ARRIVAL STATEMENT
DUBLIN, IRELAND
OCTOBER 30, 1997**

The reception we received -- the warmth of the Irish people, the sea of Irish and American flags at College Green -- these will forever be etched in our memories.

Although my visit is brief, I look forward to renewing acquaintances and making new friends in Dublin before leaving for Belfast tomorrow.

Our two countries have important work to accomplish together. We must travel a common road towards peace, prosperity and justice, both here in Ireland and elsewhere.

President Clinton remains personally committed to partnership with Ireland and to the Northern Ireland peace process.
