Elena,

Thanks for your note. I think that a decision process on the taxation of workfare benefits should not pre-judge the outcome, and so I respectfully disagree with your proposal to limit the process to filling in the details of how workfare benefits should be non-taxable (for income and FICA purposes). The DPC/NEC work group is likely to end up with this conclusion, but I would prefer to hear this issue out (I know Treasury has done some thinking about the appropriate tax treatment and that some NEC staffers feel very strongly that workfare benefits should be subject to income tax, so that recipients can qualify for the EITC). Personally, my feeling is that the benefits are akin to welfare (AFDC) benefits and should be treated the same, but if presented with persuasive evidence to the contrary, my beliefs could also change.

Is there a problem with seriously looking at this issue anew?

TUESDAY: HISTORIC NATO-RUSSIA PARTNERSHIP IS ESTABLISHED

This morning in Paris, President Clinton joined with French President Chirac, Russian President Yelstin and NATO Secretary-General Javier Solana for the historic signing of the NATO-Russia Founding Act:

- The Founding Act establishes a new partnership between NATO and Russia -- bridging Europe's Cold War divide, and taking a major new step toward an undivided, democratic, peaceful Europe for the first time in history.
- From now on, NATO and Russia will consult and coordinate and work together; where all agree, they will act jointly, as they are in Bosnia. NATO will no longer be an alliance against a hostile bloc of nations, but instead it will advance the security of every democracy in Europe -- old NATO members, new members, and non-members alike.
- President Clinton said: "We establish this partnership because we are determined to create a future in which European security is not a zero-sum game -- where NATO's gain is Russia's loss, and Russia's strength is our alliance's weakness. That is old thinking; these are new times. Together, we must build a new Europe in which every nation is free and every free nations joins in strengthening the peace and stability for all."

WEDNESDAY: PRESIDENT DELIVERS MAJOR ADDRESS TO THE EUROPEAN PEOPLE ON FUTURE OF U.S.-EUROPEAN RELATIONS

Tomorrow in the Hague, President Clinton will lay out his vision of the future U.S.-European relations -- and the goal of building a European continent that is undivided, democratic, and peaceful for the first time in history -- at a gathering with leaders from all over Europe to commemorate the 50th anniversary of the Marshall Plan.

At our week-end meeting with the Denver Summit Sherpas, the French Sherpa proposed that the following paragraph be added to the Communique. All agreed to consider the French proposal and to consult with capitals in order to properly respond to it.

[Human cloning:

We have taken note with great concern of recent scientific experiments which could open the way to reproductive human cloning. We agree that the prohibition of any form of reproductive human cloning needs both strict domestic legislation and close international cooperation to adapt current international law. We are encouraged by the reflections underway within national ethics committees as well as in various regional and international fora. We are determined to give a strong impetus to their work with a view to arriving as soon as possible at a universal ban on reproductive human cloning.]

We will be receiving comments from other countries tomorrow on this and other sections of the draft communique, and will prepare a revised draft by the end of the week. Justice, in their preliminary conversations with Republicans, are trying to get a prevention "carve out" in the inevitable Republican block grant to be included in the Republican mark. The notion then is that the R's, if they agree to a prevention "carve out," will pretty much let us submit our own language -- and that we will then be able to come up with language that satisfies both Rahm and the Dems interested in prevention. Ultimately, I think we need a bit more room to work with prevention language than Rahm has indicated, and that's why I agreed with Kent. Also worth noting: Education called me Friday and today. They're concerned that our adding new after school language to the juvie bill will only doom funding for their own effort. SUBJECT: EDUCATION SCHEDULING PROPOSALS

Following is a list of four upcoming education events that we have requested the President and/or another principle attend. To help you prioritize these requests, you should know that we will be ready to announce the recommendations of the Interagency Working Group on Improving Math and Science Education at any of these events. It is important that the President participate in at least one of these events so that he can make the new announcements on math standards and continue to highlight his call for national standards in both reading and math.

- June 10 **Release of 4th Grade Results the Third International Mathematics and Science Study (TIMSS)**. The results show the U.S. above the international average in 4th grade math. This is good news and it gives the President an opportunity to positively highlight the importance of national math standards and competing globally.
- June 11-13 **1996 Presidential Awards for Excellence in Science and Mathematics Teaching for Elementary School Teachers**. If this is President does not participate, the Vice President or First Lady should host the ceremony.
- June 24-28 **1996 Presidential Award for Excellence in Science and Mathematics Teaching for Secondary School Teachers**. The First Lady has been requested, but this event would also be suitable for the President's message event on math standards if this is the only time it can be scheduled.
- July 1 **Release of a Link-Report of the National Assessment of Educational Progress (NAEP) and the Third International Math and Science Study (TIMSS)**. This report compares math and science scores of individual states to other countries. This event promises to receive the most press coverage since it provides data specific to each of the 40 states that participated in the studies.

In addition to the above events, we have also requested that the President participate in an event on July 2 at Camden Yards to launch a PSA campaign on educational standards featuring major league baseball players. The Business Roundtable, NGA, AFT, NAB, Major League Baseball, and Department of Education are the sponsors of the PSA campaign.
