



DRAFT PRESS RELEASE

The President today announced his intention to nominate M. Larry Lawrence, of California, as Ambassador to Switzerland.

Chairman of the landmark Hotel del Coronado, in Coronado, California, Mr. Lawrence is also Chief Executive Officer of numerous other companies in varying fields, including hotels, commercial and residential real estate, corporate investments, finance, development and manufacturing.

He has served on the Federal Home Loan Bank Board of San Francisco, and as Chairman of the Finance Committee of the Economic Commission of the State of California. Most recently, he has been organizing Chairman of the Economic Advisory Board of San Diego County, California.

Mr. Lawrence was born August 16, 1926 in Chicago, Illinois, where he attended public schools until he served in the US Merchant Marine during WWII. He was presented a medal from the Russian government in recognition of his service on the Murmansk Run where his ship was sunk in 1945.

Mr. Lawrence later attended the University of Arizona in Tuscon. He played college football, and had a short stint in professional football, following which he went full-time into the building business, primarily building homes for the low and moderate income market.

Mr. Lawrence is married to Shelia Davis Lawrence and he has three grown children and six grand-children.
