# **PRESIDENT CLINTON'S AMERICA READS WORK-STUDY CHALLENGE**

October 21, 1997

*Forty percent of our children read below the basic level in the fourth grade, as reported by the 1994 National Assessment of Educational Progress. Research shows that these children too often fall further behind in school, lose interest, give up, and drop out. To help these children, President Clinton launched the America Reads Challenge. In order to empower parents and to encourage all States and schools to reach for the America Reads goal, the President also proposed voluntary national standards and tests in the fourth grade.*

**TODAY, PRESIDENT CLINTON WILL ANNOUNCE THAT NEARLY 800 COLLEGES AND UNIVERSITIES, FROM EVERY STATE, HAVE PLEDGED TO COMMIT WORK-STUDY SLOTS TO HELP ENSURE THAT EVERY AMERICAN CHILD CAN READ WELL AND INDEPENDENTLY.** Less than a year ago, the Secretary of Education issued a regulation allowing the Federal Work-Study Program to pay 100 percent of the wages for students who work as reading tutors for elementary school children, and the President named a steering committee of 21 college and university presidents who volunteered to start their own programs and to encourage other colleges to do the same. *As of today, 790 colleges and universities have pledged tutors to America Reads.*

## **TODAY'S ANNOUNCEMENT BY PRESIDENT CLINTON IS ANOTHER STEP FORWARD IN HIS EFFORT TO INVOLVE COLLEGE STUDENTS IN HELPING EVERY CHILD TO READ.**

- On August 26, 1996, in Wyandotte, Michigan, President Clinton announced his America Reads Challenge, a \$2.75 billion plan to make sure that every child is literate by the end of 3rd grade.
- In September 1996, he challenged colleges to commit a substantial part of their increase in work-study funding -- the FY 1997 Budget included a 35% increase -- to community service, including tutoring reading.
- In November 1996, President Clinton instructed the Secretary of Education to issue a regulation allowing the Federal Work-Study Program to pay 100 percent of the wages for students who work as reading tutors for elementary school children.
- In December 1996, the President announced the creation of a 21-member steering committee of college presidents who volunteered to start their own programs and to encourage other colleges to do the same.
- In February 1997, the President announced the creation of D.C. Reads, a tutoring effort involving seven local colleges and universities.
- Today he is reporting on the nationwide involvement of colleges and universities in the America Reads Work Study Challenge.

## **CONGRESS NEEDS TO PROVIDE THE SUPPORT STRUCTURE FOR THESE AND OTHER**

**TUTORING EFFORTS.** There is enormous interest in America Reads on college campuses and in communities, but to effectively tap this interest requires a commitment of resources for training, coordination, and materials. That is why the President insisted that this investment be a part of the Bipartisan Balanced Budget Agreement. The President's five-year, \$2.75 billion proposal, which was forwarded to Congress in April, would fund 25,000 reading specialists and coordinators to mobilize 1 million tutors for 3 million children in grades K-3 who need help. Recognizing that parents are their children's first and most important teachers, the America Reads Challenge Act would also foster effective programs to provide assistance for interested parents to provide the firm foundation their children need to do well in school and to become successful readers.

**THE AMERICA READS INITIATIVE ALSO INCORPORATES OTHER PROGRAMS,** including early childhood development through the expansion of Head Start and Even Start; bringing the best teaching practices to classrooms; supporting research and evaluation on reading; and building partnerships with the private sector, including following up on related commitments to the Service Summit.

I met with Mayor Paul Helmke (R-Ft. Wayne, IN), president of the US Conf. of Mayors, DeeDee Corradini (D-Salt Lake City), vice president of USCM, and Tom Cochran, executive director, USCM yesterday to discuss a number of

issues of concern to them and the White House. Regarding a possible WH Conference on Public Schools, I indicated that we are actively considering their proposal and it seemed clear to me that any such conference would need the involvement of a number of major stakeholders in education (more than mayors). They mentioned superintendents, school boards, and teacher organizations as perhaps logical but caution against too many. They also do not want to get lost in the crowd.

Sylvia, I think we need you to play the "honest broker" role in the next discussion of a WH Conference on Public Schools. I suggest we insist on attendance from Bruce or Elena, Gene, Ann, Leg.Affairs, Maria, Mike Cohen, and me to get the issues on the table. I sense from our last discussion of this issue at our message meeting yesterday, there is angst relative to the role of Mayors and the ownership DPC and NEC feel about the issue of education in general.

I think you are the best bet for bringing closure to a decision ---yes or no for a conference. And if yes, I'm very confident everyone's concerns can be addressed by a planning group led by DPC. I strongly believe the conference should occur, preferably in April after all the Washinton winter meetings of the intergovernmental groups are concluded and that the USCM should play a prominent role. However, I think it would be difficult for IGA to play the lead role. If you think differently, I'd like a chance to discuss this with you. Thanks for all your support.

Rahm, et. al.:

I've attached a DRAFT of some positive talking points for any Q's we may get tomorrow on the NBC or the LA Times stories on assaults. I understand from the LA Times reporter that Senator Feinstein is quoted as saying that our action is "worthless"...or something like that. I tried very hard to put our action into a broader context -- our long-term record on imports, China, curios and relics, etc. -- but don't know if I succeeded.

These talking points try and address Senator Feinstein's minimizing of our directive in the LA Times piece -- but they're stretching a bit. Also, I will visit w/Counsel and Treasury one more time about trying to cover the existing Uzi and other permits. I did speak to ATF Counsel tonight, and they insist we can't act on the current permits. While the Bush Administration did this in 1989, was sued...and won, all of our lawyers say that this was an entirely different situaion. More than a million assault rifles had been approved for import, and many were being recovered at crime scenes. With respect to the Uzis, not a one has even come in. In any event, we better do this soon. The increased media coverage is sure to result in new applications for imports.

Rahm, Elena, Bruce -- let me know if you think these talking points work.
