.Background Q&A on Minimum Wage

Q: Won't it be a great burden for the states if you require them to pay welfare recipients the minimum wage?

A. There has already been an enormous amount of welfare reform innovation taking place in the states, whether through demonstration waivers or workfare programs, and many states have already addressed this issue as part of those programs. In most instances where it has come up, states have made the decision to pay the minimum wage. We have no reason to believe they would change course on this issue.

It is difficult to generalize about how states would be affected, because we don't know how individual states will choose to spend their new TANF block grant money, or how much the already shrinking caseload in individual states will reduce the number of people they must put to work.

However, paying the minimum wage should not be a problem in most states. This is particularly true in the next year or two, as the requirements of the law are still being phased in.

We held an initial meeting of our new legal immigrant strategy group today, with HHS, SSA, USDA, INS, OMB, and intergovernmental in attendance. We stressed to the agencies that we need their commitment and cooperation, and for them to take ownership of the issue.

Today we focused on organizing the agencies to work together to produce good paper, particularly Q&A that responds to criticisms of our proposals. Agencies will do initial drafts by tomorrow, and we will meet as a group again early next week to look at the product.

We decided to have a meeting the week after next with immigration, health, and disability groups, to share this paper with them, get them energized, share ideas, and demonstrate our commitment on this issue. It may be helpful for you to make a brief appearance at such a meeting to help on this last point.

We also decided to reach out to the counties and cities. We hope to do some numbers on the impact by state/region so that these groups are better armed. The VP is apparently doing a NACO conference sometime soon. Emily doesn't think we can expect much from the Governors immediately.

We didn't get too far on legislative strategy yet, and will discuss that at our next meeting.

After the meeting, Ken and I talked about the "bucket" issue. What this would do is convert a chunk of the legislative fix into an admin fix. It would let more people who are losing SSI keep Medicaid, either temporarily or permanently. If we do this, it would make the remaining legislative package less compelling, but the administrative action itself would certainly be a positive move. (Although of course some advocates would be disappointed because it is not a total fix of the problem.)

I will keep you posted on next steps.

- **Gift ban.** In the 1995 State-of-the-Union Address, President Clinton challenged the Congress to ban gifts, meals, travel and entertainment from lobbyists. The Congress subsequently passed the ban on November 16th, 1995.
- Enacted the **Congressional Accountability Act** to ensure that the same laws apply to Congress as to the rest of America.
- **Closing the "lobbyist loophole."** In 1993, President Clinton proposed, and Congress passed, legislation ending the tax-deductibility of lobbying expenses, which had allowed corporations and others to deduct the cost of their lobbying.
- Imposed the **strictest Administration ethics guidelines** ever, including a five-year ban

on top officials lobbying their former agencies and a lifetime ban against lobbying for foreign governments.

- Enacted **line-item veto** legislation which significantly enhances the presidential authority to eliminate wasteful spending by allowing the President to cancel wasteful special interest projects and targeted tax breaks that benefit special interests. The line-item veto can help the President close the door on business as usual in Washington by ending breaks for special interests and cutting pet spending projects that sneak into the budget year after year. With this line-item veto, the President will have a valuable new tool to ensure that our public resources are being put to the best possible uses.
- Enacted the **Unfunded Mandates Reform Act** to restrict Congress from passing on new mandates to state and local governments without paying for them.
- **Special Interests.** President Clinton has stood up to special interests, such as the National Rifle Association and the tobacco industry, loosening their tight hold on our legislative process. The President broke six years of congressional gridlock and defeated the gun lobby by enacting a **ban on assault weapons** and the **Brady Law**.

A History Of Fighting For Real Campaign Finance Reform

- 1992** **Campaign Finance Reform Proposal.** In the 1992 campaign, Governor Clinton proposed spending limits, free TV time, PAC limits and a ban on soft money. The current McCain-Feingold and Shays-Meehan legislation mirrors this proposal.
- 1993-1994** **Campaign Finance Reform Plan.** The President and the congressional Democratic leadership proposed a reform plan that also included partial public funding for congressional candidates. Reform groups praised the President for his support of the plan. Unfortunately, the legislation was filibustered, despite passage in both chambers.
- 1995** **Bipartisan CFR Commission.** In June of 1995, the President agreed with Speaker Gingrich to create a bipartisan political reform commission. The President named John Gardner and Doris Kearns Goodwin to launch the commission, but they were rebuffed by the Speaker.
- 1996 - 1997** **McCain-Feingold/Shays-Meehan.** In the 1996 State-of-the-Union, the President announced his support of the bipartisan bill. He repeated his support throughout 1996. In the 1997 State of the Union Address the President challenged Congress to pass this legislation by July 4th, 1997. On January 11,

1997 the President met with the bipartisan co-sponsors of the House legislation (Shays-Meehan), reiterating his belief that delay will mean the death of reform.

We do not have a plan for helping DC meet our reading and math standards as far as I know, though I have not been in the middle of whatever DC discussions have been going on.

However, if we were smart we would at least be pushing for a DC reads initiative, that could be a model for the country. This would go well beyond announcing work-study tutors; it would include administering NAEP to individual kids; mobilizing a large number of reading tutors, especially federal employees in addition to college students and lawyers; creating an integrated, community-wide effort as in Boston Reads, which involves area universities (for expert help, not just tutors), hospital and pediatricians, employers, libraries, Head Start programs, etc., and, working with the schools to improve curriculum and professional development.

This is on my list of things to discuss with Carol today, assuming we have better luck connecting than in previous days.

I know that Mike Smith and Frank Raines have been working on a DC initiative--perhaps closely, perhaps not. However, DC has not come close to the top of the list of things I have to talk to, so they may be further along than I think.

I do not have much in the way of good news. Justice has concluded that many of the options that we discussed regarding pursuing campaign reform through FEC rulemaking are not available under existing law. This includes limits on foreign contributions as well as changes in FEC enforcement procedure.

As we discussed, however, it appears that we can attempt to limit some soft money expenditures by FEC rule change. Specifically we could petition the FEC to change its rules regarding the allocation of hard and soft money in covering shared state and federal expenditures. Unfortunately, the governing law would not appear to allow the FEC to completely eliminate the use of soft money for shared state/federal expenditures but we can seek rule changes to limit the role of soft money as much as is legally possible. For example, we might suggest that upwards of 80% - 90% percent of shared expenditures be covered by federal dollars.

There is also, of course, no obstacle to our appointing persons to the FEC who are committed to reform and challenging the Republicans to submit the names of persons who are equally committed. ,

TOBACCO: February 27th -- POTUS/VP event w/FDA Commissioner Kessler to mark the first effective date of FDA's tobacco regulation and Kessler's departure. Structure still under discussion.

HUMAN RADIATION EXPERIMENTS: March (?) -- release of Administration report, Building Public Trust: Actions to Respond to the Advisory Committee on Human Radiation Experiments, and signing of EO on classified human research. (If we don't do POTUS event, we should get the report out the door soon anyway).

Event would include Secretaries of HHS, DOE, and possibly DOD, Hazel O'Leary, Advisory Cmt Members, and a small number of stakeholders.

TRANSPORTATION SAFETY (reprise): March 7 DOT is supposed to deliver a report the President requested January 23 outlining a plan to increase the use of seatbelts nationwide. DOT is working with a coalition of industry and consumer types. Report will push for state primary seatbelt laws and greater enforcement of passenger restraint laws, and it may hold up North Carolina's enforcement program as a model. We could do an event with leading states and law enforcement types.

FDA RULE REQUIRING COMPANIES TO TEST SAFETY OF DRUGS IN KIDS (not ready yet): FDA is considering issuing a rule requiring that drugs be tested in kids for safety and efficacy before FDA approves them. Currently, 80% of drugs prescribed for kids have not been tested and approved explicitly for pediatric use and are therefore not "labeled" for pediatric use. As a result, doctors often don't know what doses are safe and whether the drug will be effective, and Medicaid does not always reimburse their use in kids. This is a big issue for the AIDS community and pediatric groups. I've been working with the VP and First Lady's offices to see what we can do short of regulation, but since incentive-based approaches have failed, FDA will recommend -- and the White House may support -- requiring pediatric tests. Drug companies will oppose, but have a hard case to make. I'll keep you posted. If we do it, it has great event potential. Fits perfectly with the kids EO Diane is working on, but is on a separate track.
