Jack, We have previously furnished regional offices a copy of the script we used as a basis for the training on tobacco claims we gave in Baltimore. When the transcript was released, we promised to provide transcripts for yours and Dr. Mather's presentations. I have attached a copy of the one we prepared for your presentation. It was taken off of a tape recording off of the video recording. The tape was, in places, very difficult if not impossible to discern what you or the questioner said. We have done the best we could to transcribe as much as possible.

As I see it, there are several options you could decide to take:

1. Just provide the script of your presentation and stop without the addition of any questions and answers
2. Script and some of the questions and answers
3. Script and all of the questions and answers

It is your call. But, I think that all of the transcript is a bit much. And some of it is probably duplicative of what was previously or subsequently covered by us in our training. Also, in our portion of the transcript, we made no attempt to put in any of the question/answers.

For your information, the original transcript was sent to all ROs and the major National Service Organizations. And, Keith Snyder just got a copy under FOIA.
