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Michelle Jolin of CEA just told me about two upcoming CEA reports which may be useful for March-April events. She is interested in any guidance on how and when to release them (and is also discussing this with Bruce).

**1. Welfare Reform.** By the week of 3/31, CEA will be ready with a report on the factors that have reduced the nation's welfare caseloads so dramatically in the past four years. They will conclude that about 50% was due to the strong economy, and 50% due to other factors, including our state waivers (which may account for roughly one-third of the reduction). Apparently, the President has already been told about this report and is very interested in it. It could serve as a "What Works" guide for states (or literally be turned into such a guide). Since it will almost definitely show that our approach is the right one, we may want to consider having the POTUS highlight it through a Radio Address or other event.

**2. Investments in Children Aged 0-3.** By the week of April 14th (right before the Early Childhood Conference), CEA will be ready with a report on investments in children aged 0-3, including health and mental health programs/investments. It will essentially be a cost-benefit analysis pointing out the importance and cost-effectiveness of investing in young children. While it will not contain hard news, we could release or mention it as part of another event to lead-in to the Conference.

Please let me know if either of these are of interest.

For the HS service scholarship event, how did you leave it with Lt. Gov Townsend, in terms of selecting a site?

One idea that we were kicking around on the Federal commitment: we would not only increase our adopt a school effort (maybe doubling it), but we would take a more comprehensive approach and make sure kids at our adopted schools had each of the 5 resources, perhaps by coordinating across agencies. (For instance, DOJ does a lot of "safe place" stuff that we could all take advantage of.) Not sure I love it because it's somewhat hard to summarize, it's not that service-y, and it plays off of their five goals more than we might wish, but....

FYI also yesterday: we met with Benjamin Barber to hear about his fears, and we met with the Christmas in April people to try to structure a WH activity. They do make it very easy.

I met with Eli Segal this morning. We talked about 1) the Internet project, 2) the DLC conference, 3) his organization's roll out, and 4) involving the faith community in his efforts with business. Here's what he had to say.

--He loves the internet idea. I gave him a copy of the memo I drafted for Cynthia and he is going to try to drum up computer donations immediately. He's been looking for a way to involve the high tech industry and thinks this could be it. I'll keep you posted.

--He'd love to be involved in a DLC/White House conference on best welfare to work practices. However, the National Alliance of Business and the NGA are talking about holding similar conferences. I think we should shoot to bring Eli, the DLC, NGA and NAB together for one best practices conference. Further, Eli is still having trouble with Marriot. As a way of smoothing Marriot over, we could headline Marriot's program. What do you think?

-Eli says the April 7 date is too early for a rollout and he is also hesitant about April 16. He feels a rollout on April 16 is pushing it. He's also reconsidering Milwaukee as the rollout spot and thinks Washington might be more appropriate for a national rollout followed by regional events. What do you think?

-Finally, Eli had not thought about involving the Faith community in his effort, but will give it some thought. We plan on talking again early next week.

Tomorrow Judge Ross testifies on the child support incentive report. Shaw and Levin have asked HHS to provide a table showing the incentives received state by state under the proposal versus current law. The table shows that California, Connecticut, Florida, Illinois, Mississippi, New Mexico, Tennessee will all lose money -- if they don't improve their child support enforcement performance.

Tarplin is inclined to give them the table because--

- 1) the request is bipartisan
- 2) there's no good way to keep a lid on the info because it was used by the state-HHS working group that prepared the report and one of the state reps (former CA child support director Leslie Frye) is a witness on the same panel.

He wants to make sure it's ok with us.

I think it's okay because our message should be: We want to be as tough as possible on child support enforcement -- and that means holding states accountable for results. Only states that perform well should get incentives. If California doesn't like these projections, they should revamp their program to produce better results.... etc. What do you think?

**MEMORANDUM**

Your staff requested some feedback regarding proposals submitted by representatives from American Indian tribes. I was asked to provide comment and recommendations on two specific issues: a possible Executive Order on Government-to-Government relations with tribes and a POTUS meeting with tribal leaders.

## **PROPOSAL #1**

Proposed Executive Order on Government-to-Government relations with American Indian tribes

### **BACKGROUND**

President Clinton signed a Presidential Memorandum on Government-to-Government relations with tribes on April 29, 1994. This historic Memorandum acknowledged the special relationship the United States has with American Indian tribes, and directed the heads of Executive Departments and Agencies to consult with Federally-recognized Tribal nations on a Government-to-Government basis in formulating policies and programs affecting tribes. In addition, President Clinton has issued two Executive Orders relating to tribes: one on Native American sacred sites and a second on tribal colleges.

### **ISSUE**

In a letter to the President, two tribes requested the issuance of an Executive Order on Indian sovereignty and the Government-to-Government relationship. While this is a similar subject matter to the 1994 Memorandum, in the tribes' view, an Executive Order is a more powerful means of Presidential communication to the Executive Branch.

### **DISCUSSION**

The Presidential Memorandum on Government-to-Government relations was a major accomplishment for this Administration in promoting greater tribal sovereignty. While the two Executive Orders are important to the Native American community, expanding Government-to-Government relations is generally viewed with greater significance to more tribes.

Federal agencies are varied in their compliance with the Memorandum. The Interior Department and the EPA were particularly responsive in developing and carrying out policies pursuant to the Memorandum. Other agencies have been much slower to develop and implement policies on this front. Tribes would like to see the Federal government more responsive to the Memorandum which is why they are interested in an Executive Order on the same issue.

It is debatable whether the situation warrants an Executive Order. While it is fair to expect and ask for greater responsiveness from certain agencies, issuing an Executive Order similar to the Presidential Memorandum at this point in time may suggest a failure of the Federal government to act on the President's initial request. This would be inaccurate and could undermine successes achieved by this Administration on Government-to-Government relations.

### **RECOMMENDATION**

Agencies would probably benefit from some prodding on their compliance with the initial Memorandum. An Executive Order should be considered as a possible response. However, an alternate response could be some other form of WH contact with the agencies. This would not necessarily need to come from the President.

For example, a memorandum issued by the WH Chief of Staff or other appropriate WH official to Federal agencies could ask for the status of their policies pursuant to the 1994 Presidential

Memorandum. This may generate some action from otherwise unresponsive agencies. After a reasonable amount of time has elapsed for agencies to respond, an assessment could be made on where agencies stand and what steps-- if any-- are necessary to further promote Government-to-Government relations and tribal sovereignty (e.g., Executive Order or other Executive action).

## **PROPOSAL #2**

Meeting with tribal leaders

### **ISSUE**

The leaders of approximately 25 tribes have requested meetings with the President. The last major official meeting with tribal leaders was in April 1994.

### **BACKGROUND**

In April 1994, the President met with over 300 tribal leaders in a large ceremonial event on the WH lawn. The Cabinet was present at the meeting, and the event lasted several hours. During the meeting, the President released his Memorandum on Government-to-Government relations and a Memorandum on the use of eagle feathers for religious purposes.

### **DISCUSSION**

Many American Indian tribes believe that it is time for another meeting with the President. However, only a relative small number of tribal leaders have officially requested such a meeting.

If a meeting is scheduled, it would be wise to accommodate a larger number of tribes since the last official meeting occurred nearly 3 years ago.

A larger WH meeting would require significant planning and sufficient lead time. However, even with a larger meeting, any tribe that was in attendance at the April 1994 meeting that is not invited to the next meeting could be offended.

Instead of a meeting at the White House, another option could be for the President to speak at a large inter-tribal conference, such as the National Conference of American Indians (NCAI), which meets a few times a year. Secretary Babbitt speaks at one NCAI conference annually, and the Vice President spoke to NCAI in November 1995. One scheduled NCAI conference to consider is scheduled for November 1997 in Santa Fe.

While many tribes attend the NCAI conferences, the Navajo Nation usually does not attend. It would be a major oversight to hold an inclusive tribal meeting without the large Navajo Nation.

It should be further noted that any major meeting with tribes will place the President at risk of being criticized for not being more responsive to Native American issues at both the Department of Interior or Bureau of Indian Affairs levels. This stands in contrast to the optimism held by tribes at the 1994 WH event.

### **RECOMMENDATION**

A meeting including a large number of tribes should be organized for the President's second Administration. It would not only be an important gesture of goodwill to tribes, but would allow the President to have more direct contact with a constituency that does not ordinarily receive high level attention.

If a large WH event/meeting is agreed upon, at least 3 months would probably be needed to sufficiently plan. A speaking role at an NCAI conference would be easier to coordinate, but as

noted above, the Navajo Nation would not be in attendance, unless they made a special provision to attend. Either event should take into account the timing of significant Administration decisions impacting tribes which are forthcoming (e.g, Indian gaming, BIA/Interior budget negotiation decisions).



SUBJECT: LEGISLATIVE REPORT

In an effort to get the budget resolution process underway, the Senate Budget Committee met today and will meet again on Thursday to hold a staff walk-through, function by function, of the Congressional Budget Office's re-estimate of the President's FY98 Budget.

CONGRESS TODAY (3/19)

#### SENATE

The Senate passed (55-44, 1 present) S.J.Res. 22, the Independent Council Resolution, by a vote of 55 to 44, with 1 voting present. The Senate then tabled S.J.Res. 23, the Levin/Leahy Independent Council Resolution, by a vote of 58 to 41, with 1 voting present.

The Senate confirmed Merrick Garland of Maryland to be US Circuit Judge for the District of Columbia, by a vote of 76 to 23.

Also today, the Senate passed H.R.924, the Victim Allocation bill, by unanimous consent, clearing the measure for the President.

#### HOUSE

The House passed (222-210) H.R. 1 - Working Families Flexibility Act of 1997 (Modified Closed Rule; 1 hour debate); Adopted the Rule by a vote of 229 to 195.

[The Presidential letter to the Speaker sent, 3/19: I strongly oppose H.R. 1 and will veto this bill if passed in its current form.]8

SAP also sent on 3/19 to back up the President's letter with details related to the bill.]

While under consideration of the bill, the House took up the following amendments:

- o Adopted (408-19) a Goodling (R-PA) en block amendment to require that an employee must have worked at least 1,000 hours during a continuous period of employment within the last year period before an employee is eligible for comp time; the amendment also reduces the maximum number of comp time hours an employee may accrue from 260 to 160 hours.
- o Adopted (390-36) a Boyd (D-FL) amendment to sunset the bill's comp time provisions after 5 years
- o Rejected (182-237) an Owens (D-NY) amendment to exempt from the bill's comp time provisions employees who earn less than two and one-half times the minimum wage.
- o Rejected (193-237) Miller (D-CA) Substitute amendment to allow the private sector employers to offer comp time to employees, but under more stringent requirements.

##### SENATE

The Senate will likely consider S.J.Res 19, Disapproving the President's Certification that Mexico has Fully Cooperated with U.S. Anti-Drug Efforts [Draft SAP pending: Administration strongly opposes]

The Senate may take up H.R. 412, the Oroville-Tonasket Claim Settlement and Conveyance Act, (which passed the House on Tuesday), and S. 388, a Food Stamp Act Amendment, which would deny food stamps for prisoners.

Consider pending nominations

The Senate is expected to adjourn either late Thursday afternoon or on Friday.
