>Please, please tell me why the Boston Globe continues to perpetuate the

>impression that Boston Public Schools has historically been captive of the

>"social promotion phenomenon" (Thomas Payzant, "Boston Is Taking Strong

>Steps Toward Better Schools," 9/8/98). This is simply untrue.

>

>In 1988, over one out of every nine Boston students (11%) was retained in
>grade. In addition, over one quarter of all ninth graders were not
>promoted, with rates even higher for African American and Latino students.
>Those retained included 1000 first graders. By the time students entered
>sixth grade, approximately 40% were one year behind their appropriate
grade.

>

>Once in middle school, students faced more non-promotions: 9.7% in Grade
6,
>14.0% in Grade 7, and 10.9% in Grade 8 were not promoted. Many students
>retained in the middle grades repeated their grade at a lower "ability
>level." This pattern mirrors research that finds that students retained
in
>grade are more likely to end up in special education placements. Yet
>being categorized as special education students does not protect them from
>further grade retention. Just 10 years ago, in 1988, 17% of Boston's
>mainstreamed special education students were retained in grade.

>

>As Boston's own data revealed that grade retention was not producing
>achievement gains, Boston school gradually reduced retention rates. Did
>test scores drop dramatically? No. Test scores stayed about the same.
>But gradually, the dropout rate has declined. In other words, grade
>retention undermined students' persistence in school, but made no
>difference to achievement. Do we want to return to the days of low
>achievement AND high dropout rates? We can do better, and it does not
>require filling up the elementary and middle grades with overage students.

Spoke to Damon Silvers of AFL-CIO Legal Dept. They aren't running these cases, but do try to follow them. There's something called the Coalition for Workers Health Funds (headed by Brian McQuade) that serves as a coordinating group; the Connerton and Ray law firm is heavily involved.

Cases have been filed in 38 states, involving several hundred union funds. If a class were certified in some cases, it could include as many as 2,500 plans and 30 million participants. Some cases have been dismissed in whole or in part. Other cases (Okla., Wash., Ore. W. Va.) are set for trial.

AFL has no position on the cases; BCTD may have endorsed. Most Taft-Hartley funds--other than those involving workers in the tobacco

industry--have joined in the litigation.

I realized last night that I forgot to give you the ESEA item you requested yesterday. Here it is. Please respond to let me know if you receive this or have any difficulty with it, since its the first e-mail I've sent from home.

ESEA Reauthorization. DPC staff met with Education Department staff to review the Department's progress in developing an ESEA reauthorization proposal. Education's approach overall is to maintain the fundamental focus throughout ESEA programs on helping students reach high standards and, for the most part, to maintain the current programs (though they and we are unsure how best to deal with Goals 2000). Some small programs are likely to be consolidated, and Education is developing proposals to expand the role of Title 1 in providing preschool programs, and to create a new emphasis on improving high school education in ESEA. DPC is working with Education to ensure that the reauthorization proposal provides stronger accountability for results and more effective interventions for low performance than current law, more vigorously promotes public school choice, and more effectively

ensures that program funds are used to support educational practices that work. We are also working to ensure that positions you have previously taken on strengthening bilingual education and the Safe and Drug Free Schools Program are fully incorporated into the reauthorization proposal. Together with the Education Department we are developing a strategy to place a greater and more effective emphasis on improving the quality of teaching, especially in high poverty schools, though we are not yet clear on how best to achieve this. DPC, OMB and Education believe it is important to transmit a proposal to Congress shortly after the next session begins. To accomplish this, Education will have to significantly speed up its work. To help move this along, we will provide ED with detailed proposals on key issues, review Education's progress again the week after Thanksgiving, and establish a process for completing major policy decisions by the end of this year.

Bradley warming up for big game

CONCORD, N.H. (AP) Democrat Bill Bradley offered a glimpse of
his battle plan against Vice President Al Gore by charging today
that the 1996 welfare reform signed by President Clinton ``cut the
bond between the mother and the child.''

``I think we clearly have a difference on welfare,' ' Bradley
said when pressed during a morning radio interview to distinguish
himself from Gore, the presumed front-runner for the Democratic
presidential nomination in 2000.

The law that Clinton signed in 1996 over objections from
liberals transformed welfare from a federal entitlement to a block
grant that enabled states to craft their own plans to help the
needy.

``I thought there was a federal obligation to individual

children who are poor," Bradley said, "not simply an obligation to take a pot of money and send it from one group of politicians to another group of politicians in a state."

Gore is not responding to Bradley's remarks, but spokesman Chris Lehane said: "Yesterday, President Clinton announced that America's welfare rolls were at their lowest in 30 years. Under the leadership of the Clinton-Gore administration, millions of Americans, including many in New Hampshire, have moved from welfare to work. Vice President Gore believes that this is the best help we can give to children, mothers and families."

Making his first campaign swing through New Hampshire, site of the nation's first presidential primary, the former New Jersey senator and Hall of Fame basketball player is trying to answer the most critical question of his Democratic presidential campaign: Why should primary voters side with him, not the vice president?

"Because they think I would be a better president and would have a better chance of winning," Bradley said at a Monday news conference in Manchester, N.H., to open the three-day trip.

But Gore has the power of the White House behind him; he jets across the country aboard Air Force Two and enjoys the support of a popular president. In New Hampshire, he stuffed mail boxes full of Christmas cards and White House invitations, and raised thousands of dollars for Democrats who now owe him big.

So why does Bradley think he would have a better chance than Gore of winning the presidency?

"I think in part because I'd be better able to attract independents and Republicans in a general election," he said. Bradley says he proved during 18 years in the Senate that he can draw votes from both parties.

Gore might argue that he also can court GOP and independent

voters, having served a president who forged the party's centrist ``third way.''

No matter; Bradley has other rationale for his candidacy.

``I have not been a part of the partisanship that has shaped the debate the last couple of years,' ' Bradley said. Without saying so, Bradley was clearly trying to cast himself as the anti-Washington Democrat in a race against the son of a Tennessee senator who has never wandered too long from Washington.

He and Gore have ``different personal histories,' ' the former senator said.

Bradley was raised in a small Missouri town, earned a Rhodes Scholarship, played in the National Basketball Association for 10 years, served a diverse state in the Senate and left to lecture and teach.

``I've been on the road 30 years in America as senator, a basketball player and writer, a lecturer and a businessman. I had a life before I got into politics and a life after I left the Senate,' ' he said.

It all seemed designed to make Gore pale in comparison, but Bradley denied any such motive.

``I'm not really running against Al Gore, I'm running because of what I want to do ... for the country,' ' he said.

Bradley says he wants to restore integrity to public office, ``bring out the best in people,' ' help troubled children and ease economic woes of working families in what he calls this ``age of insecurity.''

He has to win first. And most Democratic operatives say his is a long-shot bid.

``This is something Bradley should have done six years ago,' ' said consultant Harold Hodes of New Jersey, a longtime Bradley

backer now in Gore's camp.

Still, the vice president has not locked anything up. Bradley senses an undercurrent of insecurity among voters and a general disgust with anything or anybody related to Washington.

``A lot of people see (Bradley) as a good way to change, to clean the slate,'' said Jim Gilmour, a Democratic voter interviewed over a bagel in nearby Keene, N.H.

Another Democratic voter, Frank Shlauer of Keene, said Bradley's chances ``will depend on how much heat Gore takes.''

Bradley plans to turn up the heat, especially if no other Democrat enters the race.

During a brief shoot-around with New Hampshire youths Monday, the old pro bent his knees and flicked his Hall of Fame wrist to send a basketball arcing toward the hoop. He missed his first few shots, watching the ball spin off the rim, before finding his range.

The ball ripped through the net with a whisper.

Swish!

Swish! Swish!

``It takes a while to warm up,'' Bradley said afterward, a warning to competitors in basketball and politics alike.
