I don't presume to be a speechwriter or policy advisor - but I do have some strong instincts about what will work for the Governors Roundtable remarks. Thus, I would like to lay out a suggested construct for the Presidents remarks for you to adopt, consider, edit, or reject as you wish.

I. Opening

II. Six Years of a Successful partnership - Effective federalism.

1. As a former Governor, I understand the federal/state role.
2. Our record demonstrates this:

Unfunded Mandates Bill
 COPS program
 CHIP program
 Welfare reform

3. Last year we met in this room and you presented the following goals:

Transportation Finance - Govs Schafer and Patton made this case for you and working together we passed it - all 27 billion.

Internet taxation (Gov Leavitt and Romer made this case and we worked together to get this passed)

Workforce development Act - Gov Ridge (?) presented this and I signed it.

Regulatory Reform - Gov ? presented this and I signed Thompson-Levin

4. Through the year we worked on other issues successfully together:

FICA Ruling - Treasury has opined that states are not required to pay FICA for workfare - major cost savings to states.

Cost Allocation - Congress required us in the Ag Research Bill to allocate your costs, and after hearing clearly from you we accepted your state-by-state methodology for doing so.

EPA Air regs- We were required to issue new standards but - after hearing from you - the states were given significant tools of flexibility.

Each of these issues presented federalism issues and we respected the states role.

III. Our Budget is a Win for States

Prior to the release of our budget we met with you and you expressed two priorities, (1) don't cut existing commitments, and (2) invest in kids.

Our budget does that - and more - for the states

- a. fully funds SSBG
- b. no Medicaid cuts
- c. Head Start increase
- d. COPs increase
- e. Welfare increase - emphasis on fatherhood per your lead
- f. School Modernization initiative
- g. Class size initiative
- h. Livability initiative

These budget commitments reflect both the importance of the level of funding , but are consistent with our effective federalism - they give you the tools and flexibility to do your job (livability, welfare, SSBG).

IV. Looking Ahead: Preparation for the 21st Century Economy

As we look ahead, using this partnership - this effective federalism - that has worked to tackle welfare, children's health etc. how to we prepare our workforce for the 21st Century economy. Theme of partnership - accountability and flexibility . Two components: (1) Workforce training, and (2) Education Accountability

Workforce Training - describe our initiative

Education Accountability /Flexibility

On Tuesday, Secretary Riley will deliver his 6th annual State of American Education Address at 2pm EST from the campus of California State University at Long Beach. The Secretary will give his assessment of key issues confronting the nation's schools and

colleges

and outline ways that the federal government can help address these topics.

Riley will focus largely on the issue of teacher quality. Given the nation's need to hire more than 2.2 million teachers over the next

ten

years, it is imperative that we find new ways to recruit, train and prepare teachers for the new challenges they face in classrooms today (using technology, growing numbers of non-English speaking kids, record enrollment of kids). In addition to discussing the Clinton Admin. efforts to address this issue and spur education reform, specifically, Riley will announce:

- * a model for states to consider when looking at ways to change their existing teacher licensure system
- * a job bank and clearinghouse to provide prospective teachers

with

certification information and job openings nationwide

- * that ED will sponsor a study on teacher testing to get an accurate assessment of what states and doing in this area

- * that ED will host a Summit on Teacher Quality later this year bringing together college presidents and state teachers of the year

to

discuss how universities as a whole may work to improve their teacher training programs.

In addition to these items, Riley will call for passage of the Admin. education agenda including school construction, small classes and accountability measures, which will all help address teacher quality as well.

Dear Senator _____:

The undersigned organizations applaud the determination by the Department of Health and Human Services that current law permits the use of federal funds to support research utilizing human pluripotent stem cells.

Human pluripotent stem cells have the ability to reproduce themselves indefinitely and to give rise to other more specialized types of cells, such as muscle, skin, nerve, pancreas or blood cells. This ability to produce specialized cells opens a tremendous avenue of research with enormous potential for the treatment of many diseases. For example, human stem cells could be used to produce different kinds of specialized cells and tissues for use in transplantation to treat many diseases and conditions, including neurological disorders such as Parkinson*s and Alzheimer*s diseases, heart disease and stroke, diabetes, osteoarthritis, rheumatoid arthritis, and spinal cord injury. Stem cell research also offers great promise for use in drug development and testing, to evaluate and understand both the beneficial and toxic effects of drugs on different human cell types, thus potentially reducing the need for animal studies and enabling fewer and more sharply focused human clinical trials. Research on human stem cells will open exciting new pathways by which to strengthen our understanding of normal human cell and tissue development. This, in turn, will accelerate our insights into the mechanisms of abnormal growth and development, and could lead to the discovery of radically new approaches to the prevention and treatment of birth defects and cancer.

It is essential that the Federal government play a primary role in funding and overseeing the conduct of this research so that the talent and creativity of all our scientists -- both privately and federally funded -- can be applied to this important line of research. Federal involvement creates a more open research environment, promoting the free exchange of ideas and data among scientists, and ensuring greater public engagement and the protections of federal regulatory oversight. Federal support will also increase fiscal resources and expand the pool of well-trained investigators engaged in this area of research, both of which will speed the pace of scientific discovery.

We concur with the National Institutes of Health*s plans to move forward to develop clear guidelines to address the special scientific, legal, and ethical issues surrounding this research. We are confident that this process will have appropriate public input, as well as the advice of the National Bioethics Advisory Commission and NIH*s newly established Council of Public Representatives. NIH has made clear that it will not support any research using human pluripotent stem cells until the appropriate guide

lines

have been developed and disseminated and an oversight process is in place.

Given the tremendous promise this research holds for millions of Americans, indeed all humankind, we strongly urge you to work with the NIH to ensure that this research can move forward with the support and oversight of the Federal government.

U.S.-Mexico Cooperation in Law Enforcement

The United States and Mexico are committed to strengthening our counter-drug efforts and enhancing security along the 2,000 mile border we share by continuing to increase law enforcement cooperation. Today, President Clinton and President Zedillo of Mexico announced a new agreement to enhance consultation on cross-border law enforcement activities; an offer by the United States to provide training and technical assistance for Mexico's new Federal Preventive Police force; and a commitment to negotiate a bilateral agreement that will facilitate information-sharing related to control of chemicals used in the manufacture of illicit drugs.

Agreement on Consultation Procedures

Today in Merida, Attorney General Reno and Mexican Attorney General Madrazo signed an agreement that specifies procedures for consulting on major or otherwise sensitive cross-border law enforcement activities. This agreement follows from a July 2, 1998, joint letter that the two Attorneys General addressed to President Clinton and President Zedillo. That letter expressed a commitment to enhance U.S.-Mexican consultation and cooperation concerning cross-border law enforcement activities.

The new agreement establishes points of contact, timing, and form for notification of and consultation on covered law enforcement activities, and provides for the exchange of annual reports by the Attorneys General on compliance. The agreement applies to all federal law enforcement agencies of both countries.

Mexico's Federal Preventive Police

President Clinton today announced U.S. support for Mexico's newly-established Federal Preventive Police force, a consolidated national uniformed police force that brings together previously disparate forces. Attorney General Reno and Director of the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) Louis Freeh recently met with Mexican Minister of the Interior Francisco Labastida to discuss this new initiative. Most law enforcement functions in Mexico are exercised at the state and local levels, as in the United States. Unfortunately, many state and local police officers in Mexico lack formal education and training and are paid a very low salary. In creating the Federal Preventive Police, President Zedillo seeks to strengthen law enforcement throughout Mexico by developing an integrated force of carefully-selected, sufficiently-trained, and suitably-paid police officers. The FBI is prepared to provide training and technical assistance to help develop this new law enforcement capability in cooperation with the Government of Mexico.

Bilateral Chemical Control Agreement

President Clinton and President Zedillo agreed to negotiate a bilateral

chemical control agreement to facilitate information-sharing regarding suspected illicit diversions of precursor and essential chemicals. Strengthening cooperation in this area of law enforcement is critical to implementation of the U.S.-Mexico Bi-National Drug Strategy. The intended agreement will specify the mechanisms for this important information exchange.

U.S.-Mexico Counter-Drug Cooperation:
Bi-National Performance Measures of Effectiveness

President Clinton and President Zedillo of Mexico today announced agreement on Bi-National Performance Measures of Effectiveness (PMEs), an important advance in the two leaders' continued effort to combat the threat of illegal drugs. The PMEs provide objective markers that the United States and Mexico can use to measure the success of our cooperative efforts to reduce the supply and demand of illegal drugs. They also serve to identify those areas in which both nations can intensify their counter-drug efforts. By imposing measures for determining progress, the PMEs ensure a greater degree of accountability and scrutiny.

On May 6, 1997, the United States and Mexico formed an Alliance Against Drugs, which laid the foundation for the U.S.-Mexico Bi-National Drug Strategy, issued in February of last year. This strategy complements the national drug control efforts of both the United States and Mexico, and promotes the three principal counter-drug objectives we share:

Reduce the illicit consumption, production and traffic of narcotics and psychotropic substance in both countries;

Combat drug-related crimes, such as money laundering, arms trafficking, and the diversion of precursor and essential chemicals; and

Treat the health and safety problems generated by drugs that both our countries face.

The PMEs are critical to the implementation of this strategy, enabling both governments to track progress towards achieving each of the sixteen major goals identified in the Alliance declaration, and the 147 action items specified in the Strategy. The PMEs address the following areas of drug control:

- Demand Reduction
- Production and Distribution of Drugs
- Criminal Organizations
- Law Enforcement Cooperation
- Extradition
- Firearms Trafficking

Corruption
Border Cooperation and Security
Chemical Control
Money Laundering
Asset Forfeiture
Interdiction
Training and Technical Assistance
Exchange of Information and Evidence

The PMEs not only enable both partners to gauge progress in these areas, but also orient future counter-drug efforts. The Bi-National Drug Strategy calls for responses to the results our on-going cooperation, as measured by the PMEs, by prescribing modifications to both nations' counter-drug efforts.

U.S.-Mexico Cooperation Against Border Violence

Today Attorney General Reno and Foreign Secretary Rosario Green of Mexico signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) on Cooperation Against Border Violence. The MOU is the latest step forward in the continuing joint effort by the United States and Mexico to build cooperation and understanding along the 2,000 mile border we share. It formalizes and enhances existing modes of communication between law enforcement officials on both sides of the border in order to help prevent incidences of violence along the border.

The United States and Mexico share a deep concern about life-threatening border incidents. To help prevent such incidents, both governments pledge in the MOU to take the following steps:

Develop procedures among law enforcement agencies on both sides of the border for responding to calls for assistance when conflicts, assaults, violence, and other threats to public safety occur along the border.

Develop training programs for local and national law enforcement in non-lethal response, proper procedures for patrol and arrest, and heightened community sensitivity.

Formalize communication between U.S. Attorneys and Mexican Consuls along the border.

Establish a working group to monitor and report on the success of these and other bilateral efforts.

In 1997, President Clinton and President Zedillo signed the Joint Statement on Migration affirming their commitment to enhancing bilateral cooperation in the management of migration between the two countries. Since that time, the Immigration and Naturalization Service (INS) and Mexican officials have taken concrete steps to further the goals of the Statement.

Last June, with the assistance of the Mexican government, INS launched its Border Safety Initiative, an unprecedented effort to reduce injuries, prevent fatalities, and educate migrants about the very real and ever present dangers associated with illegal crossing.

In January, officials from the Department of Justice, Department of State, and INS met with their Mexican counterparts in San Diego to discuss progress in implementing the border safety program. In addition, the participants agreed to explore border-wide arrangements between United States Attorneys and Mexican Consuls to investigate incidents involving U.S. law enforcement and Mexican nationals. The MOU on Cooperation Against Border Violence comes as a result of this meeting.

Josh, Rich, Lisa K, and I met with Waxman's staff this afternoon and they have a new twist on recoupment. They want to produce that spends about half the money on tobacco control and the other half either on debt relief or on a menu of health and other programs. They believe they can get bipartisan support and can rally the groups around this effort.

Instead of letting the states keep the funds so long as they spend it for certain specified purposes, they propose that, at least for funds to be used for tobacco control, the funds be spent at the federal level. Specifically, they would propose to fund the \$2.6 billion a year in tobacco-related spending in the Hansen-Meehan bill which included:

- (1) \$500 million on a national education campaign (including counteradvertising)
- (2) \$300 million on FDA
- (3) \$600 million on grants to communities and schools
- (4) \$1 billion on research
- (5) \$200 million on cessation

They argued strenuously that spending at the federal level is the best way to ensure these funds are spent effectively and why -- if nothing else for positioning reasons -- wouldn't they want to start there?

They are less sure what they want to do with the other half of the funds. Phil Schiliro, Waxman's chief of staff, argued that putting the rest towards debt service would be the cleanest message that would attract the most Republicans. Phil Barnett, Waxman's committee counsel, argued that a less specified menu had advantages.

We should discuss.
