Subject: Senator Torricelli Offers Family Leave Benefits to Gay Staff, F

Senator applies leave law to gay staffers

March 12, 1997

WASHINGTON (AP) -- Sen. Robert Torricelli, D-N.J., has extended benefits of the family-leave law to gay members of his staff.

A homosexual-rights group said other lawmakers have done it informally, but that the freshman senator is the first to write it into his office policy.

It means that a gay staffer could get unpaid leave to care for a companion in a medical emergency.

The 1993 Family and Medical Leave Act requires companies with 50 or more employees to offer 12 weeks of unpaid leave within a 12-month period for family emergencies.

But Torricelli told The Hill newspaper, "This is making the laws of Congress consistent with a new and rising national standard of equality. ... Rather than being the last institution to rise to this new standard, Congress should be a part of the change."

Torricelli has a staff of 43. The benefit has been added to his office personnel manual.

"My general sense is that many offices in the House and Senate do offer this benefit to employees in an informal manner," said David Smith, spokesman for the Human Rights Campaign. "Senator Torricelli has gone the extra step and placed that policy in writing."

Torricelli spokesman Jim Jordan said this does not make companions of gay

staffers eligible for any health benefits in their own right. "It's for sickness, bereavement," he said.

A conservative group criticized Torricelli's gesture.

"This was a law developed for the purpose of ensuring that people can care for their families," said Kristi Hamrick, spokeswoman for the Family Research Council. "It's inappropriate for a senator to cheapen the meaning of family by saying family is a `fill in the blank.'"

Subject: Chicago Finance Committee Approves DP Benefits

Benefits for gay partners appvd by Chi.

CHICAGO, March 12 (UPI) \_ A key Chicago City Council committee has voted to extend government employee health benefits to the domestic partners of homosexual city employees.

The city's Finance Committee Wednesday voted 15-7 in favor of the proposal \_ which was favored by Chicago Mayor Richard Daley \_ after three hours of debate and despite loud protests from anti-abortion and fundamentalist religious groups.

Daley had steadfastly stood behind the proposal despite criticism based not only on moral and religious grounds, but from aldermen and others who believed it was unfair to extend benefits to gay domestic partners but not to heterosexual domestic partners.

Passage of the bill by the city's powerful Finance Committee virtually assures its approval by the full City Council. The overwhelming votes of the pro-Daley aldermen on the committee allowed some of the mayor's allies to vote against it or to walk away from the controversy.

And there was plenty of controversy. Protesters spent much of Wednesday picketing and chanting outside of City Hall, saying the proposal rewards immorality and sanctions the gay lifestyle.

Some carried signs urging Chicago not to act like San Francisco. Others blasted Daley and claimed the vote would erode the morals of the city. The measure was also opposed by the powerful Catholic Archdiocese of Chicago, which, however, failed to send anyone to testify against the measure.

Today, President Clinton issued a statement announcing the date and themes of the White House Conference on Early Childhood Development and Learning: What New Research on the Brain Tells Us About Our Youngest Children. The day-long Conference will take place on April 17, 1997 at the White House. The Conference will highlight how critically important children's experiences before school are to their development and their later success in school and in life.

The Conference will focus on the practical applications of the latest scientific research on the brain, particularly for parents and care-givers. Also central to the Conference will be a discussion of the ways all sectors of society, including the medical, business, and faith communities, child care providers and government, can use this information to strengthen America's families.

Over the last four years, the Administration has invested heavily in research to help us better understand the importance of the first few years to child development and learning, and in strengthening efforts that support families and caregivers with young children, including:

□□Increased NIH Research Funding 23%. Unlike other research areas, the federal government is almost the sole funder of research of children and youth, supporting over 90% of research on children and youth. Under the

Clinton Administration, funding for NIH research has increased by 23% since 1993, to \$12.7 billion in 1997. Between 1993 and 1997, funding for NIH children's research has increased 25%, from 1.3 billion to 1.6 billion. This sustained level of investment has helped support many of the research advances the April White House Conference will explore. In FY 1998 the President's budget proposes to increase funding for NIH by an additional \$337 million.

Enhanced Head Start Participation and Quality and Created the Early Head Start Program for Children 0-3. The Administration has enhanced Head Start participation and increased its funding by 43% over the last four years, and created the Early Head Start program in 1994 to support families with children ages zero to three. Head Start provides low-income children and their families with comprehensive education, health services, and nutrition. The President's FY 1998 Budget further increases participation to reach 122,000 more children in FY 1998 than when he took office.

Commitment to Full Participation in WIC. The Administration dramatically increased participation in the WIC Supplemental Nutrition Program, providing 7.4 million pregnant women, infants, and children with nutrition packages and information and health referrals -- 1.7 million more than when President Clinton took office. And his FY 1998 Budget would achieve his goal of full participation in the WIC program by the end of FY 1998. Research shows that every \$1 invested in WIC prenatal serves saves up to \$4 in Medicaid costs in the first 60 days after birth. [USDA, 1990 Mathematica Policy Research].

Leading National Effort to Raise Immunization Rates. In 1993, the Administration launched a national effort to raise childhood immunization rates by reducing vaccination costs for parents and vaccine delivery services, and increasing community education and partnerships. Today, childhood immunization rates are at record high levels.

FYI, INS is holding briefings tomorrow for the media (and for Congress and community groups, I believe) on the new regulations that waive English & civics tests for some disabled individuals. The regulations also address matters of accomodation during the naturalization process for those who need it. Because some field offices held the cases of disabled applicants pending the issuance of these regulations, the result will be that a sizeable backlog of cases will have their cases processed for citizenship.

As you recall, DOJ determined that the oath could not be waived, so there will be some of the severely disabled who will not be able to be naturalized. Here is the letter. Elena, Jon Kaplan can work with you and the Vice President's office on the release. Here is what has changed since the last time it was circulated. I leave it to your discretion and Jon's as to whether anyone needs to have a final poke at the letter in view of the changes and the passage of time.

1. I eliminated a sentence saying that if the FCC finds a link between the ads and children's attitudes about liquor that the FCC should consider time restrictions on the advertising. Dan Tate thought that was too strong. We don't really need to say it, so I struck it. I alerted Rahm to this change, but don't know if he focused on it at the time. I don't know whether this would be viewed by others as subtracting from the oomph of what we're doing, but I think the change Dan suggested is an improvement.

2. Kahlua is supposedly on the brink of a big advertising campaign. I don't know whether what they are planning, which may have a strong subliminal appeal to children that is obvious to adults, may tip the balance at the FCC and cause them to act regardless of whatever we say or don't say.

3. Interest in this issue seems to have quieted on the Hill. I can't tell whether this is an enduring or temporary phenomenon.

Dear Chairman Hundt:

I write to ask your assistance in addressing a new and emerging challenge to parents struggling to raise safe, healthy children: the decision by manufacturers of hard liquor to advertise on television.

For half a century, these companies voluntarily refrained from such advertising. They understood that advertising over the uniquely powerful and pervasive medium of broadcasting could reach children inappropriately, encouraging them to drink before it is even legal for them to do so. Until now, these companies have shown appropriate restraint. For as long as there has been television, they have known that a voluntary ban was right and they lived by it.

Now, some companies have broken ranks and started placing hard liquor ads on TV. I was greatly disappointed by their decision. I have previously expressed my dismay at this action and called on the industry to urge all its members to return to their long-standing policy and stand by the ban. I am gratified to learn that, according to one survey, the vast majority of television stations are declining to air these advertisements. I applaud that stand.

I firmly believe that we have a national obligation to act strongly to protect our children from threats to their health and safety. That's why I have fought so strongly to impose appropriate regulations on the sale and distribution of cigarettes and smokeless tobacco and tobacco advertising that appeals to adolescents, to ensure that our schools and children are safe and drug-free, and to combat gangs and violence afflicting our youth.

I applaud your public remarks calling on the industry and broadcasters to reactivate the voluntary ban. I also commend your comments that the Federal Communications Commission has an obligation to consider any and all actions that would protect the public interest in the use of the public airwaves.

I urge the Commission to take all appropriate actions to explore what effects might ensue in light of the decision by manufacturers of hard liquor to abandon their long-standing voluntary ban on television advertising, specifically the impact on underage drinking.

We have made tremendous progress in recent years reducing the incidence of deaths due to drunk driving among our youth. We have taken important steps including the increase in the 1980s in the drinking age to 21 and the passage of zero tolerance legislation for underage

drinking and driving. But there is more to be done. Too many of our young people are dying in car crashes, and too many young people are starting to drink at an early age, leading to alcohol and other substance abuse problems.

I would appreciate your help and the help of the Commission in exploring the possible actions you could take to support our parents and children in response to the manufacturers' decision to break with the long and honorable tradition of not advertising on the broadcast medium.
