EARLY CHILDHOOD DEVELOPMENT AND LEARNING: WHAT NEW RESEARCH ON THE BRAIN
TELLS US ABOUT OUR YOUNGEST CHILDREN

□&Learning begins in the first days of life. Scientists are now discovering how young children develop emotionally and intellectually from their very first days, and how important it is for parents to begin immediately talking, singing, even reading to their infants....We already know we should start teaching children before they start school.□8

--President Bill Clinton, State of the Union Address, February 4, 1997

Today, President Clinton issued a statement announcing the date and themes of the White House Conference on Early Childhood Development and Learning: What New Research on the Brain Tells Us About Our Youngest Children. The day-long Conference will take place on April 17, 1997 at the White House. The Conference will highlight how critically important children□,s experiences before school are to their development and their later success in school and in life.

The Conference will focus on the practical applications of the latest scientific research on the brain, particularly for parents and care-givers. Also central to the Conference will be a discussion of the ways all sectors of society, including the medical, business, and faith communities, child care providers and government, can use this information to strengthen America□,s families.

Over the last four years, the Administration has invested heavily in research to help us better understand the importance of the first few years to child development and learning, and in strengthening efforts that support families and caregivers with young children, including:

□□Increased NIH Research Funding 23%. Unlike other research areas, the federal government is almost the sole funder of research of children and youth, supporting over 90% of research on children and youth. Under the

Clinton Administration, funding for NIH research has increased by 23% since 1993, to \$12.7 billion in 1997. Between 1993 and 1997, funding for NIH children's research has increased 25%, from 1.3 billion to 1.6 billion. This sustained level of investment has helped support many of the research advances the April White House Conference will explore. In FY 1998 the President's budget proposes to increase funding for NIH by an additional \$337 million.

Enhanced Head Start Participation and Quality and Created the Early Head Start Program for Children 0-3. The Administration has enhanced Head Start participation and increased its funding by 43% over the last four years, and created the Early Head Start program in 1994 to support families with children ages zero to three. Head Start provides low-income children and their families with comprehensive education, health services, and nutrition. The President's FY 1998 Budget further increases participation to reach 122,000 more children in FY 1998 than when he took office.

Commitment to Full Participation in WIC. The Administration dramatically increased participation in the WIC Supplemental Nutrition Program, providing 7.4 million pregnant women, infants, and children with nutrition packages and information and health referrals -- 1.7 million more than when President Clinton took office. And his FY 1998 Budget would achieve his goal of full participation in the WIC program by the end of FY 1998. Research shows that every \$1 invested in WIC prenatal serves saves up to \$4 in Medicaid costs in the first 60 days after birth. [USDA, 1990 Mathematica Policy Research].

Leading National Effort to Raise Immunization Rates. In 1993, the Administration launched a national effort to raise childhood immunization rates by reducing vaccination costs for parents and vaccine delivery services, and increasing community education and partnerships. Today, childhood immunization rates are at record high levels.

TODAY, THE PRESIDENT WILL SEND TO CONGRESS LEGISLATION TO HELP LOCAL COMMUNITIES AND STATES REBUILD THE NATION'S SCHOOLS. As America moves into the 21st century, our schools should too. The President's new legislation -- the Partnership to Rebuild America's Schools Act -- meets his commitment to provide *\$5 billion over four years, leveraging \$20 billion*, to help local communities and states rebuild America's schools -- through both upgrading and new construction to respond to population increases and shifts. The need for this is clear:

- **Record Numbers of School Buildings in Disrepair.** One-third of all schools—serving 14 million students—need extensive repair or replacement. About 60 percent of schools have at least one major building feature, such as leaky roofs and crumbling walls, in disrepair. [Source: General Accounting Office Report: "School Facilities: America's Schools Report Differing Conditions," June 14, 1996]
- **Student Population at an All-Time High.** Many school districts also face the need to build new schools to accommodate enrollment growth. Public school enrollment in grades K-12 is expected to rise 20 percent between 1990 and 2004. [Source: U.S. Department of Commerce, *Statistical Abstract of the United States, 1995*, p. 151]
- **A State and Local Responsibility, and a National Concern.** The federal government can, and should, play a crucial role in addressing this increasing problem of school disrepair by providing limited resources in a manner that spurs states, communities, and even the private sector to provide adequate school facilities for all children.

FACT SHEET ON THE SCHOOL CONSTRUCTION LEGISLATION

The Partnership to Rebuild America's Schools Act of 1997

March 14, 1997

TODAY, PRESIDENT CLINTON WILL SEND TO CONGRESS THE PARTNERSHIP TO REBUILD AMERICA'S SCHOOLS ACT OF 1997 -- A NEW INITIATIVE. Since the President announced his school construction initiative last year, his Administration has listened to hundreds of people responsible for school financing in the process of developing the Partnership to Rebuild America's Schools Act. The new \$5 billion legislation:

- *Gives states and local communities more flexibility* in using the financing of school construction.
- *Targets half the funding to school districts most in need.*
- *Includes a competitive component* to ensure that federal funds are carefully and efficiently spent on incremental construction.

THE ACT GIVES GREATER FLEXIBILITY TO STATES THROUGH INTEREST SUBSIDIES OR ALTERNATIVE FINANCING FOR NEW CONSTRUCTION AND RENOVATION: The Partnership to Rebuild America's Schools Act would provide up to a 50% subsidy of interest or the present value equivalent of other financing costs to school districts. This funding would underwrite repairs to existing K-12 schools, or construction of new schools to replace old ones or to accommodate increased enrollments.

- **Allowable financing costs** would include the costs of bonds, certificates of participation, purchase or lease arrangements, capitalizing state revolving funds, or other state and local expenditures incurred by States or local governments in financing eligible projects.
- **Subsidies would be awarded to communities according to several criteria,** including

KEY ELEMENTS OF THE

- **Allocates \$2.45 billion to** on the Title I basic grants formula. The legislation allocates one half of the total amount to states and the other half to local assurances that it will increase, covering private funds.
- **Targets another \$2.45 billion to children living in poverty.** Under the Act, according to GAO data, will be allocated by formula, and the greatest needs and the best construction mechanisms.
- **Provides flexibility to states for renovation.** This legislation provides flexibility for states to use construction bonds; to reduce the amount of construction; or for other similar mechanisms.
- **Leverages additional spending.** That is, recipients may use federal funds for school construction in communities.
- **Applies to a wide range of facilities,** renovations to ensure health and safety (plumbing and heating systems), and construction that prepares for the establishment of charter and magnet schools.
- **Provides flexibility for states to determine** have the flexibility to determine the amount of subsidies. Such determinations

(i) greatest need, (ii) fewest resources to meet that need, and (iii) commitment to leverage federal funds by increasing the community's own school construction effort.

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USING A NEW FORMULA, THE ACT ALLOCATES ONE-HALF OF THE FUNDS TO STATES FOR STATE BONDS OR FOR DISTRIBUTION TO LOCAL DISTRICTS. Of the \$5 billion total for this initiative, \$2.45 billion would be allocated to states using a formula based on the existing "Title I" (education for the disadvantaged) basic grants formula.

- **Leveraging requirement.** To receive funds, States will have to assure that they will increase, over a four-year period, the amount of school construction paid for by State, local and private funds.
- **States would determine their highest priorities for construction assistance** based on a survey of school construction needs, awarding the subsidies to those communities with the greatest construction needs and least ability to meet those needs with their own resources.

THE ACT TARGETS FUNDS TO THE 100 SCHOOL DISTRICTS WITH THE HIGHEST NUMBERS OF CHILDREN LIVING IN POVERTY. According to General Accounting Office data, those school districts -- primarily urban -- that have the greatest numbers of children living in poverty have far and away the greatest school construction needs. This legislation addresses this by providing direct allocations, and a competitive bonus pool, to those districts facing dire construction needs.

- **Leveraging requirement.** To receive funds, eligible school districts would have to demonstrate in their applications how they will increase, over a four-year period, the amount of school construction paid for with State, local, and private funds.
- **Districts would determine highest priority needs** based on a survey of local construction needs.
- **Districts would compete to receive bonus funds.** Seventy percent of the funds available directly to local districts would be awarded by a formula, based on their Title I shares. The remaining 30 percent would be awarded on a competitive basis to those districts with particularly high needs that are willing to provide the most support, through non-federal resources, for infrastructure improvement.

PURPOSES OF SUBSIDIZED PROJECTS. Funds for subsidies would be provided to states and local districts to lower the costs of additional construction or renovation of projects with one of the following purposes:

- **Fixing or upgrading classrooms or structures related to academic learning.**
- **Addressing basic health and safety problems** with air quality, plumbing, heating, and lighting.
- **Enhancing access for students, teachers, and other people with disabilities.**
- **Improving energy efficiency.**
- **Providing infrastructure that facilitates use of educational technology,** such as communications closets, electrical systems, and power outlets.
- **Constructing new schools to meet needs imposed by increased or shifting enrollments.**
- **Creating after-school learning centers, community schools, and charter schools.**

ONE-TIME FEDERAL STIMULUS OF SCHOOL CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITY. The funds available through this legislation would be distributed as single awards to States and districts.

STATE AND LOCAL GOVERNMENTS MAINTAIN RESPONSIBILITY FOR SCHOOL CONSTRUCTION. States and localities would continue to maintain full responsibility for determining school construction needs and administering facilities programs.

Allocation of Funds Methodology
The Partnership to Rebuild America's Schools Act of 1997

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The Partnership to Rebuild America's Schools provides \$5 billion to jump-start State and local school construction and renovation. After two percent of the funds are set aside for the Bureau of Indian Affairs and the U.S. territories, the remainder is made available as follows:

LOCAL DISTRICT ALLOCATION

One-half of the remaining available funds, \$2.45 billion, is made available to fund applications submitted to the Secretary of Education by the 100 local school districts with the greatest number of children living in poverty.

Of that \$2.45 billion, 70 percent, or \$1.715 billion, will be made available to local districts on the same basis that they receive funds under the Federal government's major program for helping schools serving children from low-income families (basic grants under Title I of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act). The data used for the tables that follow are based on the 1990 Census count of low-income children. That data is being updated and may be incorporated into the Title I allocations for FY 1998, causing some adjustments to the estimates provided here.

The remaining 30 percent of the local allocation, or \$735 million, will be awarded on a competitive basis to those districts with particularly significant infrastructure needs that will use these funds most effectively in leveraging non-Federal resources.

STATE ALLOCATION

The other half of the funds, \$2.45 billion will be made available to the States based on the same Title I formula, except that the qualifying children that live in local school districts that are eligible to apply directly for funds are subtracted from the States' total number. (For example, the children living in poverty in Philadelphia were not included in the calculation for the State of Pennsylvania, since Philadelphia would be eligible to apply for funds directly to the Education Department). Again, the estimates may be adjusted in the next few months based on an update of Census data.

In order to receive funds, States must survey their infrastructure needs (if they have not already done so) and provide the Secretary of Education with an application describing how the funds will be distributed to localities with the greatest need and with the greatest leveraging impact.

*A Case Study
Broward County/Ft. Lauderdale*

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THE PROBLEM

Broward County is located in Southern Florida and is the fifth largest school district in the nation. Its schools suffer from severe overcrowding:

- 34,000 students without permanent desks;
- Approximately 10,000 new students added to the school system each year; and
- In the past nine years, Broward has built 36 new schools and rebuilt 23 schools, and continues to have a difficult time meeting its demand

Broward would have to build a new school every month to meet this demand adequately. Citing the approximately 2,000 portable classrooms in the county, the budget director for the county public schools described Broward as "the portable capital of the world." One high school has 46 portable classrooms in use during this school year alone.

NEEDS AND AVAILABLE RESOURCES

A recent needs analysis estimated Broward's capital construction needs at \$2.4 billion, \$200 million of which is needed for technology improvements alone. The last bond approved for school construction was for \$317 million in 1987. Mobilizing local support for new tax or bond referenda has been difficult. In fact, in September, 1995, a tax referendum to increase the sales tax by one penny to raise \$1 billion for school construction was defeated.

POTENTIAL IMPACT OF THE PARTNERSHIP TO REBUILD AMERICA'S SCHOOLS ACT

Under the President's legislative proposal, approximately \$16.4 million would be allocated to the county school district. Broward could use these funds to subsidize interest costs for a local bond to cover a substantial part of the its school construction costs. This funding could support nearly \$70 million in leveraged funds to assist in rebuilding a number of local schools.

These new funds would be used primarily to ease overcrowding in schools by funding new schools as well as renovations and additions to existing schools that would expand seating capacity. Broward also wants to reduce its reliance on portable classrooms due to the fact that -- with a life expectancy of approximately 20 years -- portables are not a good long-term investment compared to a traditional school structure. In addition, portables cannot be wired for technology the same way as a traditional classroom.
