Folks--this issue has been kicking around and getting more momentum. VA has analyzed over the last few years the claims of these Filipinos for benefits as veterans having fought for the US in WWII. I believe the conclusion is that it would be extremely costly but I don't believe the White House has ever engaged in a substantive analysis of the merits of the claim other than the financial cost. I think we need a process to have this resolved--it has gotten on the President's radar screen. I would be happy to coordinate this process, if you'll assign the appropriate staff members for this work. Thank you.

President Submits Legislation to Restore Traditional Trade Authority

Tuesday, September 16, 1997

Sensible Bipartisan Legislation. Today, President Clinton will submit legislation to Congress that restores the President's traditional authority to negotiate trade agreements and break down barriers to American exports. This negotiating authority legislation will help keep our economy on the right track and create good American jobs, while honoring our commitment to our workers and environment. We expect this legislation will garner the bipartisan support it deserves.

Open Trade is Critical to America's Continued Prosperity. The American economy is on the move again. The President's three-part economic strategy -- cutting the deficit to spur private sector investment, investing in critical priorities like education and training, and opening markets abroad -- is a proven success. Since President Clinton took office, the American economy has generated nearly 13 million new jobs, unemployment is below 5%, wages are up, and the deficit has been cut by more than 85%. America is in the midst of a longer period of sustained growth than any other major economy in the world; one-third of our growth depends on overseas trade.

American Exports Create Millions of High-Paying Jobs. Our aggressive export strategy has paid off for American companies and workers. America is once again the world's largest exporter, the largest producer of semiconductors, and the largest producer of automobiles. Exports support over 11.5 million jobs in the United States, including one in five manufacturing jobs. Over the last four years alone, exports have created 1.7 million new jobs -- jobs that typically pay 15 percent more than non-export-related jobs.

We Need To Keep Breaking Down Foreign Trade Barriers. To keep our economy on the right track, we need to give the President the power that every President since Ford has had to break down unfair foreign barriers to American exports. This legislation restores the President's power to negotiate agreements that will help American businesses compete and win.

Legislation Honors Our Commitment to America's Workers and Our Environment. As we expand trade, the President is committed to pursuing three objectives: (1) to break down unfair foreign trade barriers and create good American jobs; (2) to promote and advance worker rights; and (3) to promote responsible environmental protections. As we renew fast track authority, our goal has been to give the President an array of negotiating tools to advance those objectives and level the playing field for American workers in the trade deals:

- **Trade Agreements.** This bill permits labor/environmental provisions "directly related to trade" to be brought back to Congress under fast track authority.
- **Side Agreements.** The President has extensive executive authority to reach labor/environmental agreements with countries. We have already committed to conclude companion labor/environment agreements in future trade agreements where appropriate, and Chile has already agreed to enter such agreements.

- Other Agreements. This Administration has done more than any other to press countries to improve labor and environmental protection -- and we will continue to do so, whether through the ILO, the WTO, the UN, or international financial institutions. We should be concerned about improving conditions in all countries, not just in free trade partners.

President is Committed to Ensuring that Everyone Benefits from the Global Economy.

President Clinton has always recognized that we have a special obligation to help low wage and dislocated workers. That's why he fought to raise the minimum wage, provide a more generous Earned Income Tax Credit, increase investment in training, and win new pension and health benefits for workers. That effort has already brought real results for low wage workers:

- Since the President's 1993 Economic Plan passed, the real average income of the poorest 20 percent of families has increased nearly \$1,000 -- or 9.7 percent.
- In 1995 -- the most recent year data are available -- America saw its largest decline in income inequality and the biggest drop in the number of people in poverty in 27 years.

As trade helps America continue to prosper, the President will continue his fight to expand opportunities for dislocated and low wage workers.

Specific Provisions of the Bill Include:

- Authority to Open Markets: The bill gives the President authority to negotiate global, regional, sectoral and/or bilateral trade agreements, which would be brought back for Congressional approval under "fast track" procedures (extensive consultations, limited debate, no amendments). This authority is critical to give our negotiators the credibility they need to secure good agreements.
- Reaffirms Commitment to Labor/Environment: The bill includes a specific negotiating instruction to improve labor rights and environmental protection abroad (a first-ever reference to the environment in fast track legislation). Provisions in bilateral free trade agreements must be "directly related to trade," but the Administration may also seek side agreements, where appropriate.
- Pursues Trade Priorities: The bill contains negotiating objectives emphasizing key U.S. trading interests, such as agriculture, services, investment, intellectual property, and the need for the U.S. to preserve its health and safety laws and to vigorously enforce U.S. trade laws.
- Enhanced Congressional Consultations: We have added strong language to ensure Congress is a full partner in setting objectives and establishing trade priorities for American negotiators, including some provisions that have never before been included in fast track bills: (1) a requirement that the Administration inform Congress of its negotiating objectives for a specific agreement before negotiations begin; (2) a requirement that the Administration consult before signing a trade agreement about any parallel agreements, such as labor and environmental side agreements.
- Duration. Authority granted until 2001, with extension until 2005 only after a congressional vote.

Good morning. . Today I want to talk about one of the most important things we must do to keep our country strong and growing into the 21st century. In recent days, I have laid out an ambitious action agenda for the remainder of this legislative session and year. We have pledged to work hard to make sure the Congress appropriates the priorities we fought so hard for in our balanced budget agreement -- everything from expanding educational opportunity and challenging our students, schools and teachers to meet the highest standards to ratifying a worldwide climate change treaty to passing campaign finance reform, to assisting in efforts to forge lasting peace in places like Northern Ireland and the Middle East. But, we must not overlook this simple fact. As we prepare to enter a new century and a new millennium, the health of our nation is absolutely dependent on the health of our people -- and especially the health of our children.

That is why last year, I launched the nation's first-ever comprehensive program to protect children from the dangers of tobacco. In August of last year, we initiated an FDA final rule, requiring tobacco companies to educate our children about the dangers of smoking and retailers to enforce laws prohibiting the sale of cigarettes to anyone under the age of 18. And we set a goal of reducing tobacco use by children and adolescents by 50 percent in seven years. Earlier this year, our approach was upheld by a federal judge in North Carolina.

These victories for the public health, along with the aggressive efforts of the attorneys general, drove the tobacco companies to the bargaining table and extracted concessions from them that would have been unimaginable just a short time ago. Joe Camel and the Marlboro Man are no longer around to glamorize smoking. And we are now in the midst of an unprecedented national debate involving members of my Administration, the public health community, the attorneys general, members of Congress, tobacco farmers and others to develop a comprehensive tobacco policy.

This broad, bipartisan effort has led us from confrontation, denial and inertia to the brink of action. Today, I want to challenge the Congress to build on this historic opportunity by passing sweeping tobacco legislation that has one goal in mind -- the dramatic reduction of teen smoking. In the coming weeks I will invite Congressional leaders from both parties to the White House to launch a bipartisan effort to enact federal tobacco legislation. There are five key elements that must be at the heart of any national tobacco legislation.

First, reducing teen smoking has always been this Administration's bottom line. Now it must be the industry's bottom line. That is why I believe that tobacco legislation must include a

comprehensive plan to reduce teen smoking, including tough penalties if targets are not met. Every day, 3,000 young people start smoking, and 1,000 of them will die early as a result. We cannot turn our backs on this tragedy. I believe the right kind of tobacco legislation must include stiff penalties that are non-deductible, uncapped and escalating to give the tobacco industry the strongest possible incentive to stop targeting kids. One of the surest ways of reducing youth smoking is to increase the price of cigarettes. By some estimates, a 10% increase in cigarette prices will lead to a 7% drop in youth smoking.

Today, I am calling for a combination of industry payments and penalties that could increase the price of cigarettes by up to \$1.50 a pack over the next decade if the youth reduction targets are not met. And I call on the House to follow the lead of the Senate and repeal the provision giving the tobacco industry a \$50 billion credit.

Second, any legislation must affirm the full authority of the FDA to regulate tobacco products. I believe that the FDA's jurisdiction over tobacco products must be as great and unencumbered as its authority over other drugs and devices.

Third, effective legislation must include measures to hold the industry accountable for past misconduct, especially efforts to market products to children, while insisting that it change the way it does business. That means greater document disclosure and, most importantly, no marketing or advertising directed to children.

Fourth, federal tobacco legislation must provide enough funds and resources to not only reduce youth smoking, but to meet other public health goals, such as the reduction of environmental, or second-hand tobacco smoke, the expansion of smoking cessation programs, the strengthening of international efforts to control tobacco and the provision of funds for medical research and other health objectives. These additional resources will build on the 15-cents-a-pack cigarette tax included in our balanced budget agreement to help states provide health care for up to 5 million uninsured children and help prevent many young people from taking up smoking in the first place.

And finally, any tobacco legislation must protect tobacco farmers and their communities. We know that most tobacco farmers live and work on small, family farms. In some states, entire communities rely on income from the tobacco crop. Any legislation must ensure the protection of these tobacco farmers, their families and their communities.

Let me be clear: this is not about money or how much we can extract from the tobacco industry. It is about protecting the health of America's most precious resource -- our children. Again, I want to thank Secretary Shalala, Secretary Glickman, and Bruce Reed of my Administration and all those who have worked so hard to bring us to this point. You have created an historic opportunity for progress in our efforts to reduce teen smoking.

FIGHTING YOUTH TOBACCO USE

Because President Clinton understands the danger of tobacco use to the health of our children, he has taken strong, bold action on this pressing public health concern.

A RECORD OF ACHIEVEMENT

First-Ever Plan to Protect Our Children from Tobacco. On August 10, 1995, President Clinton announced broad executive action to protect our nation's young people from the dangers of tobacco by sharply restricting the advertising, promotion, distribution, and marketing of cigarettes to teenagers. The President authorized the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) to initiate a broad series of steps all designed to stop sales and marketing of cigarettes and smokeless tobacco to children. The President's comprehensive and coordinated plan is intended to reduce tobacco use by children and teenagers by 50% in seven years.

Strong FDA Action. One year later, on August 23, 1996, the President's program was launched with the publication of the FDA final rule on tobacco and children. The rule required tobacco companies to educate children and teenagers about the dangers of cigarettes and smokeless tobacco through a national multi-media campaign.

Cracking Down on Youth Access to Tobacco. On February 28, 1997, the FDA made 18 the minimum age to purchase tobacco products nationwide and required photo I.D.s for anyone under the age of 27.

Courts Affirm the Clinton Administration's Efforts To Protect Our Children from Tobacco. On April 25, 1997, a Federal District Court in North Carolina affirmed the FDA's authority to regulate tobacco as a drug and restrict children's access to tobacco products.

Protecting Federal Employees. On July 31, 1997, President Clinton announced an executive order to protect federal employees from environmental tobacco smoke. This executive order banned smoking in and around federal Executive Branch facilities.
