This is my draft for the weekly (part of HEA). Should I add DPC, and/or do you have any other suggestions?

Old Professors: The House bill includes a provision that would allow colleges to offer financial incentives for tenured professors to retire early, to make room for younger (and generally lower-paid) professors. The EEOC -- and the AARP -- have opposed this provision as permitting age-based, arbitrary distinctions in employee benefit plans which would disadvantage older workers because it would allow the colleges to deny the incentive to older professors. The colleges argue that the tenure system is unique, and that this will allow them to diversify the faculty. My staff is working with Education and the EEOC to determine whether there is any reason to reconsider the Administration's position on this issue.

Draft Proposal -- Improving The Event Briefing Process:

In response to Staff Secretary's Office, and because the system has broken down, Christa and I have developed a recommendation on how to improve the event

briefing process. The key is strict deadlines on all of our parts. In the

past, we have not made it clear to DPC staff when briefing materials are due.

Now we will have a set of deadlines that everyone will held to. We propose the

following:

1. The day before the event, DPC policy staff will provide Christa with the

press paper for the event at 1:00 pm. In cases where policy issues are still

unresolved, a draft will be handed to Christa at 1:00 instead. However, final

paper will be sent to Christa in at 3:00, which she will cross check with the earlier draft paper.

2. Christa will transform the press paper into a briefing memo and give it to Laura by 3:30 pm for your review.

3. Laura will schedule a ten to fifteen minute slot between 3:30 pm to 5:30 pm for you to review the briefing paper. Because you are at so many meetings around the complex, Laura will bring the briefing paper to where ever you are in the WH complex so you can review it during that period. Laura will give Christa your edits by 5:30 pm and Christa will make the changes and hand the memo into Staff Secretary by 6:00 pm.

This is obviously a very tight schedule. In order for it to work, policy issues will need to be resolved earlier rather than later. Obviously, in some cases, POTUS or the Chief of Staff may be holding up a policy decision. In those instances we must advise Staff Secretary's office why the issue is held up. In those cases, Christa or I will tell the Staff Secretary or Press Office if the paper will be delayed. However, for this system to function effectively, delays must be the exception, not the rule.

The other issue relates to when you are not on the WH compound from 3:30 to

5:30. In those cases, I would recommend Bruce look at the documents. If Bruce is also not available, I would be happy to serve as the fail safe. However, I will only do so if you both are comfortable with that.

Please let us know what you think of this proposal.
