Looking ahead to Wednesday's meeting with the intergovernmental groups, here is a rough cut at the agenda and the status of the various items that I know of. Please review (particularly Diana and Emily) and see what needs to be added. Note also the loops that need to be closed by Wednesday.

I. 10/23 Q and A -- The answers to these questions still need final clearance from OMB. I will talk to Keith Fontenot and we will get out as many of the answers as possible.

II. Cost Neutrality and Waivers -- Since we have an answer on this question now, we should spend some time on this on the agenda. EMILY will be talking to Monahan, Yvette Jackson and OMB about what paper we can share and how to present the answer.

III. Means Tested Benefits -- It is possible the decision may be made on this one as well. ELENA -- I have a call into you to discuss how we should be presenting this decision: what paper can be shared?

IV. Food Stamp 18-50 Guidance -- Should be cleared by Wednesday. USDA should be able to hand out and discuss. I am working with OMB to get that done.

Other items from last time:

-- John Monahan and Elaine Ryan agreed to meet to discuss TANF administration issues.

-- Bruce agreed to meet with the groups on welfare-to-work proposal.

-- NGA was having several meetings on employment issues.

-- There were also supposed to be further meetings with HHS on regs.

We agreed to have reports on each of these at 12/4 meeting.

The Governors have very strong concerns about a proposed rule currently under consideration by the Department of the Interior (see the letter to the President, attached). The Indian Gaming Regulatory Act of 1988 (IGRA) set up a process for states and tribes to negotiate Class III gaming operation by Indian tribes in good faith. The Act permitted tribes to bring suit against states alleging negotiation in bad faith. The US Supreme Court, in Seminole Tribe of Florida v. Florida, affirmed the states', Eleventh Amendment defense to a suit and ruled that a Tribe could not bring such a suit against a state. The Interior Department is proposing a rule that authorizes the Secretary of the Interior to intervene with states when tribes allege bad faith and to allow tribes to operate gaming in the absence of a tribal-state compact.

Because the rule is still in the process of the advance notice of proposed rule making, we are unable to contact the Interior Department to discuss the Governors', concerns. The White House Counsel's Office, while checking the status of the rule, learned that Interior is not only considering the rule but alternatives to it, including not proceeding with the rule. Counsel's office understands that Interior is still reviewing its options and that the Secretary will bring the issue to the White House before reaching a decision. According to the Counsel's Office, Interior expects to send an options memo to the President in the next month or two.

Yesterday, Governors Miller of Nevada and Voinovich of Ohio (Chair and Vice-Chair of the National Governors' Association) requested a meeting with the President to call for his intervention into this matter (see NGA Bulletin, attached). Since the White House has not yet received the options memo from the Secretary, Counsel's Office is recommending that the President decline to meet with the Governors. We will contact Governors Miller and Voinovich today.

BRIEFING ON LABOR'S WELFARE REFORM CONCERNS

The following briefly summarizes the key issues related to welfare reform that organized labor has raised to us previously, their status, and our suggested response.

1. Privatization of Administrative Functions

Concern Allowing states to contract out the administration of Food Stamps, Medicaid, or welfare.

Problem The states have the legal authority to contract out administration of the welfare block grant. They need a waiver to do this for Food Stamps and approval for Medicaid. Both Texas and Wisconsin are well down the road in developing their plans to contract out.

Response Since (a) we do not have a definite position yet on this issue and (b) we don't have a legal basis to turn the states down, we should probably just listen.

2. Public Comment Period on State Welfare Plans

Concern Ensuring that HHS requires a 45 day public comment period before state welfare plans are certified as complete.

Response HHS will require comment periods, but they can take place after the plan is submitted to the federal government. Plans will be certified as completely only after the comment period has ended. Funding will be retroactive to plan submission.

3. Continued Medicaid Funding for Immigrants

Concern Ensuring that all immigrants will continue to get Medicaid even after losing their SSI.

Problem This is a budget issue. It may be possible to let states do this administratively, but the cost could be over \$1 billion over six years.

Response We share this concern. Need to look at it in the context of the budget.

4. Employment Rights for Welfare Recipients

Concern Providing greater labor protections for those in "workfare" programs -- working for their welfare.

Response We have pressed for greater protections in the past. We will work with them on this in the new Congress.
