I haven't seen them, yet -- they are going to send me over a copy. In our phone conversation, they told me that the draft regulations provide a fair degree of flexibility for the states to meet the minimum requirements (under the law, states would have to enact community notification laws or risk losing 10% of Byrne Formula Grant funding --- funding that goes to the states for law enforcement purposes).

States can't comply by just providing information to local law enforcement or for employment purposes. Some states were already trying to comply by just notifying schools and Justice told them more was needed. However, New Jersey has a state law that has risk levels and the level of notice is determined by the risk level (I assume that means that sexual assault of an adult would be notice to law enforcement but sexual child molester would be schools, neighborhood notice, etc. too) and that is enough. Some states have call-in numbers in which you can ask for a list of where convicted child molesters live, etc. I think she said that would be in compliance.

I will get you a copy of the guidelines when they come in so you can see if they make sense.

Supposedly, a majority of states have some form of community notification law and DoJ thinks that most states will have already complied with the Megan's Law regulations.

Tomorrow the INS will have its media briefing on the new guidelines for naturalizing individuals with disabilities. As you know, DOJ concluded that the present law will not allow all disabled individuals to satisfy the oath requirement and become citizens. The INS wants to know whether Commissioner Meissner should use this opportunity to explicitly link this limitation to the President's welfare fix proposal. In her statement, she could say something about naturalization is not the full answer to address ing the harsh provisions pertaining to legal immigrants in the welfare reform law, then discuss how the Administration is proposing to address the problem legislatively. The INS has asked whether we would want to have a White House statement or a letter from the President about the Administration's proposals to distribute at the briefing.

I guess I think that the Commissioner should probably make the link in her statement because one of the first questions that is likely to be asked is what is to become of these people and what does the Administration propose to help them. I am less certain that it would be helpful to release a White House statement on welfare reform at an INS briefing.

Any thoughts on this? I would need to get back to INS later today.

I was talking with Anne Lewis, NEC, this morning about the differences between Texas and Wisconsin. I thought that you might be interested in a better description of Wisconsin. A quick and dirty summary is that Wisconsin focuses more on privatization as a mechanism to improve program performance while Texas' approach is more focuses on improving cost effectiveness. Although each State is striving towards both goals.

This description has been added to the agency paper.

Wisconsin Works

The Wisconsin Works (W-2) demonstration proposal is a Statewide project which, in part, would establish competitively-bid County contracts with public or private agencies. The public or private agencies would be responsible for certification actions such as gathering client eligibility information, conducting eligibility interviews and imputing data for those food stamp households which are subject to W-2 requirements. The contracted agencies would not have any responsibility over the States', computer system.

There are 72 counties and 11 Indian Tribal Organizations (ITO) in Wisconsin. In 61 counties, the County Social or Human Services Department earned and exercised its right of first selection to administer the W-2 project. Two ITOs also earned the exercised the right of first selection. Therefore, competitively-bid contracts will be awarded for the W-2 project in 11 counties and 9 ITOs. However, the State could, at some point in the future, contract with a private agency for the W-2 project in a County office that does not meet a specified level of performance.

Private organizations that are awarded contracts may perform aspects of

the certification process that are currently required to be handled by merit employees. The W-2 employees would be responsible for food stamp households that are subject to work requirements. Food stamp households that are exempt from W-2 requirements, such as the elderly and disabled, will continue to be certified by public employees.

The State, presuming the Department of Agriculture's approval of its waiver request of the merit system requirements for the Food Stamp Program, released its Request for Proposals (RFP). While the State can issue the RFP without USDA's approval, they will need to hear back from USDA in order to award the contract. State officials have advised that the contract process has been completed for one County (with over 60 percent of the State caseload) without the inclusion of the Food Stamp Program. Contracts have been awarded to six private, non-profit agencies.

FYI, INS is holding briefings tomorrow for the media (and for Congress and community groups, I believe) on the new regulations that waive English & civics tests for some disabled individuals. The regulations also address matters of accomodation during the naturalization process for those who need it. Because some field offices held the cases of disabled applicants pending the issuance of these regulations, the result will be that a sizeable backlog of cases will have their cases processed for citizenship.

As you recall, DOJ determined that the oath could not be waived, so there will be some of the severely disabled who will not be able to be naturalized. My understanding is that Commissioner Meissner therefore will note that naturalization cannot be the answer for addressing all of the problems for disabled legal immigrants under the Welfare Reform Act and that the President's legislative proposal is therefore needed.

Diana researched Scholastic's donation of 1 million books and I talked about it with Carol Rasco again today. According to both the Corporation for National Service and Carol, Scholastic has donated the books for America Reads, but nothing more specific. CNS secured the pledge from Scholastic and Carol clearly does not yet have plans for the books.

Therefore, I propose that we use these 1 million books to fulfill the First Lady's goal of having doctors prescribe reading to infants and children and give books to those children who are unlikely to have books at home when they visit the doctor. HRC would like the President to be able to announce a national effort to do this at the Brain Conference, and we have the Academy of Pediatrics, Children's Hospitals, and Community Health Centers signing up to do it, but we need books. When HRC met before she left with these groups and the Assoc. of American Publishers about this, the Publishers' President also asked whether Scholastic's million books could be directed to this end.

Carol thinks of America Reads very broadly -- any effort to respond to the President's challenge to help children read -- and America Reads has always had a Parents as First Teachers component to it, so the books would still be part of America Reads and the volunteerism summit. If you are agreeable to this use for the books, I could call Carol for her blessing, but I think it would be better if you called her as the coordinator of the Brain Conference. Then one of us would need to call Scholastic.

What do you think?
