



SUBJECT: LEGISLATIVE REPORT

The House Ways and Means Committee marked up compromise legislation today to modify provisions related to farmers cooperatives and deferral of overseas taxes that were item vetoed by the President. It is possible that the bill will be considered on the House suspension calendar early next week. Prospects in the Senate are less clear.

Highway Bill: House Transportation full committee markup Wednesday morning at 10am. As of early this evening, Transportation Committee staff expect that the committee will vote on reporting a 6-month short-term extension; and will consider, but will stop short of reporting, the multiyear bill. Instead they will vote on a committee resolution endorsing the principles of the six-year bill (which may include a trigger to reduce spending if deficit targets are breached). On the Senate side, on Thursday, the Senate Banking Committee will markup a committee amendment to the highway bill -- which was reported last week by Environment and Public Works Comm. -- to reauthorize transit programs (over which Banking Comm. has jurisdiction).

On Wednesday morning at 10:00 am, the House Budget Committee will hold the first hearing in a series this fall on the Social Security System.

1. Barry Clendenon who runs this at OMB, and was at our meeting yesterday, hadn't seen your \$20-25 mill. figure cited in this a.m. request, said he thought it would be much lower at \$5-10, but wanted to get FDA's scrubbed numbers. He said he hadn't talked to Josh Gotbaum about this.
2. Janice Oliver at FDA says they will send numbers over to OMB in an hour, she expects the figure to be \$28 mill.
3. I encouraged Barry to talk to Gotbaum (who I haven't heard back from) and come up with a figure, even if it is a range, that can be floated.
4. FYI. USDA says that the groups will be very unhappy if this is just supporting fruits and vegs and FDA. They plan to ask for \$40 mill. (testing, outreach, etc) according to Olsen and will send that figure over to their OMB guy Wetherly.

A range seems preferable to a figure given the speed of these caluclations, but a substantial figure seems better than a minimal commitment. Barry at one point said it was a \$1-20 million range. That is obviously so small as to not imply not being a significant comitment. It might be worth making a call to Josh G. and reminding him we need a defensible number here.

MAKING TWO YEARS OF COLLEGE UNIVERSALLY AVAILABLE, AND PROMOTING A LIFETIME OF LEARNING

President Clinton fought for a Bipartisan Balanced Budget that included a \$1,500 HOPE Scholarship and a Lifetime Learning Tax Credit for middle income families, and a \$3,000 maximum Pell Grant scholarship for lower-income families. Today the President will release a new report which shows how these initiatives will help ensure that anyone can afford tuition and fees for two years at a community college, and highlights how community colleges are providing a high-quality education and preparing millions of Americans to participate in the 21st Century economy. The President will also challenge Congress to follow through on the Balanced Budget Agreement, not shut the door on thousands of adult students.

Community Colleges are Dynamic Institutions that Provide a High Quality, Affordable Education.

Today the President travels to San Jacinto College, near Houston, to release a new report on community colleges by the U.S. Department of Education. Fifty years after the Truman Commission Report called for a nationwide network of public community colleges, this report highlights the critical role being played by community colleges in preparing the workforce of the 21st Century. The report describes how these institutions provide a high quality education to a diverse array of Americans at various stages in their lives and careers, and underscores that community colleges are remarkably affordable, with an average cost expected to run just over \$1,300 next fall.

The HOPE Scholarship Cuts Tuition and Fee Costs at Community Colleges by 88%. New projections by the Department of Education indicate that in the 1998-99 school year, the maximum HOPE Scholarship will cover 88 percent of the national average full-time tuition and fees at community colleges. In seven States, including Texas, HOPE covers 100 percent of community college tuition and fees. In 35 States, the maximum HOPE Scholarship covers 75 percent or more of tuition and fees. 5.8 million students are expected to benefit from the HOPE Scholarship at all types of higher education institutions.

Pell Grant Increase Will Benefit 1.4 Million Community College Students. The Department of Education estimates that 1.4 million community college students will receive an average Pell Grant in 1998-99 of \$1,810. Pell Grants are available on a sliding scale based on income. The Bipartisan Balanced Budget Agreement includes the President's proposal for the largest increase in the grant in two decades, to a maximum of \$3,000.

7.1 Million Will Benefit from Lifetime Learning Tax Credit. For students beyond their first two years of college, including those who are returning to school (full or part time) to upgrade their skills or change careers, the Taxpayers Relief Act offers a 20 percent tax credit for the first \$5,000 of tuition and fees paid by a student. It is expected that 7.1 million students will take advantage of the credit to help pay for postsecondary education.

Many Adults Who Return to School Will be Left Out if Congress Does Not Finish the Job. The Department of Education estimates that 218,000 students -- and millions more who could consider

college -- will not be able to benefit fully from HOPE or Pell unless the President's budget request for the Pell Grant program is adopted -- as required by the Bipartisan Balanced Budget Agreement. The President's request included a provision to ensure that so-called "independent" students -- those who are over age 24, or are married or veterans, can receive Pell Grants if they are low-income. (Like other low-income students, their eligibility for HOPE Scholarships is limited by their tax liability). A House-Senate conference committee is currently considering this issue. If they do not act to address this problem, college may be out of reach for students like these:

- A 22-year-old veteran making only \$10,000 a year.
- A married 35-year-old with *joint* income of only \$14,000.
- A 30-year-old with income of only \$11,000.



MEMORANDUM TO THE CHIEF OF STAFF

SUBJECT: ONDCP Document Entitled "Blueprint for a Drug Free America"

Last week ONDCP circulated a draft document entitled "Blueprint for a Drug Free America." The document lays out "performance targets" for the conduct of the anti-drug abuse program in the next five - ten years. The targets and dates are aggressive. For example, among the targets are the following: 1) 50 percent reduction in the overall rate of illicit drug use in the U.S. by 2007; and 2) 50 percent reduction in the available supply of drugs in the U.S. by 2007. The document indicates that the proposed performance targets must be supported by funding if they are to be realized.

We have no evidence that would suggest that the draft goals can be achieved without substantial increases in Federal drug budgets in 1999 and beyond. Several agencies have made similar complaints to ONDCP (e.g., Justice and Treasury). As such, release of the document would be problematic and would imply FY 1999 budgetary trade-offs not yet made in favor of anti-drug spending and against other domestic discretionary spending. **We suggest that the document be withheld until after submission of the 1999 President's Budget, when all agencies must submit their performance plans and targets to Congress. Those plans must be directly linked to multi-year Presidential budget request levels.**

General McCaffrey is likely to be upset if the document is not released. His likely arguments for release, beyond his desire to pursue a vigorous fight against drug abuse, will be:

-- The 1997 President's Drug Strategy released by ONDCP this spring indicates that performance measures will be provided to Congress this fiscal year (FY 1997).

-- General McCaffrey is supposed to meet with the Speaker tomorrow afternoon (Thursday), and would like to provide the Speaker with this document. (Apparently, the Speaker wants even more aggressive performance measures than those outlined by ONDCP).

-- Without release of the document, the Speaker may decide to delay reauthorization of ONDCP. (Because ONDCP is due to receive 1998 appropriations anyway, the threat of a lack of reauthorization is not terribly significant.)

Highway bill markup: House Commerce Committee this afternoon voted to report out a simple 6-month extension of ISTEA. Chairman Shuster indicated that the House Leadership has agreed to this approach. He also said the Leadership has agreed to consider Shuster's multiyear reauthorization (BESTEA) next year. The Committee voted on several amendments to the multiyear bill today, but is holding the bill in Committee until next session. The amendments included: extending the authorization to 6 years; a trigger to reduce funding levels if BBA revenue or deficit targets are breached (CBO will not score the trigger). However, Shuster put off inclusion of Member projects until further committee action next year.
