White House Reviews Labor Law To Determine Welfare Recipients' Coverage
The Clinton administration contends that welfare recipients who must participate in local workfare programs to receive benefits should be covered by the Fair Labor Standards Act, the federal law that sets out minimum wage and overtime requirements, presidential advisor Gene Sperling said March 17.

Sperling, a special assistant to the president for economic policy and chair of the National Economic Council, told a group of workfare participants and grass roots activists that the White House is continuing

to review federal labor law to determine whether welfare recipients who must work for their benefits are covered by the law and whether they are permitted to organize.

'We are trying to find out right now what the best legal course to take is,' Sperling said during a noon event sponsored by the Association of Community Organizations for Reform Now. ACORN invited Sperling to discuss the president's welfare reform initiative, while it pressed its case that workfare recipients should have the right to organize for the purpose of collective bargaining.

Haven't Heard from the Lawyers

'Our orientation and our hope is that the [FLSA] law applies as broadly as possible so that anybody working [in workfare programs] does get the minimum wage and . . . and has the right to organize,' he said.

'We are trying to find out how the law works best,' according to Sperling. But he admitted that the White House still has not heard back from all its lawyers on this matter. 'Sorry to say, I just do not know the answer,' he said, again stressing that the administration's 'overall orientation' is that workfare participants are covered by federal wage and hour provisions.

Sperling reiterated that the president is committed to pushing through his proposal to improve the new welfare law. As laid out in the president's fiscal 1998 budget request, the president wants Congress to approve a \$3 billion job placement and job creation program over three years, allotting \$750 million for fiscal 1998. Sperling, however, was booed when he said that program would allow mayors to decide how to spend the money.

Organizing Under Way in Cities

Workfare participants from the New York's Work Experience Program were among those participating in the event. Some participants of the WEP program, for example, must pick up litter in New York City parks as part of the WEP's requirement to receive welfare benefits.

ACORN said it is working with WEP workers who want to organize 'to win better working conditions, training, and permanent jobs.' Since December 1996, more than 6,000 workfare participants in New York and Los Angeles have signed ACORN cards, the organization said.

Also attending the event were participants from Los Angeles, Philadelphia, Houston, Chicago, Boston, and several other cities, according to ACORN, which describes itself as a grassroots community organization that represents about 100,000 low- and moderate-income families in 30 cities.

'We're here in Washington to make it clear that 'fixing' welfare reform must include creating real jobs at living wages as well as protections for workfare workers' rights as workers to organize,' according to ACORN National President Maude Hurd. The Rev. Jesse Jackson also was on hand to lend his support for workfare participants' right to organize.

Following the noon discussion, held at a Capitol Hill church, the group marched to the Capitol building and to the Department of Health and Human Services to raise public of their public awareness of their position.



Michelle Jolin of CEA just told me about two upcoming CEA reports which may be useful for March-April events. She is interested in any guidance on how and when to release them (and is also discussing this with Bruce).

1. Welfare Reform. By the week of 3/31, CEA will be ready with a report on the factors that have reduced the nation's welfare caseloads so dramatically in the past four years. They will conclude that about 50% was due to the strong economy, and 50% due to other factors, including our state waivers (which may account for roughly one-third of the reduction). Apparently, the President has already been told about this report and is very interested in it. It could serve as a "What Works" guide for states (or literally be turned into such a guide). Since it will almost definitely show that our approach is the right one, we may want to consider having the POTUS highlight it through a Radio Address or other event.

2. Investments in Children Aged 0-3. By the week of April 14th (right before the Early Childhood Conference), CEA will be ready with a report on investments in children aged 0-3, including health and mental health programs/investments. It will essentially be a cost-benefit analysis pointing out the importance and cost-effectiveness of investing in young children. While it will not contain hard news, we could release or mention it as part of another event to lead-in to the Conference.

SPRINGFIELD, Ill., March 18 (UPI) -- The Illinois Senate supported a measure requiring municipalities that try to extend government employee health benefits to the domestic partners of homosexual city employees to provide them to the unmarried partners of heterosexual employees as well.

By a 40-10 vote, the Senate Tuesday gave final approval to a measure by state Sen. Walter Dudycz, R-Chicago, requiring all unmarried partners to get full benefits.

Dudycz' measure was inspired because Chicago city government is considering a measure extending the benefits to the gay partners of city employees. Chicago Mayor Richard Daley backs the measure.

But Dudycz does not. On Tuesday, he told his Senate colleagues he thinks it is illegal to provide medical benefits to only some unmarried partners of city employees.

Privately, Dudycz admits his measure is a reaction to Chicago city government, claiming he thinks their action -- which has yet to be voted on by the full City Council -- "undermines the sanctity of marriage."

Daley has said he opposes the state's action, saying that it would cost the city too much money to provide full benefits to all unmarried

partners, although city officials cannot offer a specific dollar amount.

The measure, which now goes to the Illinois House where it faces an uncertain future, also is opposed by the American Civil Liberties Union.



QUESTION AND ANSWER ON WELFARE REFORM AND THE MINIMUM WAGE

Question: Is the Administration going to make clear that the Fair Labor Standards Act requires that at least the minimum wage be paid to welfare recipients participating in work activities?

Answer: This Administration is committed to moving people from welfare to work. It's also committed to making sure workers get at least the minimum wage for their efforts: we don't believe anyone doing real work ought to be paid a subminimum wage. But the Administration is still studying precisely how the FLSA and other worker protection laws play out in the welfare context. We expect to have a final answer on the minimum wage question within the next few weeks.

QUESTION AND ANSWER ON WELFARE REFORM AND PRIVATIZATION

Question: Is the Administration going to allow states to privatize welfare operations now performed by state employees?

Answer: As you know, the Administration is reviewing requests by certain states to privatize some or all of their welfare operations. The legal and factual questions involved in this decision are very complicated, and I understand that the agencies involved are not yet ready to make any decision.



We are concerned that the two pending proposals for a race commission or council have serious flaws. This memo presents a third alternative.

The proposal to establish a full-fledged Presidential commission on race has four weaknesses.

Of course, the President could reject all or part of the commission's eventual recommendations, but we should not place the President in the position of having to do so.

- Third, it subjects the President to criticism that he is not doing anything. Many people think we have studied questions involving race long enough and that it is past time to put that study to practical use.
- Fourth, and perhaps most important, it fails to take advantage of the President's unique talents. Any President could appoint a commission and respond to its proposals. This President has the unprecedented ability to do more -- to talk about race in a way that the American people respond to and to construct his own agenda for racial reconciliation.

The proposal to establish an action-oriented Council, along the lines of the Council on Physical Fitness, also raises significant concerns, at least as described so far.

- First, it is subject to characterization as a "do-good," "touchy-feely," essentially unrigorous and unserious response to the most intractable of America's social problems.

- Second and relatedly, it would not in fact deal with the broadscale policy issues of welfare, criminal justice, education, and so forth that are central to achieving progress in this area.
- Third, it too would be removed from the President (though potentially somewhat less so than the commission) and so would fail to take advantage of his ability to spur reconciliation and progress.

A third alternative makes the President central to a second-term effort on racial issues, at the same time as it combines intellectual rigor with an action orientation. It would include the following components:

- A major multi-day conference on racial issues to take place at the White House, perhaps in early summer. Participants in this conference would include all the people who would be candidates for the commission: political figures (e.g., Jesse Jackson, Pat Moynihan); business, civil rights, and religious leaders; scholars and public intellectuals (e.g., William Julius Wilson, Skip Gates, Randy Kennedy). It also could include events or discussions involving the participation of "non-elites," in order to widen the range of views considered and command the attention of the broadest possible audience.
- A series of "town halls" led by the President on race-related issues. These events would occur in different areas of the country among different kinds of communities. They would focus on particular subjects, such as race and criminal justice. They would involve both "ordinary Americans" and experts in the field, who would contribute empirical evidence and rigorous analysis.
- Policy announcements to precede, accompany, and follow the conference and town halls. We would put into place a broad policy development process, led by the White House, involving all the agencies, and reaching out to public policy experts outside the government. This process (with the events described above serving as action-forcing mechanisms) would produce a wide range of actions and proposals -- both large and small, executive and legislative.

It should be noted that this proposal easily can accommodate some attention to issues of intolerance generally, involving not only racial minorities, but also women, religious minorities, and gays and lesbians. Although we would not like to see the conference, town halls, and policy process focus exclusively (or even mainly) on this area, nothing would be easier than to have, for example, one panel of the conference or a single town hall address these issues.


