Child Support Computer Systems

Nine or more states -- including California -- are expected to fail to meet the 10/1/97 deadline for to have in place state-wide child support computer systems. Under current law, HHS must disapprove a state's child support plan if it does not meet the computer systems requirement -- thus withholding all federal child support funds from those states, a process that will take six months or more. Senator Feinstein wants to enact a temporary moratorium on penalties to states failing to meet this deadline.

HHS, OMB, and DPC oppose such a moratorium. Now -- just as welfare reform's tough new child support rules are beginning to take effect -- is the wrong time to signal to states that we are willing to let them off the hook. Instead, we proposed to accept the invitation of the Ways and Means Committee to work with them to develop a legislative solution to develop a new, more effective penalty system -- one that will impose tough, immediate penalties rather than withhold all federal funds. We can develop this proposal and enact it before the current penalties actually take effect.

Background

Nine or more states are expected to fail to meet the 10/1/97 deadline for child support computer systems. The 1988 Family Support Act required states to have "in operation a single, state-wide automated data processing, information, and retrieval system" by 10/1/95; this deadline was extended by two years in the last Congress.

The states expected to fail are California, Michigan, Illinois, Pennsylvania, Ohio, Maryland, D.C., Nevada, and Hawaii. Other possibilities include New York, Florida, Texas, Indiana, South Carolina, and New Mexico. We won't actually know on October 1st how many states have failed, because under the law states have until December 31st to submit to HHS a state plan amendment indicating that their child support system was completed and operating as of October 1st. HHS must then conduct certification reviews to assess states compliance. Under current law, HHS must disapprove a state's child support plan if it does not meet the computer systems requirement -- thus withholding all federal child support funds from those states, a process that will take six months or more. (The federal government pays 66% of administrative child support enforcement costs, and 90% for computer systems costs before FY 1997 and 80% up to a total of \$400 million for costs thereafter.) In addition, HHS must reduce the TANF grant by between one and five percent. California says it will lose \$300 million in federal child support payments and between \$37 and \$185 million in TANF payments.

MEMORANDUM FOR THE CHIEF OF STAFF

SUBJECT: Tobacco Roll Out Plan

This memo describes the roll out plan for our tobacco announcement. Our goal is to build momentum and support for the enactment of comprehensive tobacco control legislation next year.

Notifying Key Groups

Prior to the announcement, we will notify key groups about the President's plan to enact comprehensive legislation to reduce youth smoking. We will work with OPL, Legislative Affairs, Intergovernmental Affairs, and HHS to ensure that leaders in public health, in Congress, among the attorneys general, and among governors are prepared to validate the President's stand.

Donna and I will meet with the House and Senate Democratic Tobacco Task Forces late in the day on Tuesday. We will also try to meet with the Republican leadership. I will call Governors Hunt and Patton. (Chiles?)

Press Strategy

There will be considerable press interest in our announcement. We should take advantage of the heightened interest to get out our message, shape the debate, and build momentum for enactment of our plan.

To get the most out of the event, we should surround the President with leaders from public health, the attorneys general, and possibly the Congress. Our goal is a picture that sends a clear message that we are putting the public interest first. It is a message that contrasts with the AGs announcement, which although not by design, ended up appearing to be validated by the industry and trial attorneys, and ultimately at odds with the public interest.

The event itself will be limited to remarks by the Vice-President and President. Donna and I will join the President, Vice-President, and validators on stage. Donna and I will lead Mike McCurry's afternoon briefing.

In addition to the President's and Vice-President's remarks, we will provide a short white paper

that can be handed out, a backgrounder that promotes the Administration's record, and Q&As.

Follow-up

In addition to the typical follow-up briefings for interested groups, we will develop a detailed plan of actions we will take throughout the remainder of 1997 to maintain interest and build momentum for enactment of comprehensive legislation next year. We will work with the Vice-President and his staff to establish a visible leadership role for him.

Legislative Strategy

We will need to work closely with the Congress to lay the groundwork for Congressional action next year. At least six committees in the Senate and possibly as many in the House would have jurisdiction over legislation enacting the President's plan. The lack of an effective legislative strategy has been cited repeatedly as a key reason for the failure of attorney's general proposed settlement. We will not repeat their mistake.

Attached is Cynthia's and my best effort to make sense of where we are on Shaw's new workfare compromise. Since there are major choices to be made and we are tentatively scheduled to talk with Tanner/Stenholm tomorrow at 11, it would be very helpful if you could either read this tonight or if we get a chance to talk before the meeting. (There's always the staff meeting at 9:15 as a fallback.)

We got the agencies' reactions this morning. The main news items are: (1) Haskins' draft legislation raises concerns on labor protections, but they seem to be fixable IF Haskins is sincere in wanting to fix them; (2) the FICA/FUTA exemption includes "private sector workfare", a concept we are afraid will blossom if employers can avoid those taxes, to the detriment of private sector jobs; and (3) the definition of community service is so broad that employers may have an incentive to call everything community service to get around FICA.

Elena, DOL says that the draft manages to allow the checks to come from welfare offices rather than from the employer, without doing violence to the person's employee status. (Employers would still be required to keep records of hours worked.)

We pushed HHS to quantify how much these provisions would weaken the work requirements, an assignment they were singularly unenthusiastic about. They claim they will get us something by COB today. DOL is quietly checking with the labor unions to see what they think of all this. Emily is checking with Democratic Governors to see if any of them are already committed to Shaw's proposal.

 - Call Democratic Governors asap to try to prevent defections to Shaw

3. Support or do not object to proposal; offer a number of technical suggestions ASAP via Tanner
 - Offer DOL fixes to ensure no negative implications for labor protections
 - Ensure narrow definition of community service; rule out private sector workfare
 - Other technical fixes

Description of W&M compromise:

1. Defines maximum hours of work experience/community services, including private sector workfare (TANF + food stamps - child support collected).
2. If maximum hours calculation above falls short of law's work requirements, allows states to use any other work activity to reach work requirements -- job search, vocational education, training directly related to employment, and education for those without a high school diploma. The current 6-week limit on job search and 12-month limit on voc ed would be lifted for this purpose.
3. Exempts work experience and community service from FICA and FUTA. (Defines those two work activities so broadly that it raises concern that it could encompass unsubsidized or subsidized jobs.)
4. Stated intent is to preserve employee status, but DOL feels legislative language does not make this clear. They are drafting potential fixes to this problems in case we want them. Allows payment for work experience/community service to be paid by welfare office instead of "employer."

Four Possible Alternatives

Alternative 1:

- Agree only to FICA/FUTA exemption and allowing welfare office to make payment instead of employer (close to our July offer).

Alternative 2:

- No agreement to maximum hours calculation.
- Give all states more flexibility in work activities over 20 hours per week (30 hours for two parent families). Current law already allows greater flexibility over 20 hours (30 hours) by permitting job skills training directly related to employment and education for those without a high school diploma. We would go beyond that by permitting job search/job readiness beyond the 6 weeks currently allowed.
- Exempt work experience/community service from FICA/FUTA, but stipulate that this does not apply to private sector workfare and that private sector employers must pay FICA/FUTA on portion of wages they pay.
- Do not weaken May Department of Labor ruling on employee status/worker protections; make it an option for wage to continue to come from welfare office, not employer.

Alternative 3:

- Similar to Alternative 2, but work off of Ways and Means “maximum hours” structure. (This approach was suggested by Stenholm.) No change below 20 hours (or 30 for two parent families), but for those states whose benefits can’t support the required number of hours above 20 (or 30) hours, permit job search/job placement with no 6 week limit. This alternative would not permit vocational education in excess of 12 months above 20 (or 30) hours per week as would the Ways and Means proposal.
- Exempt work experience/community service from FICA/FUTA, but stipulate that this does not apply to private sector workfare and that private sector employers must pay FICA/FUTA on portion of wages they pay.
- Do not weaken May Department of Labor ruling on employee status/worker protections; make it an option for wage to continue to come from welfare office, not employer.

Alternative 4:

- Ways and Means “maximum hours” structure for hours above and below 20 hours, but permit only two additional work activities: (1) job search/job placement in excess of 6 weeks; and (2) job skills training directly related to employment. This alternative would not permit vocational education in excess of 12 months above 20 (or 30) hours per week as would the Ways and Means proposal.
- Exempt work experience/community service from FICA/FUTA, but stipulate that this does not apply to private sector workfare and that private sector employers must pay FICA/FUTA on portion of wages they pay.
- Do not weaken May Department of Labor ruling on employee status/worker protections; make it an option for wage to continue to come from welfare office, not employer.

Other Possible Things to Demand in Exchange

- Waivers:
 - Do not allow prior law waiver exemptions to count as work in the numerator (i.e., drug treatment, education, job search) even if a state continues its waiver. (Alternatively: do not count as work unless a state is continuing research group policies in order to complete an impact evaluation of a waiver demonstration.)
 - The five year time limit starts when state joins TANF, not at the end of the waiver period, as even if the state previously had a time limit of a different length under a waiver.
- Bifurcation -- clarify that state programs must meet same work requirements as federal dollars (this is a very big item)
- Job search limit of 6 weeks is lifetime, not annual (HHS draft reg calls it annual).

SUBJECT: Tobacco Rollout Plan

This memo describes the rollout plan for our tobacco announcement. Our goal is to build momentum and support for the enactment of comprehensive tobacco legislation within the next year.

Notifying Key Players

Prior to the announcement, we will inform key players about what the President plans to say on Wednesday. We are working with OPL, Legislative Affairs, Intergovernmental Affairs, and HHS toward ensuring that key Members of Congress, attorneys general, governors, and leaders of the public health community are prepared to validate the President's position.

Donna and I will meet with the House and Senate Democratic Tobacco Task Forces late in the day on Tuesday. We will offer to meet with the Republican leadership. I will call Governors Hunt, Patton, and Chiles and David Kessler, C. Everett Koop, and Matt Myers.

Event and Communications

There will be considerable press interest in our announcement. We should take advantage of the heightened interest to get out our message, shape the debate, and build momentum for enactment of comprehensive tobacco legislation.

McCurry, Rahm, and I have developed a plan to give advance details of the President's proposal to the major papers for Wednesday morning. With so many Members of Congress being briefed tomorrow, we don't think the story would hold anyway.

To get the most out of the event itself, we should do a Rose Garden event where we can surround the President with leaders from public health, the attorneys general, and the Congress. Our goal is a picture that sends a clear message that we are putting the public interest first. From the public health community, we expect the leaders of the American Cancer Society, the American Heart Association, and the American Medical Association, David Kessler, Matt Myers, and possibly C. Everett Koop. From the attorneys general, we expect Mike Moore, Christine Gregoire, Grant Woods, and possibly Bob Butterworth and Scott Harshberger. From Congress,

we hope to attract members and leadership from both parties. The audience of 100-150, will be a mix of public health experts who participated in our public outreach meetings, agency staff who conducted the interagency review, and individuals from a list we requested from the Campaign for Tobacco-Free Kids.

The event itself will be limited to remarks by the Vice-President and President. Donna, Dan Glickman, and I will join the President, Vice-President, and validators on stage. Donna and I will lead Mike McCurry's afternoon briefing.

We will provide a short handout to the press describing the President's approach, and we will prepare Q&As for the press office and others.

Follow-up

In addition to the typical follow-up briefings for interested groups, we will develop a detailed plan of actions we will take throughout the remainder of 1997 to maintain interest and build momentum for enactment of comprehensive legislation next year. At the same time, we will develop a detailed plan for working with Congress to enact legislation next year. The President should announce Wednesday that he will invite Congressional leaders to the White House next month to develop a bipartisan process to enact tobacco legislation. We will work with the Vice-President and his staff to establish a visible leadership role for him.
