FYI: This executive order needs a fair bit of work. The biggest problem is that there isn't right now a legally sufficient basis for the order stated in the introductory section. That section talks a lot about how the order promotes health and safety and improves the environment, all of which is very nice but legally irrelevant (or at least incomplete). There's very little discussion of what there should be discussion of: how the order relates (whether through health and safety effects or otherwise) to the procurement process and the efficiency of governmental contracting. In addition, the enforcement mechanisms in the order raise some questions. But not to worry: we're on the case.

3. The campaign finance meeting Hilley wanted (with the reform groups and President) won't happen this week. There's going to be a formal, Presidential-level announcement of the DNC leaders this week. Rahm wants to release info on DNC reforms at the same time. Some people doubted whether the reform plan would be ready in time. Leon pressed for an expedition.

4. Gene's education event is set to roll for Thursday. (Why exactly is this GENE's education event?)

5. Rahm asked that we (I say "we," but it was unclear to whom he was talking) figure out whether or how to plug into state efforts to pass HMO Patients' Bills of Rights. (See the Washington Post this morning.)

6. All agreed that Mike should comment as little as possible on the Pear story and the details of the Administration's Medicaid proposals. To the extent he needs to say something, he should state the two overarching principles: (1) retaining the individual guarantee and (2) placing constraints on overall spending.

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
