Here is the letter. Elena, Jon Kaplan can work with you and the Vice President's office on the release. Here is what has changed since the last time it was circulated. I leave it to your discretion and Jon's as to whether anyone needs to have a final poke at the letter in view of the changes and the passage of time.

1. I eliminated a sentence saying that if the FCC finds a link between the ads and children's attitudes about liquor that the FCC should consider time restrictions on the advertising. Dan Tate thought that was too strong. We don't really need to say it, so I struck it. I alerted Rahm to this change, but don't know if he focused on it at the time. I don't know whether this would be viewed by others as subtracting from the oomph of what we're doing, but I think the change Dan suggested is an improvement.

2. Kahlua is supposedly on the brink of a big advertising campaign. I don't know whether what they are planning, which may have a strong subliminal appeal to children that is obvious to adults, may tip the balance at the FCC and cause them to act regardless of whatever we say or don't say.

3. Interest in this issue seems to have quieted on the Hill. I can't tell whether this is an enduring or temporary phenomenon.

Dear Chairman Hundt:

I write to ask your assistance in addressing a new and emerging challenge to parents struggling to raise safe, healthy children: the decision by manufacturers of hard liquor to advertise on television.

For half a century, these companies voluntarily refrained from such advertising. They understood that advertising over the uniquely powerful and pervasive medium of broadcasting could reach children inappropriately, encouraging them to drink before it is even legal for them to do so. Until now, these companies have shown appropriate restraint. For as long as there has been television, they have known that a voluntary ban was right and they lived by it.

Now, some companies have broken ranks and started placing hard liquor ads on TV. I was greatly disappointed by their decision. I have previously expressed my dismay at this action and called on the industry to urge all its members to return to their long-standing policy and stand by the ban. I am gratified to learn that, according to one survey, the vast majority of television stations are declining to air these advertisements. I applaud that stand.

I firmly believe that we have a national obligation to act strongly to protect our children from threats to their health and safety. That's why I have fought so strongly to impose appropriate regulations on the sale and distribution of cigarettes and smokeless tobacco and tobacco advertising that appeals to adolescents, to ensure that our schools and children are safe and drug-free, and to combat gangs and violence afflicting our youth.

I applaud your public remarks calling on the industry and broadcasters to reactivate the voluntary ban. I also commend your comments that the Federal Communications Commission has an obligation to consider any and all actions that would protect the public interest in the use of the public airwaves.

I urge the Commission to take all appropriate actions to explore what effects might ensue in light of the decision by manufacturers of hard liquor to abandon their long-standing voluntary ban on television advertising, specifically the impact on underage drinking.

We have made tremendous progress in recent years reducing the incidence of deaths due to drunk driving among our youth. We have taken important steps including the increase in the 1980s in the drinking age to 21 and the passage of zero tolerance legislation for underage

drinking and driving. But there is more to be done. Too many of our young people are dying in car crashes, and too many young people are starting to drink at an early age, leading to alcohol and other substance abuse problems.

I would appreciate your help and the help of the Commission in exploring the possible actions you could take to support our parents and children in response to the manufacturers' decision to break with the long and honorable tradition of not advertising on the broadcast medium.

I am meeting a couple of times a week with OPM and NPR to ensure that the implementation process runs smoothly. So far, so good. However, a couple of questions were raised today that I told them I'd ask you both and then pass on the answers.

1) At the point agencies assess their success, can they count welfare recipients hired before March 8, 1997 or must they count from March 8 on?

2) The primary goal of agency plans will be to directly hire welfare recipients. Can agencies also encourage government contractors to hire welfare recipients, and then count those recipients when reporting progress? This is an issue particularly relevant to NASA and similar high tech/science-based agencies that contract out a tremendous amount of work and have few in-house entry level jobs. NPR and OMB say doing so is legal and there is precedent for it. The only question is whether we want agencies to include this option or not.

3) Same question for federal grantees.

4) The Postal service is a quasi-governmental agency so is not covered under this directive. Do we want to include them? (We should--lots of entry-level jobs.) NPR and OPM think that if we want to include the postal service-, one of you (Bruce or Elena) should call Runyon directly.

5) Are we, at the DPC, going to hire a welfare recipient? (This question came up at today's earlier White House meeting, not at the OPM/NPR meeting.)

Here is my better understanding of the particular facts on the clips issue. Then, I guess we should talk about the Dingell issue when you want to.

The 1994 Crime Bill restricted the manufacture, transfer, and possession of certain semiautomatic assault weapons and "large capacity ammunition feeding devices."

The Act defined "large capacity ammunition feeding device" to mean:

"A magazine, belt, drum, feed strip, or similar device manufactured after the date of enactment of the Act that has the capacity of, or that can be readily restored or converted to accept more than 10 rounds of ammunition."

So the definition, itself, grandfathers in clips that were manufactured before the effective date. This definition was inserted into the bill by Dingell during conference.

However, ATF originally interpreted this provision to only to such devices lawfully possessed in the United States on or before enactment.

Two suits were filed against ATF by clip manufactures over their interpretation of this provision. Dingell was very vocal about this interpretation and I can go into that background w/ you. In addition, the Associate Attorney General informed ATF that the Civil Division would not defend ATF's interpretation in court.

As a result, in July 1996, ATF reinterpreted the clip provision through a temporary rule in the Federal Register acknowledging that pre-ban clips could be imported. They did, however, require importers to present reasonable evidence that the devices were manufactured on or before the Crime Bill's date of enactment.

Treasury informs me that since then and as of March 1, 1997, importation records indicate that 157,236 large capacity magazines from a variety of countries have been imported, through 21 approved permits. 83 permits seeking importation of 2,112,441 large capacity magazines have been approved. According to Treasury an importer receives a one year permit to bring in a certain number of clips, but the importer might not use all of this permit authority.

Feinstein now claims that these clips are coming in from China and it is because of the Dingell amendment.

Since the Tiananmen Square crackdown in 1989, exports of defense articles to China have been prohibited. State and Treasury regulations state that it is the U.S. policy to prohibit imports of defense articles that are subject to an U.S. arms export embargo. Before 1994, China was exempted from this policy.

On May 26, 1994, the President revoked China's waiver --- so that no guns or clips could legally come into the United States from China.

However, Senator Craig, from the great State of Idaho, added an amendment to an appropriations bill, effective July 25, 1994, that prevented appropriated funds from being used to bar the importation of previously importable munitions from China that were in transit as of May 26, 1994.

According to Treasury, 35,000 large capacity magazines were imported from China under the Craig amendment -- but none have come in since the Crime Bill's implementation date, September 13, 1994.

So, yes clips are coming into the United States because of the Dingell provision, but no they are not coming in from China (at least according to the Treasury Dept, the same folks who forgot to tell us that they had already announce the President's youth gun interdiction initiative a year before he did).
