PRESIDENT CLINTON ANNOUNCES APPAREL INDUSTRY PARTNERSHIP AGREEMENT

April 14, 1997

TODAY, PRESIDENT CLINTON WELCOMES TO THE WHITE HOUSE THE MEMBERS OF THE APPAREL INDUSTRY PARTNERSHIP TO ANNOUNCE A NEW AGREEMENT.

Leaders from the footwear and apparel industry, labor, nongovernmental organizations (NGOs), and consumer groups have found common ground, agreeing to a Code of Conduct and independent monitoring systems that will assure Americans that the clothes and shoes they buy are made under decent and humane working conditions. The Partnership also agreed to recruit others in the industry and to develop an independent association to assure compliance and inform consumers about the Code and which companies comply.

THIS AGREEMENT FOLLOWS FROM WHITE HOUSE MEETING LAST YEAR. On August 2, 1996, the President and Vice President met with these parties to discuss the problem of sweatshops, consumer concerns, and the need to join together to address these issues. The parties formed a voluntary, industry-driven partnership that proposed to report back to the President its recommendations for action.

- **Participants in the Partnership** include: Liz Claiborne; Nike; Phillips-Van Heusen; Reebok; L.L. Bean; Patagonia; Tweeds; Nicole Miller; Karen Kane; UNITE; the Retail, Wholesale, Department Store Union; Business for Social Responsibility; the Interfaith Center on Corporate Responsibility; the International Labor Rights Fund; Lawyers Committee for Human Rights; the National Consumers League; and the RFK Memorial Center for Human Rights.

THE PARTNERSHIP'S AGREEMENT IS THE FIRST OF ITS KIND. The agreement contains the following components:

- **A Strong Workplace Code of Conduct** that companies will voluntarily adopt and require their contractors to adopt, which, among other things, includes:
 - Prohibitions against child labor, worker abuse or harassment, and discrimination;
 - The recognition of workers' rights of freedom of association and collective bargaining;
 - A minimum or prevailing industry wage, a maximum 60-hour workweek, and a cap on mandatory overtime; and
 - A safe and healthy working environment.
- **Independent External Monitors** to conduct reviews of company policies and practices and to verify that the company is in compliance with its obligations and commitments under the Code of Conduct. Companies will also maintain an internal monitoring system that outlines the obligations each company will undertake to ensure that the Code is enforced in its facilities and its contractors' facilities both domestically and internationally.
- **Commitment to Form an Association Over the Next Six Months** that will (1) recruit new member companies which also will abide by the Code and implement independent monitoring; (2) **develop a reliable, independent means to provide for public confidence that the above obligations are being met;** and (3) develop a mechanism or seal of approval informing consumers about which companies abide by the Code and monitoring.

DETAILS ON THE APPAREL INDUSTRY PARTNERSHIP AGREEMENT

The Apparel Industry Partnership agreement contains the following:

- **A Strong Workplace Code of Conduct** that individual companies will voluntarily adopt and require their contractors to adopt, which includes:
 - The prohibition of employing any persons under the age of 15 (unless permitted by the country of manufacture to be 14);
 - Prohibitions against any worker abuse or harassment and discrimination;
 - The recognition and respect for workers' rights of freedom of association and collective bargaining;
 - The requirement that employers pay at least the minimum or prevailing industry wage, whichever is higher, and provide mandated benefits;
 - The requirement that workers be provided with a safe and healthy working environment;
 - A cap on mandatory overtime to 12 hours per week and the regular work week of the country (or 48 hours, whichever is less); and requiring a day off in every seven day period; and
 - The requirement that overtime be compensated for at the premium rate required in the country or at least equal to their regular hourly compensation.

- **Independent External Monitors** who will conduct independent reviews of participating company policies and practices; provide company employees and contractors' employees with secure communication channels to report concerns of noncompliance; audit production records and practices to ensure compliance; conduct employee interviews and site visits; and verify that the company is in compliance with its obligations and commitments under the Code of Conduct.

- **An Internal Monitoring System** that outlines the obligations each company will undertake to ensure that the Code of Conduct is enforced in its facilities and its contractors' facilities both domestically and internationally.

- **A Commitment to Form an Association** over the next six months that will:
 - Recruit new member companies which also will abide by the Code and implement independent monitoring;
 - **Develop a reliable, independent means to provide for public confidence that the above obligations are being met;** and
 - Develop a mechanism or seal of approval informing consumers about which companies abide by the Code and monitoring.

The group agrees to report back in six months.

- December 1996** Department of Labor's "No Sweat" Initiative receives Innovations in American Government Award from the Ford Foundation and John F. Kennedy School of Government.
- January 1997** Clinton Administration has collected more than \$10.4 million in back wages for minimum wage and overtime violations for more than 34,000 garment workers across the country.
- February 1997** Labor Department pledges funding to International Labor Organizations' initiative against child labor in the Pakistani soccer ball industry.
- March 25, 1997** Three companies added to the Trendsetter List, bringing the total to 34 companies representing over 125 apparel lines and tens of thousands of retail stores.

Thank you for your letter.

I am concerned about violence against abortion clinics. As a nation committed to the rule of law, we cannot allow vigilantes to restrict the rights of American women. No person seeking medical care and no physician providing that care should have to endure harassment, threats, or intimidation.

While the Freedom of Access to Clinic Entrances Act makes it a federal crime for protesters to use force or physical obstruction with the intention of injuring, intimidating, or interfering with individuals seeking or providing abortion-related services, it does protect the right to peaceful assembly.

Personal privacy is a fundamental liberty protected by the Constitution. The right to privacy includes the freedom to make difficult and intensely personal decisions regarding abortion, without governmental interference. I support a woman's constitutional right to make this difficult decision, but I believe that we must reduce the need for abortion. By providing better family planning services and improved education programs, we can help reduce the number of abortions. In addition, I believe that abstinence and sex education should be taught.

I hope that our common concerns for the future of America will unite us. I appreciate your sincerity and your candor.

One idea for a pre-summit event that Harris & co. are very pumped up about strikes me as somewhat dull -- but I wanted to check it out with you.

It's called the "Partnering Initiative." In a nutshell, I think the news here is that a bunch of education groups are endorsing the concept of service-learning in schools for the first time. So it's big news in the service world, but it doesn't strike me as event material.

Groups signing on include the Foundation on Economic Trends, NEA, PTA, AFT, Council on Chief State School Officers, and National Association of Secondary School Principals. I'm not sure what this means, but Jeremy Rifkin is very involved. They actually plan to announce this at the National Press Club on April 14, but would be flexible on dates, venue for a WH event.

The only hook they have to offer is that this is some kind of call to action on service in schools. We could certainly search for a better hook

if you like this idea.

Options

- 1) Funds in 1999-2002 to help long-term recipients in high unemployment/high poverty areas go to work and keep jobs. Funds would be added to TANF but earmarked for work.

- 4) Funds for vouchers for training, job creation, and job placement to help long-term recipients in high unemployment/high poverty areas go to work and keep jobs. Funds would be added to TANF, earmarked for vouchers for individuals.
- 5) Funds in Title XX Social Services block grant, which states could use for work or child care.
- 6) Child Care:
 - a) Make Child and Dependent Care Tax Credit refundable. Cost: bet. \$2-\$5 billion. (Mark Mazur costing specific options by 4/15.)
 - b) Increase the Child and Dependent Care Tax Credit amount to \$3,600 for one child and \$5,400 for two. Increase could be phased in over time. (Mark Mazur costing specific options by 4/15.)
 - c) \$1.4 billion through 2002 for working poor families that CBO says is needed to keep them from getting short-changed by welfare reform (Dodd-Daschle). (This week, CBO is redoing its analysis of the shortfall -- dollar amount would change accordingly.)
 - d) Tax credit to companies for costs of building, renovating and/or operating child care centers (50% credit for eligible activities up to \$150,000 per year per business). Cost: \$2.6 billion (Kohl). (Because this proposal would subsidize already operating centers, Mark Mazur is developing an option that would subsidize only the expansion or creation of new centers, which would cost less.)
 - e) Loan forgiveness tax credit in President's budget which could be used for

individuals becoming child care workers. Cost: minimal.

SUBJECT: FDR MEMORIAL CONTROVERSY - STATUS REPORT

On May 2, you will speak at the FDR Memorial dedication ceremony. The disability community, dissatisfied that the Memorial fails to depict FDR in a wheelchair, is planning a protest at the ceremony.

Following a March 24 decision memo that recommended calling upon the FDR Memorial Commission to incorporate into the Memorial an additional sculpture of FDR in his wheelchair, Erskine called Senator Inouye, Chairman of the FDR Memorial Commission, to discuss our position. After Senator Inouye disapproved of having the Commission modify the Memorial, we consulted with the Department of Interior and determined that only Congress, through legislation, has the authority to modify the Memorial.

We are planning several steps to defuse the controversy. First, after we place a courtesy call to Senator Inouye informing him of our actions, we plan to begin a dialogue with Senator Harkin (D-IA) and Cleland (D-GA) on introducing legislation to modify the Memorial. We will then accept a request from leaders of the disability community to discuss this issue at the White House with senior staff. At this meeting, we will communicate our support for efforts in Congress to modify the Memorial. We will also release a Presidential statement prior to the May 2 ceremony endorsing an additional Memorial sculpture of FDR in his wheelchair.

This week, we received a statement from sixteen of FDR's grandchildren calling for, "a permanent, meaningful portrayal in the Memorial of FDR's disability." President Bush, President Carter, and President Ford have written to expressed their support for depicting FDR in his wheelchair.

On April 12, Texas State Representative Ciro Rodrigues defeated fellow Democrat Jan Solis in a runoff election to fill the late Rep. Frank Tejeda's seat for Texas's 28th Congressional District. Rodrigues will be a member of the House National Security Committee, as the House Democratic leaders promised, but does not yet know his other committee assignment.

On Friday, April 18, Deputy Director John Koskinen will testify before the House Government Reform Committee regarding debt collection improvement.

CONGRESS TODAY (4/14):

SENATE

The Senate continued consideration of S. 104, the Nuclear Waste Policy Act of 1997.

The bill would also require that the President sanction countries that engage in chemical weapons activities, and would provide the death penalty for violations of the law that lead to the loss of life.
