalante -- the subject of the movie Stand and Deliver

-helped to take and pass Advanced Placement courses in Calculus when most people didn't even think they could learn algebra, to realize that we can set and meet high expectations for all of our students.

? What we have learned from these tests is that the countries that outperform us do so because of what happens in the classroom, much more than what happens outside of it. They have high expectations for their students. They have a challenging curriculum, that is focused on a few topics each year. They teach in depth, so that students really understand the material. There is no reason in the world that we can't do that in every school in this country, no matter where it is.

? Finally, while education is a local and state responsibility, the federal government can and will help. That is why I have fought so hard for funding for programs like Head Start and the Title 1 program that helps disadvantaged students, and Goals 2000 that helps set high

standards.



Patsy Fleming asked me to send you the following regarding the NGA resolutions.

38.1 -- Concur.

38.2 -- Bottom of p. 43 alludes to but does not explicitly discuss concerns about mandatory testing. Administration's position has been that routine voluntary testing is preferred.

38.2.1 - Concur. I checked with ONDCP regarding treatment levels -- the FY 98 budget requests an increase for treatment. In FY 97 CDC funding for outreach to substance abusers was increased -- the FY98 budget also proposes an increase in outreach.

38.2.2 -- The language refers to the Coburn Amendment. The Administration did not

take a position on the amendment but rather supports the PHS guidelines that call for routine and voluntary testing for women as the best way to reduce perinatal transmission. The issue raised (paragraph 1, p. 45) about mandatory testing possibly discouraging women from seeking health care is legitimate. The concern about low incidence states being able to meet the 50% percent required reduction is also valid (paragraph 3, p. 45).

38.3 -- Concur. The expressed support for research and public-private partnerships in this section is in concert with the themes of the National AIDS Strategy.

38.4 -- Concur with concerns regarding cost of care.

The Administration has made significant efforts to address the health care needs of persons living with HIV/AIDS. Overall funding for the Ryan White CARE Act (RWCA) has increased by 158% since 1993. In the proposed FY98 budget, the RWCA titles are slated to receive a \$40 million increase.

In the last year, in close coordination with State AIDS Directors, the Administration increased ADAP funding threefold - from \$52 million in FY 96 to \$167 million in FY 97. Also in the past year, the Administration submitted two budget amendments to increase specific funding for ADAP (one for \$52 million and one for \$65 million). In the FY98 budget, Title II (which includes ADAP) is slated to receive a \$15 million increase -- States will have the option to use this money on ADAP.

Also, it is now standard operating procedure that all Medicaid managed care waiver applications are examined for their impact on people living with HIV if people with disabilities are included in the waiver.

38.5 -- Concur with NGA interest in working together in implementing new provisions of the RWCA. Administration has strongly supported RWCA and secured significant increases for all Titles, including ADAP. (See above.)

To ensure the most effective use of ADAP resources several efforts are underway:

- HRSA is working with states to ensure appropriate use of ADAP funds;
- PHS is working on developing treatment guidelines on the most effective use of these therapies; and
- Through the Forum for Collaborative HIV Research (an initiative

catalyzed through the Vice President's Office) government, industry, patients, and third-party payors are designing studies to assess the clinical effectiveness of these therapies.
