**PHOTOGRAPHERS** will be escorted from the Press Briefing Room to the Blue Room for a photo opportunity with Mrs. Clinton. This photo opportunity is for still photographers only.

**TV CREWS** will be escorted from the Press Briefing Room to the White House Ground Foyer. TV crews will join their correspondents as they arrive on the State Floor and then move to the Blue Room to join Mrs. Clinton.

After departing the Blue Room reporters will be invited to continue their tour of the State Floor.

**FIRST LADY HILLARY RODHAM CLINTON TO RECEIVE WHITE HOUSE

WASHINGTON, DC -- First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton will be presented with the official White House Christmas Tree on Wednesday, November 27, 1995.

This year's tree is from Coshocton, Ohio. The Colorado Blue Spruce is 18 1/2 feet tall and was grown at the Scheetz Tree Farm. The tree will be placed in the Blue Room of the White House and will be on display throughout the holiday season. The Scheetz Tree Farm was named the 1996 Grand Champion Growers by the National Christmas Tree Association.

The tree will be brought up the White House's driveway to the South Portico by a horse draw carriage.

**FIRST LADY HILLARY RODHAM CLINTON TO ATTEND  
6TH CONFERENCE OF WIVES OF HEADS OF STATE  
AND GOVERNMENTS OF THE AMERICAS**

WASHINGTON, DC -- First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton will travel to La Paz, Bolivia to participate in the 6th Conference of Wives of Heads of State and Governments of the Americas. The conference "The Rights of Women and Children Within the Framework of Sustainable Human Development," will review effective projects and strategies effecting the health and education of women and families.

Mrs. Clinton's participation in the Bolivia conference will include a keynote address during the conference's opening session on December 3rd and joining the working sessions on December 4th. Mrs. Clinton is also expected to participate in a signing ceremony of a USAID grant to the Pan American Health Organization to pursue maternal mortality reduction in the Western Hemisphere. In conjunction with the conference Mrs. Clinton is expected to visit several US-AID supported projects in the community.

In 1994 Mrs. Clinton hosted a Symposium on Children during the Summit of Americas in Miami for the spouses of the presidents and heads of state from the Western Hemisphere and in 1995 the First Lady attended the 5th conference of Wives of Heads of State and Government in Asuncion, Paraguay.

Mrs. Clinton will depart for Bolivia on Monday, December 2 and return to Washington on December 4th. WASHINGTON, DC -- First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton will join Housing Secretary Henry Cisneros and Assistant Housing Secretary Andrew Cuomo in launching the Housing Department's new Community Empowerment Banking Initiative in Washington, DC on Thursday, December 19, 1996. Mrs. Clinton is expected to make remarks and participate in a discussion with Secretary Cisneros, Assistant Secretary Cuomo and individuals from three communities -- Washington, DC, Baltimore and rural Mississippi -- that will receive the initial HUD start-up investment. This initiative will help revitalize poor communities by creating new community empowerment banks which will be the first in the nation to raise money by selling inexpensive shares to local residents and business people. The banks are modeled after successful microcredit programs around the world. Mrs. Clinton is a long-time advocate of micro-credit programs.
