

In response to Pauline's message re: Don Hirsch last night, here goes:

1. I have a draft of the early-childhood standards in my files if you want to see them.
2. Don's phone number at the Core Knowledge Foundation in Charlottesville is 804 977-7550. If he's not there, they'll give you his home number where he often works.
3. With regard to managing the politics of this issue before, at and after the summit, here are some preliminary thoughts:



Judy Wurtzel at ED should have a decent handle on the key players and we should quietly consult with her. After the meeting with Hirsch, Mike Smith indicated to Bruce and I that he thought the WH, rather than ED, needed to take the lead on this issue, so it didn't look like ED was intruding on HHS turf. Mike is out of town until Friday. Judy will consult with him if she needs to, but when we approach Judy we should be clear we are looking at this point for quite advice, not ED leadership. While I suspect that HHS staff will not be our strongest allies in this, there is at least one really sharp person I encounter there from time to time, who works on early childhood issues. I can't remember her name, but I can get it from Judy.

Carol Rasco has pretty good ties into key parts of this world. We should check with her as well.

I don't know the format/participants for the conference, but I think it will be very important if we are going to float this issue at the meeting to have a few credible validators -- researchers, providers, teachers, or leaders -- quickly proclaim that this is an idea worth pursuing. Depending upon how far we can go leading up to the conference, you might want to create either a high profile commission, or a low key working group, to develop some specific recommendations focused on ways to incorporate learning standards into Head Start -- or perhaps simply more

of a focus on learning -- as a follow-up action to the conference. Marion Wright Edelman and the CDF are likely to be critical here. Would the current relationship between FLOTUS and Marion be something we could draw upon here

Well, that's my first cut at this. Let me know if you want me to make any calls, and let me know if you still want a 3-way conference call.

Here is where we are:

1. NAGB (Advisory Group(s) for testing initiative):

The short answer is that we are working with the Education Department to identify options for establishing an advisory group, and are consulting with key members of Congress, to determine how best to proceed. Congressional consultations will begin next week, and we continue for the next several weeks.

The longer version is:

1. The Education Department is producing an options paper, which Mike Smith and I will review on Friday. The paper addresses the mission(s) to be served, the number of groups we might need (e.g., a technical advisory group to advise on technical aspects of test development, a substantive group to make sure the test measures the right content, etc.) and how the groups would be formed.

The key issues to be resolved here revolve around (1) whether to establish an independent, policy/governing board that would have responsibility for overseeing the test development and use; (2) if so, whether this would be the current NAGB or something separate -- and, if separate, how it would relate to NAGB; (3) if we decide we need an independent group, when to engage the Hill on this.

2. Mike and I are meeting with Goodling's staff next Tuesday on these issues; as appropriate we will then reach out to other key Republicans (e.g., Riggs, Porter) and Democrats (Clay, Kildee) on the House side.

3. Mike Smith and Kay Casstevens think our biggest risk comes from getting Congress involved in all of this stuff when so far only a few Republicans (prodded by 2 outsiders and 1 staff member) have even raised these issues. However, I think our biggest risk comes from not creating some distance between the Administration and the test development, and by

not taking steps to create an independent, credible buffer between us and the tests.

## 2. Teacher News

1. The prime teacher event coming up is the teacher of the year event in mid April. This event generally generates good local coverage nationwide, because every state teacher of the year shows up. Because the national teacher of the year is a board-certified teacher, this event is also an opportunity to highlight and explain our initiative in this area; we haven't done that yet, and the Defense announcement in North Carolina limited any attention to the National Board there.

In addition, I am working with ED to identify a new step for the President to announce at this event. My leading candidate is centered around a proposal (to be included in the Higher Ed Act) to support the development of standards and assessments for beginning teachers, to complement the tough standards for existing teachers. There is work underway on this we can build on. This will get nailed down with the Department by the beginning of the week.

As a package, the message from the event will be about excellence in teaching--teachers of the year, national board standards, standards for new teachers, and Riley and POTUS listen to the voices of the best teachers.

2. I'm still working on Shanker memorial, but no progress to report since yesterday.

I just read this. Sorry. I am swamped, but let me give you a quick couple of points:

1. Medical Records Privacy. A broader bill on medical records privacy is being put together by HHS, but will take probably months to work out internal (OMB) and external (business and insurer) political problems. I would say August or so.

However, there appears to be a good chance that we could do something on privacy related issues as they relate specifically to genetic screening. With all this cloning stuff around, I think this would be a very good and timely idea. It could provide for protections against insurers using this stuff to underwrite. I was planning on having a meeting with HHS on this sometime during the week, but events have intervened. I do believe, however, that a later April timeframe for an announcement is really very doable. (I will report back immediately after my meeting.)

2. EO on unemployed workers. Nancy Ann Min did put a call into OPM on this issue, but never heard back before her departure. I asked her to put a staff person on it and was told I would soon get a report. Nothing yet, but I will look into it as soon as I get a free moment. (I have a feeling, however, that this will not be an easy thing to do.)

3. Criminal background checks on home health care/nannies. We included the background check in the recent home health reg. Probably not much here in my area, but nannies may be another thing, Dennis?

4. Diabetes Research. Checking into this as per our conversation. Will get back to you.

We met with summit organizers last night (Stuart Shapiro, Powell's guy, Points of Light guy, and Corp) and learned the following things of interest:

1. They do plan to announce the formation of the partnership on Thursday. Powell wants to announce it in an interview with the Phila Inquirer, along with a \$1 million grant from Pew. The current name they are working with is "America's Promise: The Alliance for Youth." Let me know if you want me to follow up in any way.
2. Governors attending so far include Rowland, Carper, Zell Miller, Edgar, O'Bannon of Indiana, Weld, Engler, Shaheen of NH, Whitman, Hunt of NC, Keating, Ridge, Almond, Janklow of SDakota, Sundquist, Dean, Locke of Washington, Geringer of Wyoming. They predict Wilson will come. Marcia may push Romer and Bob Miller to come too.
3. We are planning to meet with their PR team soon. New production company hired includes Bill Kitchen, who did Inaugural.
4. President's Service Awards won't be ready until the summit itself. The group thought maybe the President could award these on Sunday. (they originally wanted Monday night.)
5. There is some left-wing protest planned for Sunday, with rhetoric that this is a sham designed to cover up increasing poverty and signing of welfare bill. Endorsers include Mumia Abu Jamal, the celebrated guy on Death Row, Noam Chomsky, Ramsey Clark, lots of labor union locals, although apparently not the leadership, and a zillion small left groups.
6. Sunday day of service on Germantown Road has kickoffs at 10:30 and 1:30 led by Powell, with calisthenics led by Schwarzenegger. They asked if POTUS would be there Sunday in time for 1:30; we said we'd get back to them.
7. We said we'd want a speaking role for VP on Monday am, and for FL on Tuesday. They said they'd "get back to us." Sounded more positive about VP, although they will put him earlier in the Monday program, before all the Presidents talk.

Our allies are looking for demonstrations of commitment from us, so having had this meeting with a statement or having a firm plan by then would be great.

#### Education

Has gift authority, including solicitation authority. All gifts/solicitations have to be approved in advance (as early in the process as possible) through either Joan Bardee or Amy Comstock -- 401-5309. Also, they routinely co-sponsor events/conferences.

#### HHS

I have been trading calls with the person I need to speak with at HHS. I know that they regularly co-sponsorship events. Plans to co-sponsor must be discussed with Rick Thomas -- 690-7258.

#### National Service

My calls have not been returned, but I know they have gift authority. I am assuming that all gifts must be approved in advance through Barry Stephens or Brit Rapp -- 606-5000, exts. 259, 258, respectively.

1) Teen Pregnancy Prevention: May is National Teen Pregnancy Prevention Month and May 1-2 the National Campaign to Prevent Teen Pregnancy will be having its first annual board meeting and dinner here in D.C. On May 2, the Campaign has also scheduled a Congressional press conference and policy forum on the Hill with several members.

On Thursday, May 1, we could a) have the President meet at the White House with the Board of Directors of the Campaign, keep it closed press and simply have the Campaign update the President on where they are and ask the President to encourage them to do more; b) have the President speak at the dinner the evening of May 1, open press, and have an announcement (to come) to make.
