I do not have much in the way of good news. Justice has concluded that many of the options that we discussed regarding pursuing campaign reform through FEC rulemaking are not available under existing law. This includes limits on foreign contributions as well as changes in FEC enforcement procedure.

As we discussed, however, it appears that we can attempt to limit some soft money expenditures by FEC rule change. Specifically we could petition the FEC to change its rules regarding the allocation of hard and soft money in covering shared state and federal expenditures. Unfortunately, the governing law would not appear to allow the FEC to completely eliminate the use of soft money for shared state/federal expenditures but we can seek rule changes to limit the role of soft money as much as is legally possible. For example, we might suggest that upwards of 80% - 90% percent of shared expenditures be covered by federal dollars.

There is also, of course, no obstacle to our appointing persons to the FEC who are committed to reform and challenging the Republicans to submit the names of persons who are equally committed.

I. PURPOSE

To announce that seven DC college presidents have responded to your America Reads challenge by committing to partner with District public schools and place thousands of college student reading tutors in the DC schools over the next five years. You will also announce that AmeriCorps participants will coordinate and recruit additional tutors in targeted District schools. General Becton will announce that DC is taking the first steps towards meeting your America Reads Challenge.

II. BACKGROUND

The Clinton Administration has secured commitments from seven DC college presidents to place at least 680 new college reading tutors in the DC schools next year alone, and thousands over the next five years. This is in addition to the hundreds of college students who are already tutoring in the District schools. Most of the new tutors are federal college work study students. The colleges will use the increased federal work study funding and take advantage of your having waived the local match for work study students who tutor.

Last fall, you proposed that colleges dedicate half of their additional work study slots -- 100,000 slots -- to tutoring in reading or other community service. In December, you announced that 21 college presidents had responded to your challenge to dedicate work study slots for tutoring in reading and formed a steering committee to recruit additional colleges. This is an excellent example of how you are using the presidency to mobilize Americans without waiting for Congress to enact legislation. Father O'Donovan, President of Georgetown, and Dr. Robert Corrigan, President of San Francisco State University, are both members of this steering committee and both will be at the Garrison School tomorrow.

While the total number of additional college students pledged to tutor in the District is lower than we had originally thought, it is still a substantial initial commitment. You challenged colleges nationally to provide 10 percent or 100,000 of the 1 million reading tutors called for under America Reads. The 680 new tutors pledged in the District are over 10 percent of the 5,400 tutors General Becton believes he needs to reach his goal of tutoring all the first graders in the 18 public schools he has targeted for tutoring.

General Becton will announce that DC will be taking the first step toward meeting your America Reads challenge by creating "DC Reads," a public-private partnership to use these college tutors and mobilize additional volunteer reading tutors to improve reading skills in the 18 elementary schools with the greatest academic need. AmeriCorps will put two AmeriCorps participants at each of the 18 schools to coordinate and recruit tutors, and General Becton will hire reading specialists to train the tutors at each of the schools. The non-profit, Communities In Schools, formerly called Cities in Schools, will help coordinate resources at each of these schools and recruit private sector partners. The private sector partners will include Nations Bank, First Union Bank, Buvermo Properties, and the Washington Post, although they have not finalized their commitments.

The three initial components of DC Reads are:

1. Book Buddies: Beginning later this year, AmeriCorps members, along with Communities in Schools, will recruit and coordinate volunteers or "book buddies" to tutor first grade students twice a week in each of the targeted 18 elementary schools. All tutors will be trained and assisted by reading specialists hired by General Becton;
2. Saturday Academy: DC Public Schools will establish Saturday Reading Academies for 3rd and 6th graders at the 18 targeted schools; and
3. Family Resource Centers: District and AmeriCorps will work with public and private partners to establish Family Resource Centers in the targeted schools to help parents support their children's reading.

You are making this announcement at Garrison Elementary School because it is the pilot school for DC Reads and is one of the 18 targeted schools. Three AmeriCorps participants recruited reading tutors who began tutoring there this week. Education Department employees and Retired Senior Volunteer Program (RSVP) members and Foster Grandparent members tutor at Garrison as well. Communities in Schools is also a partner at Garrison.

They are clearly right on those. Congress went out of its way to make FEC enforcement as cumbersome and inefficient as possible. For example, the statute requires that even a simple decision to investigate a matter must be formally approved by the Commission. There is also no wiggle room under the statute on foreign contributions. Justice does have the ability to proceed independently in the case of criminal (not civil) violations but I am not sure what we want to do with that.

Although we obviously do not want to interfere with our current efforts on behalf of McCain-Feingold, we may want to consider, at some point, the advisability of offering legislation that addresses only FEC reform issues. This should including streamlining enforcement, requiring more frequent candidate disclosure filings, and breaking the partisan 3-3 logjam that is endemic to FEC decisionmaking.

DOJ -- The Department of Justice wants to file a brief in the next few days arguing that New York State should be permitted to cut off Medicaid-funded prenatal care for illegal aliens, in a case dating back to the late 1980's. The Bush Administration argued in court that illegal aliens were not entitled to Medicaid coverage for prenatal care. In 1991 a district court enjoined HHS and the state from cutting off benefits because congressional intent was unclear. However, the new welfare law appears to make it very clear that illegal aliens are not entitled to Medicaid-funded prenatal care, and DOJ would like to file a motion dismissing the complaint against the government. It appears that this would be the first action by the Clinton Administration on this issue.

I. PURPOSE:

To demonstrate and mobilize support among college and university presidents for your HOPE Scholarship and Tuition Tax Deduction proposals.

II. BACKGROUND:

This speech is an opportunity to demonstrate, in advance of budget negotiations, the support your budget proposals for higher education enjoy, particularly the Hope Scholarship and the Tuition Tax Deduction. In addition, this is an opportunity to highlight the progress we have already made on your America Reads/Work Study challenge and to reiterate that challenge in person to 1,300 college and university officials.

At this event, you will be receiving the endorsement of the American Council on Education (ACE) Board of Trustees for your package of higher education proposals. The Board is expected to pass this resolution on Sunday. In addition, we expect that the boards of directors of the Association of Community College Trustees and the American Association of Community Colleges will also endorse your package of higher education proposals.

While these endorsements are forthcoming, it is also important to recognize that there is concern within the higher education community about the HOPE Scholarship proposal. Two concerns have been expressed most frequently. First, college administrators are concerned that the reporting requirements to the IRS will be burdensome. Second, many are concerned that the tax credits and deductions will favor middle class families at the expense of poor families, and would prefer that Pell Grants be used as the vehicle for increasing student financial aid. Your speech is designed to respond directly to these concerns and to thereby help transform these organizational endorsements into active,

Others have raised concerns about aspects of the HOPE Scholarship proposal, specifically that it will lead to tuition and grade inflation. The experience of Georgia colleges and universities provide powerful responses to these concerns. Charles Knapp, the President of the University of Georgia, will speak prior to your remarks, to address these issues and speak to the benefits of HOPE Scholarships.

ACE is the umbrella higher education organization, representing nearly 1,700 public and private 2 and 4-year colleges and universities. Its members are college and university presidents, and it is the only organization that represents all sectors of higher education. It is the largest organization representing higher education. You will be the keynote speaker at their annual conference. You have been the keynote speaker twice before, in 1993 and 1995.

**Hiring welfare recipients in the federal government
February 21, 1997**

The Wall St. Journal reported today that we are moving forward on consideration of having government agencies hire welfare recipients.

- All of us who have been working to move more Americans from welfare to work acknowledge that government alone cannot afford to provide jobs for all of those currently on assistance. We need the commitment of the private sector to get the job done -- and we have been very pleased by the response to date from the CEOs of several major corporations who have committed their companies to hiring welfare recipients and investing in troubled communities.
- At the same time, the White House has been interested in what federal agencies can do to open up work opportunities to those on welfare. We asked the Office of Personnel Management to look into this question and just this week OPM Director Jim King provided the President's Domestic Policy Council with a memo which outlines different options that federal agencies could undertake, including the expansion of existing programs to attract entry-level workers. The Domestic Policy Council will review the memo and move forward as appropriate.
- OPM's memo looked at the question of hiring welfare recipients in the federal government generally. The Domestic Policy Council, led by Bruce Reed, is continuing to look at the possibility of opening up opportunities for welfare recipients at the White House.

NOTE FROM RICHARD SOCARIDES:

As most of you are aware, the Servicemembers Legal Defense Network will be releasing a report on Wednesday highly critical of DOD's implementation of "don't ask, don't tell." According to the report, discharges of gays are up 42% since the change in the policy, which in theory was suppose to make it easier for gays to serve. A similar report last year showed discharges up 21%. Last year, after the report appeared on the front page of the NYT, DOD said they would investigate, but it does not appear there was much follow-up.

Laura Marcus has been working with DOD and they appear prepared to say (we think) that they are taking the report seriously and will evaluate the allegations, take appropriate action, etc. David Johnson will be calling over there tonight and hopefully any combative language can be avoided -- although this is a work in progress.

In the meantime, here are some proposed talking points for WH use.

DRAFT TALKING POINTS: SLDN REPORT ON GAYS IN THE MILITARY

-- The "don't ask, don't tell" policy, developed in concert with the armed services and Congress, recognized that many gay and lesbian Americans have served and continue to serve in the military with bravery and distinction.

-- The policy was intended to provide an opportunity for continued service to those willing to abide by the new policy.

-- While we have not had an opportunity to review the report, the allegation that the policy is not being implemented fairly, if true, is quite troubling.

-- We understand that Secretary Cohen has instructed his staff to investigate the allegations and any other relevant information to determine what is happening.

-- We further understand that Secretary Cohen has indicated that violations of either the letter or the spirit of the policy will not be tolerated and the President, of course, concurs in this judgment.

House Democrats will release their education initiative on Wednesday. It will be based on the Administration's plan, but will 1) make Pell an entitlement, 2) expand the individual grant to \$3300, 3) restore the student loan deduction, 4) not require a B average for eligibility for the Hope Scholarships, and 5) propose an emergency reforms assistance program for schools.

Background checks estimated to have stopped 186,000 illegal gun
WASHINGTON (AP) Police background checks since 1994 have
blocked more than 186,000 illegal over-the-counter gun sales 72
percent by would-be buyers who were convicted or indicted for a
felony, the Justice Department estimated Tuesday.

The Bureau of Justice Statistics estimated that 6,600
applications to buy handguns or long guns are rejected each month
not only in the 32 states covered by the federal Brady Act but also
in those states that have their own similar laws authorizing
background checks of gun-buyers.

The figures cover the 28 months from Feb. 28, 1994, when the
Brady Act took effect, through last June.

By far the largest reason for blocking gun sales was the
discovery that the buyer had been convicted or indicted for a
felony, which occurred in 72 percent of the cases.

Fugitives accounted for 6 percent of the rejections; those
barred by some state law provision, 4 percent; those under court
restraining orders, 2 percent; mental patients, 1 percent. Some 15
percent were rejected for other reasons, including that they were
drug addicts, juveniles, illegal aliens or violators of local
ordinances.

The overall rate of applicants rejected was 2.6 percent in a
sampling of handgun applications during the first six months of
1996. Out of 1.3 million handgun applications during that period,
34,000 were rejected.

"Today's Justice Department study provides dramatic new
evidence of the importance of the Brady law's background checks in
stopping criminals from obtaining a firearm," said Sarah Brady,
chair of Handgun Control Inc. The law was named after her husband,
James Brady, the former White House press secretary who was
seriously wounded by a gunman who also shot President Ronald
Reagan.

"The numbers released today probably understate the real impact
and importance of background checks," she said. "It's not just
the criminals who walk into a gun store and are stopped from

purchasing a gun; it's all those criminals who are deterred from even walking into a gun store in the first place.''

The Brady Act requires that gun dealers wait five days before selling a handgun and ask local police to do a background check on the buyer during that time. Another federal law prohibits the sale of any firearm to anyone convicted or indicted for a felony, fugitives, illegal drug users, illegal aliens, mental patients, dishonorably discharged soldiers, and those convicted of domestic violence or under court restraining order for stalking or harassing an intimate partner.

The report noted that not all states check for mental disability, restraining orders or drug abuse. As of last June, 14 states reported presale investigations included checking outstanding restraining orders; 11 states looked into mental health records.

The bureau surveyed 600 law enforcement agencies, of which 176 in 44 states responded. The national estimates were derived by using standard statistical techniques to account for the non-responding states.

The Brady law provides that the waiting period will be eliminated when a national computerized instant criminal background check system administered by the FBI is established by November 1998.

President Clinton has proposed expanding the Brady law to ban handgun sales to adults who had been convicted of felonies as juveniles.
