

Social Security Programs Throughout the World, 1999

This 400-page report summarizes the principal features of the social security systems of 172 countries and territories. The five main branches of social insurance described are: Old-age, disability and death; sickness and maternity; work injury; unemployment, and family allowances.



Social Security Programs Throughout the World is published every other year; this edition was released in September 1999.

Social Security Programs in the United States, 1997

This monograph presents a comprehensive picture of the vast network of programs under the Social Security Act and how they operate. This edition also takes a brief look at their history and current legislative provisions. The programs are grouped into four major areas: Social insurance, health insurance and health services, assistance programs, and programs for specified groups (such as veterans, government employees, and railroad workers).
