1. It is said that the furniture dealer Voegele, 6 Kronenstrasse, Karlsruhe, brought by order of the Civil Administration in Strasbourg furniture and other objects to Karlsruhe at the beginning of the year 1942.
At that time these things had been stored in the Herrenstrasse. On 4 December 1944 this warehouse with all the inventory burnt out totally.
2. In May and June 1945 the French Military Government has already searched for restitutable objects. Then the furniture dealer Voegele had returned objects, especially furniture, acquired from Strasbourg property during the war.
The furniture dealer Voegele has no restitutable objects in his possession any more.
Due to his statement it is possible that some pictures and
been among the confiscated things from Strasbourg being stored
and burnt in the Herrenstrasse, Karlsruhe. He has not dealt
with paintings and pictures. He is a furniture dealer and no
expert in paintings.
Statement
3. Mr. Voegele's may be true. He makes the impression of a joiner
and not of an expert. Also the furnishing of his apartment at
6 Kronenstrasse looks like that of a workman. There were no
valuable paintings or other works of art to be seen.




