**SCHEDULE OF FIRST LADY HILLARY RODHAM CLINTON FOR
SEPT. 1-4, 2000**

WASHINGTON, D.C. – First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton will travel with the President to Skaneateles, New York, from Friday, Sept. 1 to Sunday, Sept. 3, and to Chappaqua, New York, from Sunday, Sept. 3, to Monday, Sept. 4. The First Lady's official event schedule follows. Please note that additions or changes to the First Lady's public schedule will be released as information becomes available.

FRIDAY, SEPT. 1

4:45 p.m. SYRACUSE AIRPORT ARRIVAL

The President and First Lady arrive Syracuse Hancock International Airport via Air Force One, make remarks to the Syracuse area community, and depart via motorcade.

Members of the public wishing to attend the open arrival should note the following information. Doors for the public open at 2:30 p.m. and due to space limitations, access is available only on a first-come, first-serve basis. For safety reasons, signs and other similar items will not be allowed. Parking for the general public is available in the main airport parking lot. The public entrance will be through Gate 57 on the north side of the Airport.

This event is OPEN PRESS. Media wishing to cover the arrival need not request credentials but must show valid state or federal photo identification and press identification at the designated entrances.

VILLAGE POWER 2000 PROJECT AWARDS

WASHINGTON, D.C.— On Tuesday, August 8, 2000, the White House Millennium Council and U.S. Secretary of Energy Bill Richardson will host an event to honor a group of U.S. students for their efforts to bridge the technology divide in Uganda and Tanzania. The students recently traveled to rural areas of Uganda and Tanzania, installing solar panels in unelectrified schools. Richardson will present awards to the students and their sponsors.

The students are part of the Department of Energy's Village Power 2000 Millennium Project, working to bring clean and affordable energy to the hundreds of millions of rural people throughout the world, especially women and children, with no access to electric power. Private sponsors include: The Discovery Channel Global Education Fund, The Hathaway Foundation, BP Solarex, Solar Energy for Africa, SolarQuest, and United Solar Corporation.
