Extent

Access

Collection is open to all researchers. Access to Clinton Presidential Records is governed by the Presidential Records Act (PRA) (44 USC 2201) and the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) (5 USC 552, as amended) and therefore may be restricted in whole or in part in accordance with legal exemptions.

Copyright

Documents in this collection that were prepared by officials of the United States government as part of their official duties are in the public domain. Researchers are advised to consult the copyright law of the United States (17 USC 101), which governs the making of photocopies or other reproductions of copyrighted material.

Provenance

Official records of William Jefferson Clinton's presidency are housed at the Clinton Presidential Library and administered by the National Archives and Records Administration (NARA) under the provisions of the Presidential Records Act (PRA).

Scope and Content

The materials in FOIA 2006-1185-F are a selective, not necessarily all inclusive, body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related materials.

FOIA 2006-1185-F consists of records concerning two telephone calls between President Clinton and Russian President Boris Yeltsin. These calls took place on June 13 and 14, 1999. It should be noted that many of the documents regarding conversations between Presidents Clinton and Yeltsin on these dates have been withdrawn due to national security restrictions.

Documents responsive to this FOIA were entirely found within the NSC Cables, Emails, and Records Management Systems (RMS). The NSC Emails contain discussions referencing planning for the telephone calls. These discussions include scheduling documents, press guidance, and comments regarding the transmission of documents related to the telephone conversations, such as talking points and telcons. The NSC Records Management System includes documents related to preparation for the telephone calls and to the telcons of the conversations.
