SUPPLEMENTAL

The Disaster/Bosnia Supplemental Conference will take place tomorrow at 11:00 am. After the weekly policy luncheons, the Conferees intend to meet again at 5:00 pm and continue until they are finished. The House Rules

Committee announced that they plan to take up both the Supplemental and the Budget Resolution Conference Reports on Wednesday, though that schedule may get pushed back.

BUDGET RESOLUTION -- SENATE BUDGET COMMITTEE

Early Monday evening, the Senate Budget Committee voted to report the budget resolution to the Senate by a vote of 17-4 (no votes were: Gramm, Grams, Hollings, Sarbanes). Floor action will begin Tuesday afternoon. The Committee took the following action on amendments during the mark-up:

- o Conrad Sense of Senate amendment urging efforts on structural entitlement reforms and making CPI more accurate:

Approved 17-4

- o Wyden amendment to remove the +98 and +99 firewalls; and reduce defense spending to last year's budget resolution level: Defeated 6-15

- o Bond/Durbin/Conrad/Hollings sense of Senate to increase self-employed health deduction to 100 percent: Approved by voice vote

- o Murray sense of Senate that function 500 includes adequate resources for teacher training in technology: Defeated 10-11

- o Murray sense of Senate on adequate resources for early childhood development and education: Defeated 10-11

BUDGET RESOLUTION -- HOUSE RULES COMMITTEE

The House Rules Committee today adopted the rule to consider H.R. 84, the Budget Resolution, which will go to the House floor on Tuesday. The rule is a modified closed rule, and provides for 5 hours of debate.

The Rule makes in order the following five amendments:

- 1 Congressional Black Caucus (Waters/Thompson) substitute amendment, which does not provide for any new tax cuts until the budget balances in 2002. The amendment fully funds a child health initiative to cover all 10 million uninsured children, includes \$25.5 billion in Medicare savings, and includes the President's \$20.6 billions in welfare addbacks. (60 minutes debate)

- 2 Doolittle substitute amendment, which balances the budget by 2002, increases tax cuts by \$109.3 billion, reduces NDD spending, and allows a point of order to be raised against any concurrent resolution on the budget or on any bill that would cause total outlays to exceed total receipts in 2002 or thereafter. (20 minutes debate)

- 3 Brown's investment substitute amendment, which balances the budget by 2002, and provides for tax cuts only after the budget is actually balanced. The amendment provides increases in investments including R&D, transportation, and education and training. It offsets the increases by limiting defense spending, incorporating the Medicare reform proposals from the Budget Agreement, and including the reductions in unwarranted benefits proposed by the President. (20 minutes debate)

- 4 Kennedy substitute amendment, which spends \$100 billion more than the Budget Agreement in priority areas of health, education, transportation, R&D, and economic development.

- 5 Shuster substitute amendment, which increases outlays from the Transportation Trust fund over 5 years to equal revenues over that period. (20 minutes debate)

If the House adopts a substitute amendment, its adoption concludes consideration of the concurrent resolution, and precludes consideration of the other amendments. The Minge amendment -- which included Sense of the Congress enforcement language to include a mechanism to trigger cuts in entitlement programs and to sunset tax cuts if projections prove to be inaccurate -- was not made in order. Chairman Kasich, however, will give Minge 20 minutes of floor time to talk about his amendment. In addition, the rule waives the so-called Gephardt Rule, which means that they will address the debt ceiling as a part of the reconciliation, rather than automatically altering the debt limit upon adoption of the resolution. Bruce, Elena, Rahm:

After reviewing the draft Meth and drug testing, here are my reactions:

1. Meth report shows our strategy is working. Substantive and newsworthy items include: (1) preliminary '96 data show that meth use is down from 7 to 52 percent in most cities; (2) clandestine lab seizures have increased 170% (from 326 in '95 to 879 in '96), and '97 seizures are escalating; (3) increased meth penalties recently released by Sentencing Commission and will take effect on 11/1/97; and (4) good, recent anecdotes on successful prosecutions -- including life for meth dealers -- and lab seizures.

The report also discusses state and local cooperation, law enforcement training, treatment, meth awareness campaign, improved efforts from Mexico (1 ton of precursor chemicals seized last year), and precursor chemicals.

2. Update on Operation Drug TEST not ready. The report on drug testing still needs considerable work. Problems include: (1) more than a year later, not all 25 cities have program running (only 19); (2) no numbers/impact to report; (3) mostly a re-hash of original EO and proposed guidelines -- essentially no anecdotes; and (4) does not address issue of treatment -- to what extent are we treating offenders that test positive?

Rec: Play up the meth report and Treasury's GTO; hold the drug testing report. Also, get with DOJ on improving the criminal justice drug testing/treatment report. It's too important an anti-drug and crime initiative to get such short shrift. Here are some initial thoughts on improving the report: (1) Focus on cost-benefit of testing/treatment, along the lines of new RAND report; (2) broaden to include state and local efforts, like crime bill-funded "drug courts"; and (3) included new actions with reports -- Drug Testing Czar (in Dennis memo)? Directive/guidelines for states to adopt comprehensive testing/treatment? Push for testing/treatment dollars in juvie bill? Release of drug court funds? I follow-up on these and check DB's files for more. I know he was talking to Mark Kleiman about some ideas.

II. BACKGROUND

You will be addressing CEOs and senior executives from over 100 companies that have joined the Welfare to Work Partnership. The Welfare to Work Partnership is an independent, nonpartisan, national effort which has pledged to enlist 1,000 companies within the next six months to help move those on public assistance into jobs in the private sector. The Partnership was formed in response to your challenge in the State of the Union, and the CEOs from the companies you noted in that speech -- Sprint, Monsanto, UPS, Burger King, and United Airlines -- form the Partnership's Board of Directors. At this event, United Airlines Corporation CEO Gerald Greenwald will be named the Chairman of the Board.

Today President Clinton announced that over 100 companies have accepted his State of the Union challenge to forge "a new national effort to marshal America's businesses, large and small, to create jobs so that people can move from welfare to work."

- CEOs and senior executives from over 100 companies joined the President to launch the Welfare to Work Partnership, a private, non-profit organization which will lead the national business effort to hire people from the welfare rolls. The Partnership pledged to enlist 1,000 companies within the next six months and named United Airlines Corporation CEO Gerald Greenwald its Chairman of the Board.
- Citing transportation as one of the biggest barriers in moving from welfare to work, President Clinton today announced grants to 24 states to develop strategies to solve this problem. The President urged Congress to enact his \$600 million welfare to work transportation initiative, part of his NEXTEA transportation proposal, and he praised a similar bipartisan bill introduced today by Senators Arlen Specter (R-PA) and Frank R. Lautenberg (D-NJ).
- The President praised the new budget agreement which includes two critical welfare to work initiatives. The first is a \$3 billion Welfare to Work fund for cities and states to create jobs and provide incentives for employment. This proposal, a centerpiece of the President's second-term agenda, will help move one million adults from welfare to work. The budget agreement also includes the President's proposed enhanced tax credit which would give companies that hire long-term welfare recipients a 50 tax credit on the first \$10,000 of wages paid over two years.
- To ensure that former welfare recipients succeed in the workplace, Vice President Gore announced a new campaign, beginning with a conference on May 29th, to help those who leave welfare retain jobs.

The President was joined today by the Vice President, Mr. Greenwald, Partnership President Eli J. Segal, Delaware Governor Tom Carper, Wisconsin Governor Tommy Thompson, and small business owner George R. Stinson of Racine, Wisconsin, whose company workforce is more than half former welfare recipients.

The Welfare to Work Partnership

The Welfare to Work Partnership is an independent, nonpartisan, national effort of the American business community to help move those on public assistance into jobs in the private sector. The Partnership will provide information, technical assistance, and support for all interested companies. The Partnership was formed in response to the President's challenge in his 1997 State of the Union speech, and the CEOs from the five companies the President noted in that speech -- Sprint, Monsanto, UPS, Burger King, and United Airlines -- form the Partnership's Board of Directors. Since signing the welfare law last August, the President has launched an aggressive campaign to challenge both the public and private sector to help welfare reform succeed. The President signaled his commitment to work with the corporate community by holding a White House meeting with 14 company CEOs in

January 1997. After that meeting five companies made a commitment to lead a national welfare to work effort.

The President's Welfare to Work Transportation Initiative

One of the biggest barriers faced by people moving from welfare to work is finding transportation. Two-thirds of new jobs are in the suburbs, but three of four welfare recipients live in rural areas or central cities. Only six percent of welfare recipients own cars, and public transit often provides inadequate connections to job and training centers.

To combat this problem, the President today urged Congress to adopt the six-year, \$600 million grant program in his NEXTEA transportation bill that would support flexible, innovative transportation systems in rural, urban, and suburban areas to get people where the jobs are. A similar bill was introduced today in the Senate by Senators Arlen Specter (R-Pa) and Frank R. Lautenberg (D-NJ). Today, the President also announced grants to 24 states and the Virgin Islands to develop welfare to work transportation plans. The grants are being awarded by the Department of Transportation's Federal Transit Administration and the Federal Highway Administration in cooperation with the National Governors' Association.

SUNDAY: PRESIDENT CALLS FOR COMMITMENT TO DEVELOP AIDS VACCINE

Yesterday, at Morgan State University, in his first commencement address at a historically black college, President Clinton announced new actions to harness the forces of science and technology so that they work for us, not against us, in the 21st Century:

- The President called for a national commitment to develop an AIDS vaccine within the next decade, announcing that the National Institutes of Health will establish a new AIDS vaccine research center; pledging to enlist other nations in this crusade at next month's Summit of the Eight in Denver; and challenging America's pharmaceutical industry to make the development of an AIDS vaccine part of its basic mission.
- To make sure that no insurer is able to use genetic data to underwrite or discriminate against any American seeking health insurance, the President urged Congress to pass legislation to prohibit insurance companies from using genetic screening information to determine premium rates or eligibility.
- President Clinton laid out four guideposts, rooted in our traditional principles of ethics and morals, that must guide us if we are to master the powerful forces of change in the new century: "One, science that produces a better life for all and not the few. Two, science that honors our tradition of equal treatment under the law. Three, science that respects the privacy and autonomy of the individual. Four, science that never confuses faith in technology with faith in God."

SATURDAY: PRESIDENT URGES PASSAGE OF BEST EDUCATION BILL IN A GENERATION: THE BALANCED BUDGET

In his weekly Radio Address, President Clinton hailed the balanced budget agreement's historic investment in education, including the most significant increase in education funding in 30 years, and the single largest increase in higher education since the G.I. Bill in 1945:

- It will fund the America Reads challenge, to help every 8-year-old learn to read; and the Technology Literacy Initiative, to help wire every classroom and school library to the Internet by the year 2000.
- It includes \$35 billion in tax relief for higher education -- including HOPE Scholarship tuition tax credits, a \$10,000 education tax deduction, and the largest increase in Pell Grant scholarships for deserving students in two decades.
- It expands Head Start, increases job training, and preserves our commitment to school-to-work initiatives, to help give young people the tools they need to succeed.
