FAIRCLOTH (AND OTHERS) AMENDMENT NO. 2421 (Senate - May 19, 1998)

[Page: S5135]

Mr. FAIRCLOTH (for himself, Mr. Sessions, and Mr. McConnell) proposed an amendment to the bill (S. 1415) to reform and restructure the processes by which tobacco products are manufactured, marketed, and distributed, to prevent the use of tobacco products by minors, to redress the adverse health effects of tobacco use, and for other purposes; as follows:

At the appropriate place, insert the following:

Sec. . Limit on Attorney's Fees.

(a) Fee Arrangements.--Subsection (f) shall apply to attorneys' fees provided for or in connection with an action of the type described in such subsection under any--

- (1) court order;
- (2) settlement agreement;
- (3) contingency fee arrangement;
- (4) arbitration procedure;
- (5) alternative dispute resolution procedure (including mediation);
- (6) retainer agreements; or
- (7) other arrangement providing for the payment of attorneys' fees.

(b) Requirements.--No award of attorneys' fees under any action to which this Act applies shall be made under this Act until the attorneys involved have--

- (1) provided to the Congress a detailed time accounting with respect to the work performed in relation to the legal action involved; and
- (2) made public disclosure of the time accounting under paragraph (1) and any fee arrangements entered into, or fee arrangements made, with respect to the legal action involved.

(c) Application.--This section shall apply to fees paid or to be paid to attorneys under any arrangement described in subsection (a)--

- (1) who acted on behalf of a State or political subdivision of a State in connection with any past litigation of an action maintained by a State against one or more tobacco companies to recover

tobacco-related medicaid expenditures;

(2) who acted on behalf of a State or political subdivision of a State in connection with any future litigation of an action maintained by a State against one or more tobacco companies to recover tobacco-related medicaid expenditures;

(3) who act at some future time on behalf of a State or political subdivision of a State in connection with any past litigation of an action maintained by a State against one or more tobacco companies to recover tobacco-related medicaid expenditures;

(4) who act at some future time on behalf of a State or political subdivision of a State in connection with any future litigation of an action maintained by a State against one or more tobacco companies to recover tobacco-related medicaid expenditures;

(5) who acted on behalf of a plaintiff class in civil actions to which this Act applies that are brought against participating or nonparticipating tobacco manufacturers;

(6) who act at some future time on behalf of a plaintiff class in civil actions to which this Act applies that are brought against participating or nonparticipating tobacco manufacturers;

(7) who acted on behalf of a plaintiff in civil actions to which this Act applies that are brought against participating or nonparticipating tobacco manufacturers;

(8) who act at some future time on behalf of a plaintiff in civil actions to which this Act applies that are brought against participating or nonparticipating tobacco manufacturers;

(9) who expended efforts that in whole or in part resulted in or created a model for programs in this Act;

(10) who acted on behalf of a defendant in any of the matters set forth in paragraphs (1) through (9) of this subsection; or

(11) who act at some future time on behalf of a defendant in any of the matters set forth in paragraphs (1) through (9) of this subsection.

(d) Report.--

(1) Each attorney whose fees for services already rendered are subject to subsection (a) shall, within 60 days of the date of the enactment of this Act, submit to Committees on the Judiciary of the House of Representatives and the Senate a comprehensive record of the time and expenses for which the fees are to be paid. Such record shall be subject to section 1001(a) of title 18, United States Code.

(2) Each attorney whose fees for services rendered in the future are subject to subsection (a) shall, within 60 days of the completion of the attorney's services, submit to Committees on the Judiciary of the House of Representatives and the Senate a comprehensive record of the time and expenses for which the fees are to be paid. Such record shall be subject to section 1001(a) of title 18, United States Code.

(e) Severability.--If any provision of this section or the application of such provision to any person or circumstance is held to be unconstitutional, the remainder of this section and the application of the provisions of such to any person or circumstance shall not be affected thereby.

(f) General Limitation.--Notwithstanding any other provision of law, for each hour spent productively and at risk, separate from the reimbursement of actual out-of-pocket expenses as approved by the court in such action, any attorneys' fees or expenses paid to attorneys for matters described in subsection (c) shall not exceed \$250 per hour.

Subject: Good job!

I saw you on CNN last night. You did a good job and you looked good too. More importantly, tobacco legislation is moving forward. Congratulations!

The public health community is fretting over Coverdell, Gramm, etc. because they are adding them up and worrying that there are no \$\$ left for public health. I disagree. I think they need to refocus on what is important -- we are still in position to win this. We need to stay focused on our bottom line: 50% reduction in youth smoking in 7 years. To achieve it we need 3 things: as big a price hike as possible, full FDA authority, and a number probably below \$13B for tobacco control programs.

The biggest problem now is floor discipline -- the Rs now have it and despite hard work by all of the groups we don't. So far we are lucky that the Rs have not used their discipline to go after the essential components of reaching our 50% goal. But that is likely to change before the Senate completes its work. We need to redeploy our forces, and stop wasting time fighting fights we can't win and instead prepare for fights we must win, like Hatch.

We need to find the Rs to eventually lock down 60 votes for cloture. Koop and the health groups have been working hard at this. I'm not sure what their count is, but they are making progress in the reports I have received (they claim Bennett is their latest pick-up). But probably more important right now, we need 50 votes to defeat amendments that will keep us from our 50% goal. The public health groups should stop wasting their capital on amendments like Coverdell and Gramm and line up the needed Rs to defeat truly damaging amendments. If we are lucky, a victory over Hatch could shift momentum and provide us with a disciplined 50 votes that will not only defeat the amendments we need to, but possibly pass one or two to surreptitiously drive up the price such as eliminating tax deductibility.

Finally, here is my view of the \$\$\$. Months ago in a Nickles staff meeting, you remarked off the cuff that in the end the \$\$\$ would be split 3 ways between the states, Rs, and Admin/Ds. Even with Coverdell and Gramm we are not far from that. Moreover we have flexibility. Research dollars can be found elsewhere in the budget, Rs are as committed as we are to increasing NIH's budget. Farmers may end up with less than \$10B, they shouldn't have been so greedy in the first place. We could always require some of the state \$\$\$ to fund programs like ASSIST. And we can probably do adequate tobacco control for less than \$13B.

The Administration appreciates the concerns of the sponsors of S. 1645 about fostering parental and family involvement in a minor's decision to obtain an abortion and their concerns about overbearing and sometimes predatory adults who improperly influence minors' abortion decisions. The Administration believes, however, that changes must be made to ensure that S. 1645 is appropriately tailored to achieve these important goals. The Administration would support properly crafted legislation that would make it illegal to transport minors across state lines for the purposes of avoiding parental involvement requirements, but strongly opposes S.1645 unless these changes are made.

First, S. 1645 must be amended to exclude close family members from criminal and civil liability. Under the legislation, grandmothers, aunts, and adult siblings could face criminal prosecution for coming to the aid of a relative in distress. Even a mother or father could be exposed to criminal penalty if she or he resides in a state that has a two parent notice or consent law. Imposing criminal and civil sanctions on family members for helping their relatives, however, would not further the interests of healthy family communications. Subjecting family members to criminal or civil sanction, moreover, would also further isolate the minor by discouraging her from seeking advice and counsel from those closest to her. Finally, creating a civil action that permits family members to sue each other when a minor within that family has an abortion would not serve the goal of fostering strong families.

Second, S. 1645 must be amended to ensure that persons who only provide information, counseling, referral, or medical services to the minor cannot be subject to liability. The bill as written, for example, could potentially subject a telephone receptionist, physician, or counselor to civil or criminal liability merely for informing an unnamed caller or patient about the availability of abortion services. Exposing such persons to criminal or civil liability, however, would not further the interests in promoting family communication, would not deter those who would inappropriately transport minors across state lines to obtain abortions, and might provide an unintended basis for vexatious litigation against individuals and organizations.

Finally, S. 1645 must be amended to address constitutional concerns that the Department of Justice has identified in particular provisions of the legislation. The Department will forward their concerns subsequently and would be pleased to work with the sponsors in crafting legislation that remedies those defects and the other matters noted above.

The Administration is concerned that S. 1645, as written, raises novel and important federalism issues including the rights of states to regulate matters within their own boundaries. The Administration believes, however, that legislation that addresses the concerns noted above, and that is carefully targeted towards punishing non-relatives who transport minors across state lines for the purposes of avoiding parental involvement requirements, would minimize the federalism concerns.

ROBERTSON COULD BE HELD LIABLE SHOULD A TERRORIST  
BOMB MANIFEST IN ORLANDO, HRC ASSERTS

Washington, D.C. -- The Human Rights Campaign warned religious political broadcaster Pat Robertson that his remarks made earlier this week about Orlando, Fl., expose him and his media empire to civil and criminal charges should the city experience a terrorist attack. Robertson said that Orlando could suffer from terrorist bombs, hurricanes, earthquakes and even a meteor for allowing gay pride flags to be flown along city streets. His remarks were made Monday on the Christian Broadcasting Network's "700 Club" following a news report on "Gay Days" at Walt Disney World, which took place Saturday, June 6.

"Pat Robertson practically invited a terrorist attack on the city of Orlando," said David M. Smith, HRC's communications director and senior strategist. "In the wake of last year's bombings at Olympic Park, the Atlanta gay nightclub, and a number of attacks on women's reproductive health care facilities, his remarks are an outrageous act of irresponsibility that have the potential to incite more violence."

"I would warn Orlando that you're right in the way of some serious hurricanes and I don't think I'd be waving those flags in God's face if I were you," Robertson said. "This is not a message of hate; this is a message of redemption. But a condition like this will bring about the destruction of your nation. It'll bring about terrorist bombs; it'll bring earthquakes, tornadoes and possibly a meteor."

"Pat Robertson has exposed himself and the Christian Broadcasting Network to significant legal action should such a terrorist attack take place," said Tony Varona, HRC's chief counsel. "These remarks clearly indicate a reckless disregard for the safety and well-being of the people of Orlando."

Despite these irresponsible remarks, three days later Pat Robertson was granted a meeting with House Republican leadership to discuss issues of concern to the Christian Coalition, the religious political organization he founded. Robertson and Christian Coalition Executive Director Randy Tate met with House Majority Leader Dick Armey, R-Texas, and Majority Whip Tom DeLay, R-Texas late Wednesday according to news reports.

The Human Rights Campaign is the largest national lesbian and gay political organization, with members throughout the country. It effectively

lobbies Congress, provides campaign support, and educates the public to ensure that lesbian and gay Americans can be open, honest, and safe at home, at work, and in the community.

- Q. The National Academy of Sciences released a study today on national testing, concluding that Mr. Goodling's proposal to compare student achievement by using existing state and commercial tests is unworkable. What is the President's reaction to this study?**

*Background: In last year's compromise on national testing, we agreed to a Goodling proposal for the National Academy of Sciences to determine if the achievement of students from different states and cities, as measured by different state or commercial tests, could be compared by statistically related the different tests to each other. Presumably, if this could be done, there would be no need to develop a new national test, as the President had proposed. The NAS is releasing an interim report of this study today, which concludes that Mr. Goodling's approach is not feasible.*

- A.** The study's conclusions clearly show that work on developing voluntary national tests must continue. Last fall the President and Mr. Goodling agreed to have this study conducted, and agreed that the results should inform Congressional action on national testing. Now we have the results, and they show conclusively that if we want to know how well students are performing compared to rigorous and widely accepted national standards, then we simply cannot rely on existing tests. Work on the voluntary national tests in 4th grade reading and 8th grade math is proceeding under the authority of the independent, bipartisan National Assessment Governing Board. It is clear that this work must continue, without delay and without interference.

Today, President Clinton speaks about U.S.-China relations and the goals and objectives of his upcoming trip to China. The President addresses areas of mutual national interest, including stability in Asia, the prevention of weapons proliferation, and environmental protection. The President also discusses areas of disagreement between the two nations, and why continued United States engagement on these issues is crucial.

---

**BUILDING TIES TO STRENGTHEN AMERICA IN THE 21ST CENTURY.** China, already the world's most populous nation, is also a growing economic giant and a permanent member of the United Nations Security Council. A stable, open, and prosperous China that assumes its duty for building a more peaceful world is profoundly in America's interest. The best way to encourage the emergence of China in this way is to work cooperatively where possible while dealing forthrightly about differences. The United States and China are working together in key areas, including:

**STABILIZING THE ASIAN PENINSULA.** China has played an important stabilizing role in Asia:

- Nuclear Testing In India and Pakistan. After India and Pakistan conducted nuclear tests, China chaired a meeting of the permanent members of the UN Security Council to forge a common strategy for moving these two countries back from the threat of an arms race. China has joined the United States in condemning these tests, calling on both countries to sign the Comprehensive Test Ban Treaty, and encouraging peaceful dialogue to resolve their differences.
- The Korean Peninsula. China has also become a force for peace and stability on the Korean Peninsula. The Chinese government has helped us convince North Korea to freeze its dangerous nuclear program and played a constructive role in the Four Party Peace Talks.

**WORKING TO STOP THE SPREAD OF WEAPONS OF MASS DESTRUCTION.** In the past decade, China has joined the Non-Proliferation Treaty, the Chemical Weapons Convention, the Biological Weapons Convention and the Comprehensive Test Ban Treaty, each of which contains clear reporting requirements and inspection systems. China has also agreed to stop assistance to Iran and Pakistan on their nuclear programs. The President will continue to press China for assistance on non-proliferation, and seek stronger controls on the sale of missiles, missile technology, dual-use products, and chemical and biological weapons.

**PARTNERSHIP IN COMBATING INTERNATIONAL DRUG TRAFFICKING AND ORGANIZED CRIME.** Last month, a special liaison group that President Clinton created with President Jiang of China brought together leading American and Chinese law enforcement officials to set up cooperative efforts against organized crime, counterfeiting, and alien smuggling. Next month, the Drug Enforcement Agency will open its first office in China.

**HELPING CHINA DEVELOP ENVIRONMENTAL STRATEGIES.** China faces daunting environmental problems that could spread beyond its borders -- all of its major bodies of water are polluted, and respiratory illness is the number one health problem for Chinese citizens. One year ago, Vice President Gore launched a dialogue with the China to help them pursue growth and protection of the environment. The President will explore with President Jiang how American technology can help improve air quality and bring electricity to more of China's rural residents.

**ENCOURAGING OPEN GLOBAL MARKETS.** China is one of the fastest growing markets in the world and the United States exports \$13 billion in goods to China. We must continue to press the Chinese governments to open goods, services, and agricultural markets, work toward Chinese inclusion in the World Trade Organization, and renew normal trade treatment for China.

**ENGAGEMENT OF CHINA IN AREAS OF DISAGREEMENT SERVES AMERICA'S INTERESTS.** By integrating China into the community of nations and global economy, helping its leadership understand that greater freedom profoundly serves China's interests, and standing up for our principles, we can most effectively serve the cause of democracy and human rights in China. Our message remains strong and constant. Do not arrest people for their political beliefs -- release those who are in jail for that reason; resume your dialogue with the Dalai Lama; allow people to worship when, where and how they choose; recognize that our relationship will not reach its full potential as long as the Chinese people are denied fundamental human rights. Engagement, not isolation, is the best way to make a difference on human rights and religious persecution.

**SHAPING A MORE PROSPEROUS AND PEACEFUL FUTURE.** The more we share our ideas with the world, the more the world comes to share America's ideals. By continuing to work with China in areas of agreement, and dealing directly with our differences we help ensure Chinese inclusion in the community of nations.

States can spend Child Care and Development Block Grant funds only on families up to 85 percent of the state median income. They also must spend no less than 70 percent of their funds on families who are receiving welfare, transitioning off welfare, or at risk of being dependent on welfare.

Our child care budget proposal omitted this second requirement to allow states to aim funds at the working poor. As you know, our language was cleared internally, but never officially submitted to the Hill (except as I understand it, shared with some of our friends on the House side).

The tobacco bill also omits this second requirement for the additional child care money, at I believe OMB's suggestion. However, this does not eliminate the basic limitation that states to spend CCDBG funds only on families under 85 percent of the state median income.

For Elena's review, here is a draft Q&A on Shaw's Fatherhood bill for use by the VP and Kevin Thurm who are both speaking at the National Fatherhood Summit on Monday (see background below). I'd like to get a final version to them by COB today if possible.

Background

Monday is National Fatherhood Initiative's fatherhood summit here at the Marriott. VP is the keynote speaker at lunch, Judge Ross is chairing one of the public policy sector meetings in the afternoon, Kevin Thurm is on the closing panel, and I believe Secretary Riley is also speaking. Several Governors (Ridge and Carper) and members of Congress also invited.

VP is going to present a Hammer award to the federal interagency forum on child and family statistics, which formed in response to the 6/95 Exec. Memorandum which, among other things, directed agencies to incorporate fathers into research efforts on family and children issues. He is also going to strongly emphasize the Administration's history and commitment to fatherhood issues.

Apparently the producers of a Ford, Casey, and Work/Families Institute documentary coming out next week on fatherhood failed to include the Administration -- Bill Bradley is doing the voice over-- so VP's office is upset and is looking to remind people of our record on this. The VP will probably highlight a few of the agency initiatives implemented in response to the Exec Memo. (15 agencies have submitted responses to VP memo asking them to submit accomplishments, contact person, and new ideas in preparation for the PMC meeting discussion on fatherhood that Kevin chaired last week.) I've suggested he also highlight the WTW \$ going to non-custodial parents and have passed along info on both the formula and competitive grants. Tom Rosshirt is working on the speech and I'm supposed to see it on Sunday. At this point, there are no plans for VP to make any other announcements.

It's not clear how much play the Republican fatherhood block grant bill will get. So far, the bill has been stalled due to concerns among



**Question and Answer on Fathers Count Act  
June 12, 1998**

**Question:** Does the Administration support HR 3314, the Fathers Count Act of 1998?

**Answer:** We certainly support the general goal of encouraging states and communities to help fathers become more involved in their children's lives and share the concerns about working families, both mothers and fathers. The Administration has always placed a high priority on supporting strong and healthy two parent families and the role of fathers. This track record includes: family friendly policies such as the Family and Medical Leave Act, expansion of the Earned Income Tax Credit and the new Child Tax Credit; initiatives to promote father involvement in child health immunization and early education; demonstration projects to promote responsible fatherhood; and employment programs for non-custodial parents of children on welfare so they can help support their children. We remain ready to work with Congress on initiatives that will help hard pressed families meet their needs, including child care.

We would be glad to work with Congress on the specific provisions of the Fathers Count Act at an appropriate time. Funding for the initiative would need to be considered within the context of other priorities and within the context of the balanced budget.

Background

The bill was introduced by Clay Shaw on March 3 and now has 7 Republican co-sponsors. It would authorize \$2 billion over five years for block grants to states for projects to encourage fathers to become better parents. Funding levels grow from \$200 M in 2000 to \$500 M in 2004. The funds would be distributed by HHS to states based on their share of total population, and would be targeted to private organizations (75 percent) and to fathers below the state or local average income of male earners (80 percent). The bill specifically declares religious organizations eligible to receive funds under the act.

Funds could be used to: 1) encourage unmarried or prospective fathers to get married, and encourage better parenting both by fathers who are living with their children and those who are not and 2) help fathers obtain gainful employment or increase their skills in order to qualify for higher paying jobs. The bill also specifies that a state who receives a Fathers grant may use Welfare-to-Work and Title XX (Social Services Block Grant) funds for the same purpose. Up to \$10 million annually is earmarked for research and evaluation, with another \$10 million annually earmarked for technical assistance.

While the bill has not moved to date, it is possible that the National Fatherhood summit on June 15th may generate new momentum.
