1. Child support: Todd Stern wants to make sure we draw up Presidential directives or MOUs for the paternity and child support enforcement initiatives we discussed at that mtg in Ken's office the other day. We talked about 2 or 3: 1) directing HHS to strengthen the cooperation requirements for establishing paternity; 2) directing HHS & Labor to develop the deadbeat data bank (new-hire matching); and possibly 3) directing HHS & Treasury to carry out the new authority under the debt collection bill to run matches against federal benefits. Todd says Steve Neuwirth did a one-page directive when we required minor mothers to stay in school that could serve as a model for these. Give me a call or send me a note and we'll figure out how best to get this done (perhaps HHS & OMB can do most of the work).
 2. Waivers: I've now read the Wisconsin waiver, and Ken and I are meeting with Mary Jo tomorrow to get her read on what the tough issues will be. I don't want to drag you into this any earlier than necessary, but at some point I will need your constitutional and legal wisdom on a couple of questions about what's waivable and what's not. Let's talk it over.

H.R. 2977 - Administrative Dispute Resolution Act

(Gekas (R) Pennsylvania and Reed (D) Rhode Island)

The Administration strongly supports House passage of H.R. 2977, which would permanently reauthorize the Administrative Dispute Resolution Act and make several improvements to the Act.

The Administration will seek Senate amendments that reflect the confidentiality and binding arbitration provisions in the Senate companion bill (S. 1224) as reported by the Senate Governmental Affairs Committee, which would:

? Specifically exempt from disclosure under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) records generated by an agency and records provided to an agency in dispute resolution proceedings. Confidentiality of dispute resolution communications is crucial to the success of alternative dispute resolution. Providing a clear FOIA exemption will allow agencies to expand appropriate use of alternative dispute resolution.

? Authorize the use of binding arbitration by Federal agencies when appropriate.

The Administration will also seek a Senate amendment to divest district courts of jurisdiction over government contract bid protests and to vest this authority exclusively in the Court of Federal Claims, thereby eliminating disparate bodies of law and incentives for excessive litigation. With nationwide jurisdiction, contract expertise, and the ability to hold hearings at a venue convenient to litigants (including small businesses) the Court of Federal Claims could establish a consistent body of precedent governing bid protests.

Please note -- the Senate Labor and Human Resources will be marking up S. 1221 (Legal Services Reform Act) on Wednesday, June 5th. This bill was introduced by Sen. Kassebaum and would authorize \$278 million annually through fiscal year 2000. S. 1221 would also limit the types of cases that LSC attorneys could work on and require additional record keeping.

You may recall that Attorney General Reno and then White House Counsel Mikva sent a letter on S. 1221 to Senator Kassebaum on September 19, 1995, which discussed the Administrations concerns with the bill. (A draft of this letter was circulated in LRM 2567 dated September 18, 1995.)

I will keep you posted as I hear more about the markup.

There will be a briefing this coming Friday, June 7th, at 4:30 p.m. in the CEQ conference room on the Sierra Nevada Ecosystem Project, which is scheduled to be released publicly the following Monday, June 10th, in California.

The Sierra Nevada Ecosystem Project was mandated by Congress in 1993 to conduct a comprehensive scientific review of the remaining old growth in the national forests in the Sierra Nevada, and to provide for a study of the entire Sierra Nevada ecosystem by an independent panel of scientists. There will be considerable attention paid to it in California and in the press.

The briefing team consists of the Chair of the Steering Committee who conducted the report (from the U. of California), the science team leader and a third scientist on the team. They plan to brief the Congressional delegation in the morning and Secretary Glickman and Babbitt in the early afternoon.

Martha - Katie mentioned to me your conversation earlier today about not filing a petition for rehearing for the geographic scope (sales versus area) decision. As you know, none of the agencies and none of the enviros recommended fighting this further. One of the important reasons there's not a lot of interest in continuing to fight this is that virtually all of the sales went out the door this past winter when we lost the motion for stay. There are arguably one or two sales that could be caught up if we lose the murrelet or previously enjoined sale decisions and some of those sales are in the broader area, but not very much volume.

I can assure you, however, that any lack of feverent attention or interest in fighting this on the part of the enviros will be more than compensated by the reaction regarding the murrelet sale decision. I keep having to assure people on an almost daily basis that the reason we haven't appealed or cancelled contracts or whatever for these sales is that WE ARE STILL WAITING FOR THE DECISION. There are lots of stories and discussions about the situation turning really nasty if the murrelet trees start being logged. But the other issue - geographic sales - is considered past history by now.

HR 497: THE NATIONAL GAMBLING IMPACT AND POLICY COMMISSION ACT
HR 497, The National Gambling Impact and Policy Commission Act (Wolf (R) VA and 143 cosponsors), would create a commission that would be charged with conducting a comprehensive study of gambling in the United States and Federal, State, and local policy and practices regarding the legalization or prohibition of gambling. The bill also authorizes the Commission to hold hearings, to subpoena testimony and materials, and to seek information from Federal agencies. This bill passed the House in April of this year. It's Senate companion bill, S704 (Simon, IL and 24 cosponsors), has passed the Government Affairs Committee, but has not yet been scheduled for a vote on the floor.

Hot Issue for Nevada

Senators Bryan and Reid (along with Governor Miller) have adamantly opposed any form of subpoena powers for the commission and are unhappy with the House bill and the current version of the Senate Bill. Also, The American Gaming Association, while publicly stating that it does not oppose a national study of gambling, sees HR497 (and the current Senate version) as just the first step in an effort by Congress to impose some federal rules on an industry that has so far been largely regulated by the states.

The Administration has taken no official position on the specific subpoena issues.

Administration Position to Date

-October, You wrote the bill's sponsor (Rep. Wolf), stating that he had long shared your view about the need to

consider carefully all of the effects of gambling, and I support the establishment of a commission for that purpose.? In March of this year, the Administration sent up a Statement of Administration Position supporting HR 497.

This spring, You told Governor Miller that You oppose the subpoena power currently in the bill, but did not indicate that the bill would be vetoed if it passes in its current form. In mid

-May, Carol Rasco met with a group of 6

-7 Gambling CEOs at

Governor Miller's request and gave them no further indication of our position on the subpoena issue.

During hearings on the bill, the Justice Department voiced concerns about the mandatory subpoena power of the Commission in respect to federal law

-enforcement agencies. In response to these concerns, the Committee amended H.R. 497 to allow the head of an agency to withhold sensitive law enforcement information

from the Commission.

Description of the Act

H.R. 497 would create a nine

-member National Gambling Impact and

Policy Commission, with three each appointed by the President, Speaker of the House, and the Majority Leader of the Senate, to study the impact of gambling in the United States. The principal issues the bill directs the Commission to study include:

? the economic impact, both positive and negative, of gambling at the local, State and Federal levels and on Indian tribes;

? a review and assessment of political contributions and their effect on development of public policy regulating gambling;

? the relationship between gambling and crime;

? an assessment of problem gambling on individuals, families, social institutions, criminal activity, and the economy;

? the effectiveness of existing law enforcement, judicial administration, and corrections to deter illegal gambling;

? gambling that uses interactive technology, including the Internet; and

? the extent to which casino gambling provides economic opportunity to residents of economically depressed regions and to Indian tribes.

The Commission is required to report to the President and the Congress, within two years of its first meeting, on its findings and conclusions and any recommendations for legislative or administrative actions it considers appropriate.
