"Right now, everything is up for grabs," said a White House staffer familiar with the planning. "But we're going in with the idea that the federal government is going to have to heavily subsidize any child-care plan we put forward. The idea that tax breaks will resolve this national problem isn't realistic." Health and Human Services Secretary Donna Shalala has been promised a role in the project, and the White House has already met with aides to wayward Vermont Republican Jim Jeffords, to prepare for hearings by his Senate Labor and Human Resources Committee.

**Tax Cuts to Make College and Lifelong Learning More Affordable;
Helping Students and Families Get Ready for College Early**
DRAFT -- August 16, 1997

We must make the thirteenth and fourteenth years of education -- at least two years of college -- just as universal in America by the 21st Century as a high school education is today, and we must open the doors to all Americans.

*-- President Bill Clinton
State of the Union Address, February 4, 1997*

Today, as students prepare to head back to school, President Clinton encouraged families to take advantage of the new higher education opportunities contained in the historic balanced budget legislation. He also urged students and their parents to accept responsibility for preparing for college early, by choosing tough courses and working hard in school, beginning in students' middle school and junior high school years. To help families map out a bright future, the President released a new handbook on getting ready for college early, and a parents' guide to the new education tax cuts.

WHILE MORE STUDENTS ARE GOING TO COLLEGE, TOO MANY OTHERS MISS THE BENEFITS OF A POSTSECONDARY EDUCATION. In 1996, sixty-five percent of high school graduates were attending college by the following fall, an all-time high. Yet far too many of our young people still lack a college education or advanced training, limiting their ability to prosper in the 21st Century knowledge economy. College graduates are half as likely to be unemployed as high school graduates. Moreover, on average, a college graduate will earn \$600,000 more over the course of a lifetime than a high school graduate -- and this gap is widening. **Someone with an associate degree from a two year college earns more than a high school graduate, as well.**

People have been looking into this question of whether we should reconsider our (tentative) definition of means tested benefits, such that it would exclude the new child health program. Everyone has concluded or will probably conclude soon that we should give up on this. Apparently, there is some legal argument that you could exclude the new program, on the grounds that capped entitlements should be excluded. However, our opponents might argue that this clouds our big argument (the colloquy when the Byrd Rule knocked out a definition last year made an important mandatory/discretionary distinction).

Also, even if this logic were acceptable to OLC, the same logic would also let TANF off the hook -- and the only means tested programs we have defined in the entire government are SSI, food stamps, Medicaid, TANF, and probably now this new child health program. Taking TANF off the list too would risk making Lamar Smith even madder than he is, such that he would mount a more serious legislative effort to get a much meaner definition into the law. So there seems to be an emerging consensus that we are at the end of the line on this -- HHS, Apfel, NEC, and I guess me too. OMB is still checking with Josh Gotbaum, but I think he will agree. HHS will probably officially issue it next week, so let me know if you aren't ready to drop this.

Civil Rights Investigations of Higher Education in California and Texas

The Office for Civil Rights (OCR) at the Department of Education is continuing its investigation of the current admissions policies at the three University of California law schools. Preliminary analysis indicates a significant disparity in the admission rate for certain minority group students compared to whites. The investigation is now in an information-gathering phase, which is likely to extend through the end of the year. The California investigation has recently been attacked by Senators Hatch and McConnell, who wrote Secretary Riley July 31 to denounce the inquiry as an affront to the voters of California and a bureaucratic attempt to preserve affirmative action. The two senators have called for OCR to abandon the inquiry immediately, and have threatened hearings and an amendment to prohibit the use of Department funds to investigate race-neutral policies. OCR responds that it is obliged to investigate a legitimate complaint, and notes that the investigation concerns current admissions policies, rather than the widely-reported decline in minority admissions following the discontinuation of UC's affirmative action program.

An OCR-initiated investigation of the Texas higher education system, part of a series of state higher education desegregation reviews, continues as well. The review will determine, consistent with the Supreme Court's Fordice decision, whether vestiges of past discrimination remain in the Texas system. The Fordice review has been combined with an investigation of a complaint filed with OCR last fall, asserting that Texas continues to operate a dual system of higher education and challenging the state's implementation of the Hopwood decision. As with California, information-gathering for this investigation is likely to extend through the end of the year.

1. Crime: Child Safety Locks -- Earlier this week, Smith and Wesson-- the world's leading manufacturer of handguns-- announced that as of September 2, all of their handguns sold for commercial use will come with a child safety lock made by Master Lock. The child safety lock developed by Master Lock is a keyed, locking device that blocks access to the firing mechanism. When the lock is in place, the trigger cannot be pulled until the lock is removed. As you know, your juvenile crime legislation would require all federally-licensed gun dealers to provide a child safety lock with every handgun sold. You also directed the federal agencies to ensure that every federal law enforcement agent has a child safety lock for their handgun by October 15.

2. Welfare Reform: Legal Immigrants Losing Food Stamps -- This month, approximately 900,000 legal immigrants will lose food stamps. The welfare law required states to drop legal immigrants from the rolls within a year after the law was signed. With USDA's assistance, most states have arranged to heavily backlit the cutoffs, so that the vast majority are occurring this month, at the last possible moment. Legal immigrants who were not receiving food stamps when the law was signed have been rejected by states since last August. While we have proposed slight delays in these cutoffs, we have never proposed to rescind them in our budget.

With our support, Congress enacted a new option for states that allows them to purchase federal food stamps for legal immigrants. Washington state is already doing this, with a number of states expected to follow, including Massachusetts and New York. New York will pay for children, the disabled, and the elderly legal immigrants.

USDA is publicizing the fact that there are still food programs open to legal immigrant children, seniors, WIC, etc. However, they do not have an estimate of how many of the 900,000 people can get access to other food programs.
