Dear Mr. President:

We are the students, staff and parents of Cedar Hill Elementary School in Lawrenceville, Georgia. It is with great pride that we introduce ourselves to you this February in honor of President's Day. Our students are well aware of the work that you do in Washington to lead our nation into the next millennium. We wish to take this opportunity to let you know about Cedar Hill and how we are preparing to lead the nation. With our exceptional staff, an active and supportive parent population, and 1065 of the finest children you'd ever want to meet, we believe that Cedar Hill Elementary School is producing some outstanding "Future Stars of the Millennium."

Our diverse and multicultural school is eleven years old and is located in suburban Gwinnett County, Georgia. We have nine kindergarten and first grade classrooms; seven second and fifth; eight third and fourth; and five special needs classrooms. We have 71 classroom teachers and 39 paraprofessional, office, custodial and cafeteria staff. Our comprehensive academic program, called "Academic Knowledge and Skills," was developed by the Gwinnett County Public School System to ensure that all Gwinnett County students and teachers are held to the very highest academic standards. The AKS program dictates a complete K-12 curriculum and periodic "Gateway" tests (in fourth, seventh, and tenth grades) to gauge whether or not the curriculum is being learned by each individual student. As an indication of Cedar Hill's strong academic preparation, our preliminary school data indicates a predicted passing rate of 98% of our fourth grade students. We are extremely proud of our "Future Stars" and faculty for their hard work in achieving this goal.

Further academic proof that Cedar Hill is full of "Future Stars" is the fact that our students consistently score above the national average on such tests as the Iowa Test of Basic Skills (ITBS). For example, on our 1998 ITBS, our second graders scored in the seventy fifth percentile in reading, the seventy-seventh in Language Arts, and the seventy-fourth in Math. Closer to home, a quick check of our last ranking period's Principal's Honor Roll indicates 125 Cedar Hill students in grades two through five received all A's. While we do not have an honor roll for our kindergarten and first graders, they too are recognized for excellence in Perfect Attendance. We had 40 kindergarteners and 60 first graders receiving this honor last quarter. Hooray for all of them! Our children are working hard, and our test scores and honor roll reflect their efforts.

Aside from the established curriculum, there are various enrichment and extracurricular programs which are helping to prepare our students for their roles as citizens of the world and leaders of the future. Cedar Hill offers a Focus program for gifted students and the nationally recognized Odyssey of the Mind for fourth and fifth graders. We have a Continental Math League with many first through fifth grade students involved in this problem-solving competition. There is a fully functioning and ever-expanding Accelerated Reader program for all six grades, and our technology program would be the envy of many schools, with a computer in every classroom and a fully integrated county-wide network. We have two cub scout packs with approximately ten dens in each and several girl scout and brownie troops. Thanks to our counselors, students from third to fifth grade can be trained as Peer Leaders, Bulldog Buddies, and Conflict Managers, and all our students participate in Red Ribbon Week and the Mendez Peace-Able Place programs to promote drug awareness and conflict resolution. Also, we are extremely proud of our fourth and fifth grade Student Council. This ambitious team of students pursues various civic responsibilities within our school. They conduct our in-school paper recycling program, raise and lower the flag each day, and lead the school in the recitation of the Pledge of Allegiance each morning. Additionally, they raise money through bake sales and candy sales for such worthy projects as playground equipment, the painting of a beautiful mural in our school hallway, and the purchase of computer disks for the Accelerated Reader program. Our school benefits greatly from their enthusiastic efforts.

Parents at Cedar Hill are also very active, and they show their support in many different ways. Some choose to help in the classroom or with specific events like our Kindergarten Fall Festival. Some occasionally meet their children for lunch during

the school day, a terrific morale booster for both. Others attend events like Curriculum Night and Science Fair Night to demonstrate their support. Many of our parents choose to join our Parent Teacher Association (PTA), which currently has 658 members. Our PTA supports the counselors in the coordination of such yearly events as a canned food drive at Thanksgiving, a Gingerbread Boy/Girl Gift Tree at Christmas, and a school supply drive in the spring. They also organize two "Family Fun" events during the year, staff the media center with a parent volunteer every weekday, host monthly "teacher appreciation" days, and support an extensive cultural arts program and "Outdoor Classroom."

BOOST deserves special mention, however. BOOST is a mentoring program organized by the counselors and the PTA which pairs committed parent volunteers with children who may need extra time and attention, academically or otherwise. Currently, there are 35 of these effective mentor relationships at Cedar Hill, a rewarding endeavor for those involved and an excellent example of the civic mindedness of our parents. Their assistance with early intervention will make all the difference in the world to some of these young lives. The efforts of our BOOST parents and all our school volunteers are appreciated not only for the results they achieve but for the valuable example they set for our "Future Stars of the Millennium."

Our faculty and administration are, of course, the determining factor in the success of our students. Our principal, Debbie Allred, has implemented a school development program based on noted educator John Goodlad's work to ensure that the entire school community--parents, students, and staff--are committed to the same ideals. A process has been established for involving all three groups in determining academic goals and ways to achieve them. Thus, our dedicated teachers conduct frequent grade level and committee meetings, and they pursue new instructional techniques and tools with enthusiasm. For example, they have worked closely with Georgia State University (which in turn collaborates with Ohio State) to develop a reading instructional program designed to have all our Cedar Hill students reading at or above grade level by the end of third grade. This resource networking has assisted our faculty with dramatic results: in the spring of 1999, 97.4% of third graders and 99.2% of fourth graders at Cedar Hill had achieved this goal. Such a successful reading instructional program doesn't begin to scratch the surface of the innovation our teachers continually introduce in their classrooms, everything from math manipulatives to the Accelerated Reader Program to our newly founded "Writer's Workshop." We are fortunate to have such a talented group of educators dedicated to our children's success.

It must be mentioned that our teachers are a civic-minded group, as well. For the past three years, they have chosen to participate in the American Cancer Society's Relay for Life. Last year they raised over \$9,000.00 for cancer research and were one of the highest revenue generating groups in our county. Their success in turn contributed to Gwinnett County being one of the top fundraising groups in the nation. There are 92 staff members are enrolled to participate again this year. That's nearly 100% of our faculty, a remarkable achievement!


