Bruce, thanks again for participating in the tobacco forum in Tampa on Florida. It looks like we got good press and everyone was happy with how it turned out. Please let me know if you have any suggestions or changes for the next forum.

We're looking forward to scheduling the other two forums. Very tentatively we're looking at Seattle (Nov. 6-7) and Chicago (Dec. 17). The goal is to make these actually regional and bipartisan. I am writing to thank you for your tireless efforts to promote the public health. I admire your efforts on issues ranging from cancer research funding to reducing teen smoking to encouraging Americans to eat healthier diets. I regret that I cannot be with all of you in Los Angeles for your annual meeting and wish you the best of luck.

As you know, the President and I are committed to drastically reducing the number of young people who get addicted to the deadly habit of cigarette smoking. We feel that the agreement reached with the Attorneys General and the tobacco industry last June represents an unprecedented opportunity to truly change the face of this epidemic. As you would agree, the President and I will not support any legislation that does not include: a comprehensive plan to reduce youth smoking, including tough financial penalties on tobacco companies if reductions in youth smoking are not met; full authority to regulate cigarettes by the FDA; changes in the way the tobacco industry does business, including ending the marketing and promoting of tobacco products to kids and requiring the disclosure of certain industry documents; investing in other public health goals and protecting farmers and their communities. No legislation is better than any legislation that allows the tobacco industry to continue to hook thousands of kids to their deadly products every year.

As you may know, the President asked me to travel around the country to get ideas and build support for this effort. I have met with young people and their parents, public health experts, doctors, nurses, police officers and teachers in Florida, in Iowa and in Washington, D.C. From these meetings I have gained new insights and have a newfound respect for the efforts to reduce youth smoking that are happening at the local levels. I look forward to continuing these meetings in other parts of the country and bringing what I learn back to Washington, D.C. so that I can push for legislation that will truly make a positive difference for millions all Americans. I support a very open and honest discussion on this important issue and look forward to working with Congress this winter.

I very much appreciate all the work that you all have done and look forward to working with you in the future. Best of luck with your conference.

The proposal to emerge from Erskine's meeting was as follows:

1. We would try to put YOU out next week to fire a shot across the bow of the GOP to say that any tobacco bill must be comprehensive, i.e., include a price hike. We are working to see if OMB/Treas can generate numbers as to a projected reduction in teen smoking under our plan, so we

would have news to announce when you go out.

2. We expect Conrad's bill the following week. When it comes, POTUS will make a statement praising it, saying it is a good bill that is consistent with his principles. He will also say that he hopes this issue can be bipartisan, and not just partisan -- and he hopes others will come forth with bills that are also consistent with his principles (so as to not scare off the moderate Repubs who want to help, and so as to not alienate other Dems like Waxman, Harkin, etc., who are also drafting bills).

3. Erskine will begin quiet conversations with moderate Repubs to try to see if they will come onto Conrad or something very close to Conrad.

I think that this is a good approach.
