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GOAL: Health Care. Work toward achieving bipartisan consensus on and enactment of Medicare, Medicaid, health coverage expansion, and quality reforms. For Medicare, we aim toward strengthening the Medicare Trust Fund and enacting structural reform that will prepare for and / or address its long-term financing challenges. For Medicaid, our goal is to constrain costs while increasing flexibility to enable states to provide more cost-effective and responsive health benefits. In the area of health coverage expansion, we hope to cover an additional 5 million children and another 2 million adults through our health initiatives. And, for quality, we seek to find the balance of appropriate standards for quality that does not undermine our ability to constrain costs.

Objectives:

- Continue close coordination of policy development and strategy with HHS, Treasury, Labor and all relevant divisions within the White House (DPC, NEC, OMB, CEA, Legislative Affairs, Intergovernmental Affairs, Public Liaison, and Communications).
- Work toward enhancing bipartisan working relationship with the Congress, particularly with Members and staffs of the Budget, Finance, Ways and Means and Commerce Committees who have primary oversight over health care.
- Develop collaborative working relationships with governors on issues like coverage expansions, insurance reform, Medicaid reform in the budget, and 1115 waivers (usually used for coverage expansion) consistent with our overall health care agenda.
- Work with representatives of consumers, providers, insurers / health plans, and business and labor as well as academics, health economists and foundations to disseminate and validate the President's positions on health care.
- Work toward developing better relationships with the business community to find common ground in health care priorities.
- Identify opportunities for executive actions independent of legislation that further the President's health care agenda, particularly in relation to the quality and coverage initiatives.
- Continue refining and implementing communications strategy to highlight the President's accomplishments, educate the public on current proposals, and generate support for legislative and nonlegislative initiatives.

Subject: Brownfields Action Agenda

Before I left for NYC last week, I talked with Peter Robertson, chief of staff of EPA, regarding their action-agenda. As you are aware, the Administration currently has a three-pronged agenda regarding brownfields.

1. Tax Incentives -- the key component is the establishment of a new tax incentive (immediate expensing to cover the cost of the cleanup) to promote the cleanup and economic development of brownfields. Treasury and EPA are the leads on this legislative initiative.

2. Grants Program -- EPA and HUD are seeking the creation of a two new grant programs. One at EPA that would expand the existing site assessment program and the other at HUD, which would provide grants and loans for economic development at these sites.

3. Brownfields National Partnership -- This is EPA's 10 brownfield demonstration cities pilot. EPA is already funding \$125 million for site assessment, cleanup, and State voluntary cleanup programs. They have had good cooperation from HUD and Commerce, who are funding more than \$500 million for local economic redevelopment efforts. However EPA wants more assistance from some other agencies, particularly those departments who have concerns about liability or other issues. These include Justice, Transportation, SBA, OCC, and FDIC.

EPA would like for DPC to convene a principals meeting on Brownfields. The agenda items would include:

1. Timing of announcement of Action Agenda;
2. Asking agencies for additional cooperation. Particularly Justice, Transportation, SBA, OCC, and FDIC;

3. Discuss communications strategy.
4. Legislative Strategy on tax and grants program.

This Week's New Commitments to the Service Summit:

Below are the commitments to the Presidents' Summit on America's Future to be announced next week. The summit's organizers are providing this information to Jonathan Alter of Newsweek, and it may appear as part of their weekly "Commitment Watch."

Kiwanis International will involve 250,000 young people in more than 30 million hours of community service by the year 2000 through their sponsored youth clubs, Builders Clubs in junior high and middle schools, Key Clubs in high schools, and Circle K International in colleges and universities.

The submission to Newsweek notes that the President is the Key Club's most famous alumnus.

National Education Association retirees will train over 1,000 retired members to work in our public schools, will teach over 50,000 youth to read independently, and will involve over 100,000 young people in intergenerational and mentoring programs by the year 2001.

Utility Business Education Coalition (300 natural gas and electric company CEOs) will engage at least 1,500,000 young people in meaningful K-12 school-to-career experiences in model programs in a hundred communities by the year 2000.

Seventh Day Adventist Youth Service Network (or YouthNet) will pilot 100 tutoring and mentoring projects in ten cities that will place 3,000 trained volunteers in relationships with 10,000 children in the first year alone.

Michigan Nonprofit Association along with the Volunteer Centers of Michigan and Michigan Campus Compact higher education institutions will engage 50,000 young people in community problem solving through volunteerism over the next five years in the state of Michigan.

Federated Department Stores will be a catalyst for 50,000 hours of employee volunteer service in schools as tutors and mentors and will encourage employees' children and families to join them.

University of Notre Dame's Fighting Irish Retired Service Team (FIRST) and their 200 alumni clubs will reach over 150,000 children, youth, and families through intergenerational community service activities... and the Fighting Irish are challenging other alumni clubs to match their commitment.

Juvenile Justice

Q: *What does the Administration's juvenile justice proposal do?*

A: Last week, I sent my "Anti-Gang and Youth Violence Act of 1997" to Congress. My legislation is a comprehensive strategy to break the back of violent gangs, reduce youth violence, and provide our kids with positive alternatives to steer them away from gangs, guns, and drugs.

Among many other measures, the strategy provides critical resources for state and local prosecutors to target, prosecute, and convict violent youth gangs. It permits Federal prosecutors to prosecute juveniles in adult court when they commit certain violent crimes.

It also creates 1,000 afterschool initiatives to keep kids off the streets and give them positive alternatives. It will give communities the resources and support to establish youth curfews, anti-truancy efforts, create youth violence courts, and effective prevention initiatives.

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A: Yes. Police chiefs, sheriffs, and rank-and-file officers from across the country will tell you that the Clinton anti-crime agenda has made a difference in their efforts --- putting more cops on the streets, longer sentences for violent offenders, and taking guns out of the hands of dangerous criminals.

Local prosecutors also know we can help them. That is why the nation's primary and largest organization of prosecutors, the National District Attorneys Association, has enthusiastically endorsed my proposal to launch a massive attack on gangs and violent crimes by juveniles.

Q. During the campaign, you were able to neutralize the Republicans on the issue of crime -- an issue that they had traditionally dominated. Do you expect to continue to focus on this issue in this Administration and if so, in what respect?

A. I am very proud of our anti-crime record. We are past the midway point of funding 100,000 new police officers, and the Brady Bill has prevented over 186,000 felons, fugitives, and stalkers from buying handguns. For the first time since 1960, the violent crime has fallen five years in a row. We are moving in the right direction but we have a long way to go. That is why we are going to continue to put more police officers on our streets and take guns, drugs, and gangs off the streets. We are also going to continue our focus on youth violence. My

Anti-Gang and Youth Violence legislation, which I sent to Congress last week, will fulfill that mandate. My legislation is designed to keep kids drug-free, keep them away from guns and make the juvenile justice system tougher and smarter.

Q: *What are the bipartisan Congressional task force's chances for successfully enacting consensus juvenile justice reform legislation?*

I believe the chances are good. While there are some areas of initial disagreement, there are many more areas where the Congressional Democrats, the Congressional Republicans and our Administration are in agreement. I look forward to working closely with Congress to develop a comprehensive package that will make real progress in combating juvenile crime.

I have been working with DOJ and the American Bar Association to put together an initiative that would encourage lawyers, both public and private, to volunteer more time to providing legal help to legal immigrants. The ABA is very excited about this and the Attorney General pledged DOJ to do this. This is getting high-level attention on both sides as evidenced by the planning meeting that I participated in awhile ago that was hosted by Jamie and also attended by the ABA President-elect. The plan has been to have specifics put together for April, when the ABA President would unveil it. I wonder whether alternatively you would be interested in having the President unveil this as part of the Summit on volunteer service. (Or it could be done as a freestanding event.)

This initiative is consistent with the President's statements about wanting to protect legal immigrants from hardships under the new legislation; this would help legal immigrants work their way through the new rules and requirements of the welfare and immigration laws so that they better understand their situation and do not improperly lose access to services that they may be eligible for. It also advances the President's Executive Order on Civil Justice Reform (Sec. 2 Government Pro Bono and Volunteer Service). I think that this can be a very positive, productive initiative and a solid contribution to the summit or an event. This can be a good example of a meaningful public/private cooperative effort not based upon additional public funding requirements (with the potential for a sustained commitment and stories -- the ABA certainly wants to feature it in their conferences and publications).

So what do you think?

Subject Welfare to Work Outreach Strategy

This memo is a response to a Feb. 25 meeting between the Chief of Staff's Office, DPC, White House Counsel, Public Liaison, Intergovernmental Affairs, and HHS at which welfare to work outreach strategies were discussed. Following are decisions made about additional outreach steps, a summary of ongoing outreach efforts, and a suggested structure to create a more comprehensive and coordinated outreach and communications effort.

Outreach Decisions

The following decisions were made at the 2/25 meeting. Outreach and external coordination will be focused on four key groups: state governments and their social service offices; the business community; the nonprofit sector; and the faith communities. Outreach efforts will include but will not be limited to recruiting nonprofits, businesses, and religious organizations to the effort, building comprehensive lists of those committed, creating a referral network for individuals and organizations to relevant programs, assisting businesses and other entities with welfare to work programs, and preparing written material to educate states, nonprofits, business, and faith organizations about best practices on welfare to work.

A main vehicle for outreach will be to establish four private spokes people -- one for each of the outreach areas -- who will carry the Administration's welfare to work message to state governments, and the business, nonprofit and religious communities.

However, counsel has written that it will be legally difficult to recruit individuals to volunteer as spokes people for the welfare to work effort. Counsel says that there is no problem discussing issues with private individuals and indicating that we would like them to work on particular matters. However, we cannot direct a private person's activity and we must be careful not to give that person the impression that she holds an official position or that her activities are government sanctioned, or that she is acting on behalf of the White House.

Outreach Efforts To Date

Several outreach activities have been ongoing since the passage of the welfare law. Following is a summary of those ongoing activities.

- You are traveling to various state legislatures to challenge legislators to make welfare reform a success, and you are offering the legislators examples of what is working in other states and communities. HHS is currently putting together a suggested list of other states you might visit.
- You have met with and talked to 14 CEOs interested in becoming involved in the welfare to work effort, many of whom are also working with Eli Segal, the NGA, and the National Alliance of Business (NAB). You announced five of these CEOs during your State of the Union address. Additionally, the Office of Public Liaison and the DPC are building a list of more corporations interested in becoming involved. Presently, the list tops 100 and is growing. We are sharing this list with Eli Segal and others.
- You and Mrs. Clinton have met with religious leaders both at the White House Prayer Breakfast and at the Congressional Prayer breakfast, both times challenging the faith community to help with the welfare to work effort. The Office of Public Liaison is currently coordinating a broader outreach effort to all faith-based institutions.
- Public Liaison has held several briefings for organizations interested in welfare to work and will continue to do so.
- The Department of Health and Human Services has consistently provided technical assistance and guidance to states as they implement their welfare to work plans.

Also key to our outreach will be to connect with and build on newly emerging welfare to work efforts. Following are private outreach efforts underway.

- Eli Segal's Work Now (WN) will soon be established as a 501 (c)(3) organization whose mission will be to help businesses of all kinds move people permanently from welfare to work. WN's customers will be the businesses themselves, rather than welfare recipients, legislatures, Governors, or state welfare agencies. WN will encourage, mobilize, reward, and provide technical assistance to large and small companies and a broad range of so-called intermediaries that act as job placement and retention organizations.
- The NGA is beginning a process that connects Governors with private sector employers interested in hiring welfare recipients. In addition, the NGA will be collecting model programs and best practices for distribution in states. (White House Intergovernmental Affairs recently facilitated a meeting between Eli Segal and the NGA to discuss the welfare to work initiatives of both entities and possible areas of collaboration.)
- The National Alliance of Business (NAB), a Washington, DC-based business supported and led organization that helps companies with workforce development, is beginning its welfare to work initiative. NAB hopes its initiative will make employers involvement in the welfare to work effort more effective.

Coordinating the Outreach Strategy

Though outreach efforts are underway within the Administration and through private nonprofit organizations, both the outreach efforts and the welfare to work message are fragmented and lack coordination. We believe we should build upon existing and new outreach efforts to create a coordinated and comprehensive outreach and communications strategy. Following is a brief outline of what such a strategy might look like.

The following three-part plan should be run by the White House -- specifically the DPC, Office of Public Liaison, Communications, and Intergovernmental Affairs -- and is designed to ensure that the work provisions of the new welfare law are successfully implemented.

- Interagency Coordination. Coordinate all intergovernmental efforts related to welfare to work, particularly those ongoing at HHS, Labor, HUD, and the Departments of Commerce and Transportation, through regular meetings and conference calls with a designated group. With the help of the involved agencies, catalogue all welfare to work related activities ongoing at the agencies into one central document and regularly update that document.
- Outreach. Through outreach, build a comprehensive list of state legislators, nonprofit organizations, businesses, and faith organizations interested in becoming involved in the welfare to work effort who *we* need to educate. At the same time, build a list of those states, legislators, and private organizations with good programs in place to whom we can refer others.
- Communications. Discover, disseminate, and celebrate model public and private welfare to work efforts and existing Federal government programs that will help states, nonprofits, businesses, and religious organizations structure successful welfare to work programs. Disseminate information through written materials, public liaison briefings, the World Wide Web, and a speakers bureau made up of representatives from all of the agencies and departments involved.

Senator Lott said today he is considering minor changes to the BBA in order to gain passage; he is reportedly considering an amendment to permit capital budgeting. Senator Daschle told reporters he might support a revised amendment allowing for a separate capital budget -- but "I won't support (just) any capital budget." The unanimous consent agreement on S.J. Res. 1 does not permit any additional Republican amendments. Therefore, in order to offer an amendment to the BBA, Lott would have to get unanimous consent, or Chairman Hatch would have to report a new joint resolution from the Judiciary Committee.

On Wednesday, March 5th, Deputy Director John Koskinen will testify before the Senate Governmental Affairs Committee on the General Accounting Office's high-risk series, which identifies federal programs most vulnerable to waste, fraud, abuse and mismanagement.
