MEMORANDUM FOR THE PRESIDENT

SUBJECT: Cloning Policy Options

Two upcoming events create the need to develop a position on legislation banning the cloning of human beings. First, the National Bioethics Advisory Commission (NBAC) is about to complete the review you requested of the ethical and legal issues associated with cloning human beings. On Saturday, June 7, at its final public meeting, NBAC is expected to vote in favor of a legislative ban. Second, France has proposed that the Denver Summit communique include a paragraph urging countries to pass domestic legislative bans, and to work together toward a global ban.

We recommend: (1) that you support domestic legislation banning human cloning, and that you announce specific legislation at the top of your June 10th press conference; and (2) that the U.S. support France's proposed cloning paragraph while insisting on critical modifications.

**DISCUSSION**

**NBAC's Findings and Recommendations**

In its draft final report, NBAC unanimously concludes that **"it is morally unacceptable for anyone . . . to attempt to create a child"** using the technology that created Dolly the sheep -- that is, the transfer of the nucleus from an adult somatic (non egg or sperm) cell into an enucleated egg. NBAC bases this conclusion on safety concerns, finding that the technology is "likely to involve substantial risk to the potential child." The report also states that "serious ethical concerns... require a great deal more widespread and careful thought and public deliberation before this technology should be used."

The Commission notes that current restrictions effectively prohibit federally funded and regulated entities from attempting to clone a human being through somatic cell nuclear transfer. However, fertility clinics and other privately-funded clinical and research establishments face no prohibition on human cloning. NBAC expresses doubt in certain organizations' willingness to adhere to a voluntary moratorium.

NBAC clarifies that some forms of "human cloning" -- such as the cloning of DNA sequences, cell lines, and tissues -- are scientifically important and not ethically problematic. Moreover, NBAC finds that nuclear transfer cloning in animals is ethically acceptable and promises

important benefits. Hence, NBAC concludes that restrictions on cloning should preclude these activities.

Accordingly, NBAC calls for carefully-worded national legislation prohibiting anyone from "attempting to create a child through somatic cell nuclear transfer techniques." The Commission specifies that the legislation should include a sunset provision and that, prior to the sunset date, an oversight body should review and report on the status of somatic cell nuclear transfer technology and the ethical and social issues associated with its use in humans. NBAC also recommends that the U.S. cooperate with other countries to enforce mutually-supported cloning restrictions.

### **National Legislation**

We recommend that you embrace NBAC's proposal to establish a narrowly crafted time-limited legislative moratorium. Legislation is the only way to establish a comprehensive, enforceable prohibition on cloning entire human beings in all research and clinical settings. If carefully written, it will not preclude important research.

Reaction to proposed legislation should be primarily favorable. A national and international consensus is emerging that attempting to apply the technology used to clone Dolly to humans is morally wrong. The American Medical Association has conveyed this view to NBAC, and the World Medical Association has issued a similar statement. Given NBAC's recommendation, we expect many in the scientific and ethics communities to support a legislative moratorium.

But some who agree that cloning a human being using nuclear somatic cell transfer is morally unacceptable will oppose a legislated moratorium. In particular, the biotechnology and pharmaceutical industries strongly oppose legislation. These two industries are deeply concerned that a legislative debate will produce broadly drawn language that impairs critical research. Some academic researchers may share this view. Fertility clinics may also oppose legislation, but to date have not signaled a position. Finally, some in the right-to-life community will argue that NBAC's proposed approach will not fully protect embryos.

We recommend that you announce your support for legislation and propose specific legislative language on June 10, at your scheduled press conference, three days after NBAC's recommendation will become public. By acting quickly you can maintain your leadership on the issue and carefully frame the legislative debate. As a practical matter, the biotechnology and pharmaceutical industry associations understand you may choose to take this approach and, notwithstanding their opposition to a bill, have quietly advised us on legislative language.

### **Group of Eight Statement on Cloning**

France has proposed the following paragraph for inclusion in the G-8 communique:

*We have taken note with great concern of recent scientific experiments which could open the way to reproductive human cloning. We agree that the prohibition of any form of reproductive human cloning needs both strict domestic legislation and close international cooperation to adapt current international law. We are encouraged by the reflections underway within national ethics committees as well as in various regional and international fora. We are determined to give a strong impetus to their work with a view to arriving as soon as possible at a universal ban on reproductive human cloning.*

Germany will support the statement; Canada will support it with some modification.

U.S. biotechnology and pharmaceutical industries strongly oppose including any paragraph on cloning in the communique. They fear that it will not be carefully drafted and may inadvertently extend to the cloning of genes and cells as well as entire human beings. Further, industry is concerned a statement on cloning could ultimately provide cover for protectionist efforts to restrict U.S. biotechnology products and activities.

Nevertheless, we recommend that the Administration support the french proposal with critical modifications. Specifically, we suggest that the U.S. insist on changes to: (1) affirm the potential medical and agricultural benefits of cloning technology; (2) limit the prohibition to "the use of somatic cell nuclear transfer technology to create a child;" and (3) propose a time-limited moratorium instead of a ban. USDA and HHS support this position.

RE: \$3 BILLION WELFARE TO WORK PROPOSAL

**Administration Proposal**

As you know, Bruce Reed engaged in a series of conversations last week with Secretaries Herman, Shalala, and Cuomo regarding the \$3 billion welfare to work fund included in the budget agreement. As a result, the attached one-page document, "Administration's Welfare to Work Jobs Challenge Proposal" was faxed to the Hill and other interested parties on Friday.

This document reflects five key principles upon which we have Administration-wide agreement:

1. Welfare to work funds -- no less than the 50% specified in our proposal -- should go directly to cities, and cities should be subject to the same rules and application processes as states.
2. Funds should be awarded competitively, to promising welfare to work projects, not distributed based on a formula. Under this enterprise zone model, the grants would be awarded by the Department of Labor in consultation with HHS and HUD.
3. At least some funds -- 20 percent in our proposal -- shall be distributed as performance based bonuses, to encourage the job placement and retention of long-term welfare recipients living in high poverty/high unemployment areas.
4. Public service jobs should be allowed in high unemployment areas and on Indian reservations.
5. Strong language forbidding worker displacement should be included.

Bruce's conversations with the Secretaries were a follow-up to an inter-agency staff meeting held Monday, May 19th. At that meeting, attended by senior staff from DPC, NEC, CEA, HHS, Dept. of Labor, and HUD, there was a strong sentiment that the Cabinet officials had to be directly consulted on the program structure, particularly the issue of which agency, HHS or DOL, would take the lead and how funds would be distributed.

## Background

The President proposed the \$3 billion Welfare to Work Jobs Challenge during the 1996 campaign and included it as part of his budget proposal. The \$3 billion fund was included in the final bipartisan budget agreement. Currently, House Ways and Means Democratic and Republican committee staff are developing detailed proposals, and they have asked for our input. Key differences among the proposals include:

- Do funds flow directly to cities? Ever since the proposal was announced during the campaign, the mayors have expected 100% of funds to flow directly to them, although Bruce and Gene Sperling said they were always careful to describe the plan as 50% to cities and 50% to states. A key question is whether the funds will go directly to the cities or flow through the states to the cities. Administration officials, the mayors, and our union allies all feel strongly that some funds should flow directly to the cities -- thus our proposal sends 50% to them. The budget agreement, and the draft Ways and Means GOP document, distribute funds to the cities through the states (the budget agreement says funds are "allocated to states" and "a share of funds would go to cities/counties..."). The House Ways and Means Democrats would provide funds to both states and communities (percentage is unspecified).
- Are funds awarded competitively or by formula? Again, there is strong sentiment within the Administration and among our allies that grants should be awarded on a competitive basis in order to target scarce funds to successful welfare to work efforts. In particular, since not all cities run welfare to work programs, we concluded it would not make sense to provide funds to cities that do not do so. The House Ways and Means Democrats agree with us that funds should be awarded competitively. The House Ways and Means Republicans award 100% of funds to states, 80% of which must be distributed to political subdivisions within the state based on a formula determined in part by the governor. The budget agreement allocated funds "to States through a formula and targeted within a State to areas with poverty and unemployment rates at least 20 percent higher than the State average. A share of funds would go to cities/counties with large poverty populations commensurate with the share of long-term welfare recipients in those jurisdictions."

**Displacement.** Our proposal, and the House Democratic one, makes specific references to safeguards to prevent worker displacement; the House GOP document does not.

Quick update on today's meeting. Sylvia handed out a draft of the "initiative" that we had to be returned after the meeting. Basically, it included the following:

Three goals: (1) promote dialogue and improve understanding of race; (2) increase understanding of the nation's diversity and where it's taking us (demographics, trends?); and (3) focus the nation on the issue and what we can do (approaches, solutions, but also raising issue to new level..i.e., environmental analogy..?).

Five proposed activities: (1) Commission and staff; (2) Presidential event each month for the next year, including 4 town halls and the White House conference on Hate Crimes; (3) the President's/Commission's report to the American people; (4) website for comments; and (5) miscellaneous -- and unannounced policy pieces in the areas of the economy opportunity, housing, health care, education and criminal justice.

SUBJECT: Welfare to Work Proposal

Attached for your information is the one-pager we sent out late last week outlining the Administration's position on the design of the \$3 billion welfare-to-work fund. Also attached are one-page summaries of two other proposals, by the House Ways and Means Republicans and by House Democrats.

We held a productive meeting this afternoon with the Departments of Labor, HHS, HUD, and Treasury. It appears this process is moving quickly, with House Ways and Means planning to develop its draft legislation this weekend. We agreed that we should emphasize the following list of priorities to House Ways and Means staff at our meeting tomorrow morning:

- At least (?) 50% of the funds should go to cities. (The House Republican proposal would funnel all the money to states.)
- All the funds should be distributed on a competitive basis, with a preference to areas with high poverty and unemployment. A portion of the funds should be set aside as a performance-based bonus. (The House Republicans would distribute at least 80% of the funds on a formula basis.)
- States and cities should be permitted to use the funds to create public sector jobs in areas of high unemployment. (The House Republicans would not permit this.)
- We must include strong language prohibiting worker displacement. (The House Republican draft does not include this.)

The House Democratic alternative is somewhat vague, but it basically comports with our views on all of these issues.

I should note how the exact language of the budget agreement compares with the issues above. It reads that the funds shall be "allocated to states through a formula and targeted within a State to areas" with high poverty and unemployment. "A share of the funds would go to cities/counties with large poverty populations...."

We still have a number of more technical issues where we must clarify the Administration's position, such as how the performance bonus would work, whether job training is an allowable use of the funds, and whether economic development projects that would employ welfare recipients would qualify for funding. The most important unresolved issue is one that Secretary Shalala will raise with you tomorrow. Now that we have clarified our position that the Department of Labor should administer this program, she does not believe that it should be part

of the TANF welfare block grant. Apparently Hill staff have been receptive to this idea, even though the budget agreement refers to this as being part of TANF.

### **Cocaine Sentencing**

Last month, the U.S. Sentencing Commission released a special report to Congress containing new recommendations on sentencing for cocaine offenses. [Unlike the Commission's recommendations issued in October 1995, the proposed sentencing changes contained in the report require Congressional action before they could take effect.]

I commended the Sentencing Commission for moving forward with recommendations to Congress to reduce the disparity between crack and powder cocaine penalties. My Administration will give these recommendations very serious consideration. Director McCaffrey and Attorney General Reno are currently reviewing the recommendations and will be reporting back to me by June 29. I look forward to working with the Congress on this issue.

Current law creates a substantial disparity between sentences for crack and powder cocaine. This disparity has led to a perception of unfairness and inconsistency in the federal criminal justice system. Some adjustment to the cocaine penalty structure is warranted as a matter of sound criminal justice policy. However, the sentencing laws must continue to reflect that crack cocaine is a more harmful form of cocaine. The Sentencing Commission's new recommendations do so. Trafficking in crack, and the violence it fosters, has a devastating impact on communities across America, especially inner-city communities. Any change in penalties must ensure that more dangerous offenders receive tougher sentences.

### **Status Offenders**

My Anti-Gang and Youth Violence Act of 1997 does not propose a change from existing policy and practice on detention of status offenders. The bill would merely codify the federal regulatory changes enacted last December. These regulations make it permissible to hold a juvenile for up to 24 hours prior to, and immediately following, his or her initial court appearance (excluding holidays and weekends). The provisions will enable state and local governments to take into account the facts and circumstances of each juvenile taken into custody and provide for their appropriate placement.

Today in London, President Clinton with newly-elected Prime Minister Tony Blair. The two forward-looking leaders will continue to build a strong U.S.-U.K. partnership for the 21st Century:

- President Clinton and Prime Minister Blair will discuss issues of mutual concern, including Bosnia, Northern Ireland, Hong Kong, Iraq, NATO and new global threats such as international crime, terrorism, the environment and drugs.

### WEDNESDAY: PRESIDENT COMMEMORATES 50TH ANNIVERSARY OF MARSHALL PLAN, LOOKS AHEAD TO UNDIVIDED, DEMOCRATIC EUROPE

Yesterday in the Hague, President Clinton joined with leaders from throughout Europe to honor the accomplishments of the Marshall Plan on its 50th anniversary, and to summon the spirit of the Marshall Plan for the next 50 years and beyond --to build a Europe that is democratic, at peace, and undivided for the first time in history:

- The Marshall Plan planted the seeds of institutions that now bind Western Europe together --from the OECD to the European Union and NATO. It paved the way for reconciliation of age-old differences.
- Now, the end of the Cold War and the dawn of new democracies are lighting the way to a new Europe in a new century --a time in which America and Europe must complete the journey that Marshall's generation began --this time with no one left behind.
- NATO, the core of transatlantic security, can do for Europe's East what it did for Europe's West --defend freedom, strengthen democracy, temper old rivalries, hasten integration, and provide a stable climate in which prosperity can grow.
- As NATO prepares to meet in Madrid to offer membership to the first of Europe's new democracies, President Clinton pledged that "NATO's doors must, and will, remain open to all those able to share the responsibilities of membership. We will strengthen the Partnership for Peace and create a new Euro-Atlantic partnership council so that other nations can deepen their

cooperation with NATO and continue to prepare for membership.”

President Clinton said: “We who follow the example of the generation we honor today must...shape the peace, freedom and prosperity they made possible into a common future where all our people speak the language of democracy...where prosperity reaches clear across the continent and states pursue commerce, not conquest; where security is the province of all free nations working together; where no nation in Europe is ever again excluded against its will from joining our alliance of values; and where we join together to help the rest of the world reach the objectives we hold so dear.”
