FUTURE OF KEY ENVIRONMENTAL BILLS UNCERTAIN IN WAKE OF DOLE RESIGNATION
Senate Majority Whip Trent Lott (R-Miss), one of the possible successors
to Senate Majority Leader Robert Dole (R-Kan), has pledged to continue
Republican attempts to reform superfund, a Senate committee aide told BNA May
15.

A spokeswoman for Dole declined May 15 to speculate on the prospects for
floor consideration of the senator's property rights bill (S 605) in light of
his resignation. That bill would require compensation of landowners whose
property values were diminished by one-third or more as a result of federal
regulations.

Late in the week of May 5, the spokeswoman had said that Dole hoped to

schedule the bill for floor consideration before the Memorial Day congressional recess. Lott has indicated to Sen. Robert Smith's (R-NH) staff that superfund reform (S 1285) will continue to be "a top environmental priority for this session" in the Senate, Anna Matz, deputy press secretary for Smith, told BNA May 15. "We have every reason to believe" that Lott will maintain the same level of commitment toward superfund that Dole had, Matz said.

Lott was one of the original co-sponsors of S 1285, a Senate majority aide said. He added that it was hard to speculate what would happen to the reform bill in light of Dole's resignation as majority leader. Staff from Lott's office were unavailable for comment May 15.

Dole A Catalyst For Superfund Bill

Although he was not directly involved in the legislation, Dole was a key figure in the superfund debate in the Senate "because he's the one who set aside floor space to keep superfund on the agenda," Julie Rochman, assistant vice president for public affairs with the Alliance of American Insurers, told BNA May 15.

According to Rochman, Dole told Smith he was committed to moving a superfund reform bill, and had promised Smith that once S 1285 cleared the full committee, "it would be on the short list of things to do." Smith's bill, which was recently amended to change certain liability exemptions for site cleanups and other provisions in the bill, did not have Dole's initial support because of a tax credit mechanism in the original language. Dole's opposition to the language led to the cancellation of hearings on the bill in the fall of 1995.

An industry source told BNA May 15 that Dole's relinquishing of power could have either a positive or negative effect on the Smith bill. "Either you have no fire power to get it done," because Dole is absent from the process, or "it's possible that people will actually get something done because the political posturing" associated with the superfund debate will leave with Dole, she said.

Any hesitation from the successor will hurt the reform process, Rochman said. "It's important that time not be lost" on moving the bill.

An Environmental Protection Agency official told BNA May 15 that it was too soon to speculate how Dole's shuffling of duties would affect the reform process, but agreed that time was running out. EPA "is still committed to getting a bill out this year," the official said.

Some Say Takings Bill May Be Unaffected

Aides to Dole have given no indication to the property rights community that the Senate Republican Leader has backed down from his commitment to bring up S 605 for floor consideration, Nancie Marzulla, president of Defenders of Property Rights, told BNA May 15.

She said her organization consistently had been in close contact with his staff regarding prospects for the bill. "I don't know that Dole's resigning to run for president is going to hurt us," she said.

She said the fact that Dole's two successors in the Republican leadership -- Lott and Nickles -- are proponents of property rights bodes well for consideration of the bill. Nickles, who is chairman of the Senate Republican Policy Committee, authored one of the titles in the Dole bill, she noted. Marzulla said discussions have been under way regarding the possibility of narrowing the scope of the bill to address only certain issues, such as real property.

She said bill proponents have indicated that they would support a narrowing of the bill's scope only if they have a commitment from opponents that they would support the bill if certain changes were made.

Meanwhile, John Echeverria, general counsel to the National Audubon Society, agreed May 15 that prospects for consideration of the takings bill could be unaffected by Dole's resignation, since Lott, his likely successor, "generally is viewed as a more right-wing Republican."

Echeverria told BNA, "I think it is hard to predict, and I don't think

[Dole's resignation] is going to make a lot of difference.'

He said there has been much speculation that other proponents of the bill will seek to narrow the scope of the legislation before bringing it to the Senate floor.

Glenn Sugameli, counsel to the National Wildlife Federation, told BNA May 15 that Dole's resignation would provide ``reason and cover'' for bill proponents to back down from commitments to bring the measure to the Senate floor.

He said more significant than the Dole resignation was what he viewed as the retreat of House Republicans from the whole compensation issue. Sugameli said he based his assessment on a statement of principles issued by the House Republican Task Force May 15 that said that ``private property owners should be assured greater certainty regarding the use of their property. They should also be assured due process to challenge any adverse decisions and when their property rights are in question.'' (See related report in this issue.)

He said the absence of language calling for compensation of landowners whose property values have been diminished as a result of federal regulation, as well as recent published comments, indicate that ``even [House Speaker Newt] Gingrich has gotten the message.'





The House and Senate are scheduled to begin conference tomorrow on their respective versions of omnibus parks and public lands bills. The Snow Basin land exchange is part of the package, and that provision still includes the broad override of environmental law and numerous other features that severely hamper USDA's land management authority.

Their idea is that the Secretary would direct the Forest Service to engage in an internal review of salvage sales, focusing on the kinds of complaints they're hearing from the public, and while that review was on-going, salvage sales in 3 categories would be suspended: a) sales that had been previously prepared as green sales, but were bieng prepared nad advertised as salvage sales under the rider; b) sales that the Forest Service had decided not to proceed with prior to the rider due to environmental concerns, but were going forward w/under the rider; c) sales in inventoried roadless areas.

After this review was complete, the recommendations would go to an interagency team that (meanwhile) will be reviewing implementation of the interagency MOA signed in August for salvage sales. Justice and USDA lawyers are working w/the Secretary's office on this, and BLM's Chief of Staff is working to see whether BLM has sales tha tmight fall under the potential suspension categories, but other than that, this proposal is being kept close hold for now. Jack Ward Thomas has been out of town; he's been called back to discuss this tommorrow and then USDA will decide how and when to proceed. Before anything was announced, USDA would anticipate briefing hill Democrats.

Both the House and Senate will see floor action soon on campaign finance reform. Leg. Affairs would therefore like to convene a meeting to discuss the issue, 11:30am tomorrow, in a room we'll reserve (and announce later today). Per Peter Jacoby and Jamie Rubin, the following is a brief review of the state of play:

Senate: The President has already endorsed the McCain-Feingold bill, which is now attached as an amendment to the Department of Defense Authorization bill that the Senate is scheduled to take up next week. The bill bases candidate spending limits on each state's population, entitles complying candidates to both free and discounted broadcast time, bans PAC contributions, requires full disclosure of soft money contributions, and bans bundling.

House: The GOP leadership has announced that the House will consider campaign finance reform during the week of July 8. Among the proposals on the table will be a Democratic leadership bill that limits spending per 2-year cycle, limits PAC and individual contributions, provides broadcast discounting as an incentive to participate in spending limits, eliminates soft money, and eliminates bundling (with an exception for non-affiliated, non-connected PACs like Emily's List). The GOP says it will have a bill, too. Details are unknown, but there

will almost certainly be provisions targeting union political activity, in the form of a codification of the Supreme Court's 1988 Beck decision. In Beck, the court ruled that non-union workers who pay "agency fees" to unions are entitled to a refund of whatever portion of those fees the unions don't spend on collective bargaining activities, i.e. that the agency fees can't subsidize union political activities. Republicans can be expected to argue -- as they have in the past -- that nobody (union or non-union) should be forced against his or her will to contribute to a union-endorsed candidate and that unions refund far too little money, far too infrequently.

Independent Proposal: A group led by ex-journalist Paul Taylor has petitioned the networks to give each of the major Presidential candidates five minutes of free prime time each night during the last month of the campaign. Each network responded by offering some variant of this. Reed Hundt has stated the FCC's intention to hold a hearing on the proposal.

EXECUTIVE ORDER

INDIAN SACRED SITES

By the authority vested in me as President by the Constitution and the laws of the United States, in furtherance of Federal treaties, and in order to protect and preserve Indian religious practices, it is hereby ordered:

Section 1. Accommodation of Sacred Sites. (a) In managing Federal lands, each executive branch agency with statutory or administrative responsibility for the management of Federal lands shall, to the extent practicable, permitted by law, and not clearly inconsistent with essential agency functions, (1) accommodate access to and ceremonial use of Indian sacred sites by Indian religious practitioners and (2) avoid adversely affecting the physical integrity of such sacred sites. Where appropriate, agencies shall maintain the confidentiality of sacred sites.

(b) For purposes of this order:

(i) "Federal lands" means any land or interests in land owned by the United States, including leasehold interests held by the United States, except Indian trust lands;

(ii) "Indian tribe" means an Indian or Alaska Native tribe, band, nation, pueblo, village, or community that the Secretary of the Interior acknowledges to exist as an Indian tribe pursuant to Public Law No. 103-454, 108 Stat. 4791, and "Indian" refers to a member of such an Indian tribe; and

(iii) "Sacred site" means any specific, discrete, narrowly delineated location on Federal land that is identified by an Indian tribe, or Indian individual determined to be an appropriately authoritative representative of an Indian religion, as sacred by virtue of its established religious significance to, or ceremonial use by, an Indian religion; provided that the tribe or appropriately authoritative representative of an Indian religion has informed the agency of the existence of such a site.

Sec. 2. Procedures. (a) Each executive branch agency with statutory or administrative responsibility for the management of Federal lands shall, as appropriate, promptly implement procedures for the purposes of carrying out the provisions of section 1 of this order, including, where practicable and appropriate, procedures to ensure reasonable notice is provided of proposed actions or land management policies that may restrict future access to or ceremonial use of, or adversely affect the physical integrity of, sacred sites. In all actions pursuant to this section, agencies shall comply with the Executive memorandum of April 29, 1994, "Government-to-Government Relations with Native American Tribal Governments."

(b) Within 1 year of the effective date of this order, the head of each executive branch agency with statutory or administrative responsibility for the management of Federal lands shall report to the President, through the Assistant to the President for Domestic Policy, on the implementation of this order. Such reports shall address, among other things, (i) any changes necessary to accommodate access to and ceremonial use of Indian sacred sites; (ii) any changes necessary to avoid adversely affecting the physical integrity of Indian sacred sites; and (iii) procedures implemented or proposed to facilitate consultation with appropriate Indian tribes and religious leaders and the expeditious resolution of disputes relating to agency action on Federal lands that may adversely affect access to, ceremonial use of, or the physical integrity

of sacred sites.

Sec. 3. Nothing in this order shall be construed to require a taking of vested property interests. Nor shall this order be construed to impair enforceable rights to use of Federal lands that have been granted to third parties through final agency action. For purposes of this order, "agency action" has the same meaning as in the Administrative Procedure Act (5 U.S.C. 551(13)).

Sec. 4. This order is intended only to improve the internal management of the executive branch and is not intended to, nor does it, create any right, benefit, or trust responsibility, substantive or procedural, enforceable at law or equity by any party against the United States, its agencies, officers, or any person.

TONGASS: JUDGE OKs DEAL TO FREE SOME HELD-UP TIMBER SALES
US District Court Judge John Sedwick on 5/22 approved a deal that will free up about one-third of the Tongass National Forest timber sales that were tied up by a lawsuit first filed two years ago. The Alaska Wilderness Recreation and Tourism Association had sued in an effort to secure new environmental studies before the US Forest Service could resell timber that had been pledged to now-defunct pulp and saw mills in Sitka and Wrangell.

Under the deal struck between the feds, enviros and tourism groups, two-thirds of those sales must go through enviro reviews before they can be resold. The accord also ensures that further enviro reviews of some sales will not have to wait if the US Forest Service is slow in completing its Tongass management plan.

The federal government says the deal means some of the timber will be sold and harvested this year.

Tom Waldo of the Sierra Club Legal Defense Fund, which represented enviros: "We hope the formal decision approving the agreement will pave the way for a new way of managing the Tongass" (Dirk Miller, AP/ANCHORAGE DAILY NEWS, 5/24).

This Statement of Administration Policy was developed by the Legislative Reference Division (Jones), in consultation with the Departments of Justice (Taylor), Transportation (DeCell), and the Treasury (Levy), White House Counsel (), National Economic Council (), Domestic Policy Council (), General Counsel (), Economic Policy (), TCJSD (), HTFD (), BASD (Balis).

H.R. 234 was reported favorably by a voice vote of the House Committee on the Judiciary on October 31, 1995.

Description of H.R. 234

H.R. 234 would amend the Bankruptcy Code to make nondischargeable a debt for death or personal injury caused by the debtor's operation of a watercraft or aircraft while intoxicated from alcohol, drugs, or other substances.

Under current law, those who incur debt as a result of their operation of a motor vehicle while under the influence of alcohol cannot have their obligation dismissed. This bankruptcy provision has been interpreted as applying only to automobiles.

H.R. 234 bill would extend the law to operation of watercraft or aircraft.
