SUBJECT WAS RELEASED FROM CAMP DORR TO THE SALZBURG POLICE ON 19 JUNE 1947 AND COMMITTED TO THE LANDESGERICHT JAIL AFTER THE AUSTRIAN POLICE FOUND SUBJECT LISTED IN THE DAILY GRAZ FAHNDUNGSBLATT OF 7 AUGUST 1946 UNDER ARTICLE 7192 LISTED THRU THE STICHHAUPTSDIREKTION OF THE LAND STEIERMARK ON ORDERS OF THE BRITISH ELEMENT REQUESTING SUBJECTS APPREHENSION. police. It is also not known to me who issued the order of his
removal by SOV, but later on I have heard that this was done by the
police men Djordje and Djordje, because of some bad behaviour.

III. Collection of the land products.

Passing through the whole territory of Bogota and Cundinamarca during the action against the rebels, I have realized that the land was pretty well cultivated and sown. Therefore it had to be soon harvested because of cornsilk, although the harvest of potatoes, millet, beans, plums, etc. is still.

The Constituent Board has received the Survey officials of Ministry of Agriculture under leadership of the economic advisor Mr. E. S. S. G. Francisco and officials of the State Work Service, for the organization of sowing of cornsilk.

INFORMATION (in English)

COLLECTING POINTS OF CATTLE.

By the Decree of Ministry for Economy, Mr. Tom Djordjevic of 7. 1. 1942 No. U.S. 706/42, there was ordered by way of the plenipotentiary of the Protection Authority at Banja Luka, that Mr. Djordjevic organizes the collection of cattle of the domestic and imported herds proportionally on the basis of the territory of operation of Novi Sad and Trebinje.

During the military operation and breaking of the combat fortresses of Bojana and Trebinje, there were established special service points for collection, classification and distribution of cattle in the main collecting centers, where the cattle were collected.

The cattle destined for further breaking for milling, transportation and dragging purposes, on the first place were distributed to the farmers in the surrounding places for the temporary use at the official request. The special care was given by us that the cattle were in hands of the Incurable Croatian Farmers.

The rest of these cattle has been sent to the other regions of our country and there distributed to the farmers for the temporary keeping. The distribution was done on the plan made by the NOVIS DNOVOZETVORENJE in Zagreb, which in most cases distributed cattle in the private Zagorje (Croatian province) and in the Croatian part of Bosnia in the northern part of our country.

As-Deputy Commissioner Mr. Glauer commented, that in the third wave instead of 30.000 Slovaks out of Slovakia, as it was fixed by the Agreement of 4th June 1941, only 10.000 Slovaks are to be re-settled, as follows: 15.000 starting with 15 September 1941 and the rest of 15.000, only after the end of the war.

Mr. Glauer stated as the representative of the Ministry for Foreign Affairs acted, that the German authorities had a right to determine the number of Slovaks who came into consideration for deportation, but the Croatian authority had a similar clause in right to deport the full number of 30.000 to the authorities to the Agreement of 4th June 1941, are to be deported.

Thereupon Dr. Glauer has reported that the German authorities in view of Zagreb was about to accept only as many Slovaks from Slovakia as the Slovaks were to be resettled to Croatia. Glauer said he would stand upon that the Slovaks be re-settled not to Croatia but to Serbia, in which case no more from Croatia could be accepted at all. By this he stated thereupon, that the above could cause a great alteration of the Agreement of 4 June 1941, as that the present agreement has a reference only to the territorial carrying out of regulations of the Agreement of 4 June 1941, but that the present situation is in no way authorized to make any alteration of the conclusion of the Comis. Inv. of 4 June 1941, in light how only the members of the Commission of 4 June 1941, represented, and not the rest of the conclusion of 4 June 1941 one cannot conclude, that the author of the words who are to be resettled in Croatia be increased, were in the case that the German authorities, in any way increase the number of the Slovaks who are to be deported. Anyhow, he should first submit his report on this to the Minister of Interior, and therefore he cannot discuss this question.

II. Life, Work, Political Disposition.

Crotchet, aged about 50, in April 1941 he was appointed to the State Secretary of the Croatian Ministry for Foreign Affairs from 19 Nov 1941, as the deputy to the Croatian Ambassador in Berlin; and from June to November 1941 he was representative of the Croatian Government with 7th Division of the German Command in Berlin; at present kept in jail in Berlin.

As even before the German-Anglo-Soviet war was well-known for his pro-Nazi proclivities.

Recently after the creation of the so-called "Independent State of Croatia" in April 1941, he was appointed as the State Secretary in the Croatian puppet Government, in Ministry for Foreign Affairs, as chief of political-administrative section of the Government.

In November 1941, he was appointed as deputy to the Croatian Ambassador in Berlin. It was his responsibility to coordinate the Croatian economic sector to the German economic system, in the service of the Nazi effort.

Hundreds of thousands hands were sent to Germany as slave workers by his immediate action.

There is no responsible for the brutal policy of that quisling government, especially for their policy of racial and national discrimination and persecution, for the setting up of concentration and annihilation camps of various patterns. Up to 500,000 Serbs and 10,000 Jews were annihilated in those camps under most inhuman conditions.

From June 15 to November 20, 1942 he was the representative of the Croatian Government with the 7th Division (the 7th) of the German Command in Berlin. He collaborated with them in the elaboration of the massive action plan in KROV, KRUMA, BOSNA, DRAVA, SAVINA, VJESKA, SISAK, ZAGREB, LIPSKA SLOVINA, etc. Tens of thousands of peasants were deported to concentration camps in Germany, thousands of them were hanged. Many houses were burnt down, whole stretches of land devastated. The cattle and other property of the inhabitants of those regions were seized, liquidated and distributed among the Nazi facilities in Croatia.

He assumed also the leader of the Board for the deportation of the Serbs from Croatia to Serbia and the resettlement of Germans to Croatia. By his immediate action thousands of Serbs were deprived of their own property and deported under most inhuman conditions. During these deportations many people lost their lives and millions perished from cold and poverty etc.

He was reported by the German occupation forces to be one which was used in the German Nazi army, - by special committee organized to them. - As a result of conspiracy and collaboration with Nazis work, (in practice) the head of a camp in Cetinje. This accused in those areas charged him the following: - 1. Active collaboration with the Nazi-Nazi, 2. Deportation of Serbs and other civilian and labor inmates conditions, denied or violated into the concentration camps, and violation of their rights and the conduct of pogroms, which were carried out during the period of Nazi rule.





Subject TURINA was released from arrest in Austrian Penal Camp Klessheim on 16 September 1947, and has been placed under Town Arrest at Siezenheimerstrasse 4, Salzburg, reporting twice weekly to the Undersigned. As a security measure, he will actually be living at Rosengasse 4, Salzburg, with acquaintances. He has been unofficially advised to make arrangements to move to Bavaria as soon as possible. To what extent can we be of assistance to him in this respect?

Through confidential informants the undersigned is led to believe that a super-hush-hush U.S. intelligence organisation (Waldman group) in Bavaria will be willing to actively support and protect Subject since negotiations with Croatian emigration elements there have been underway for some time, and Subject's continued internment has been a chief cause of Croat unwillingness to cooperate.

Subject's release by CIC is a strong, valuable point in our favor insofar as cooperation of Croat intelligence groups are concerned. Suggest that continued support from us would be well worth the trouble.



Subject, together with BLAZEKOVIC Dr. (fmu) and SAKKANIY Dr. (fmu) left Salzburg on or about 20 February 1948 for Genoa, Italy, where papers were allegedly waiting for them to emigrate to a South American country, reportedly Argentina. Subject did not have legal papers in his possession to leave Austria when he left Salzburg. The informant was told that they would attempt to cross the Austro-Italian border illegally, since they were unable to get legal exit permits.

Subject, born 19 August 1892 was arrested by CIC, Salzburg Det., on 21 August 1945 and released from Camp Marcus W. Orr to the Salzburg Police on the 19 June 1947.

BLAZEKOVIC (fmu), appears in an undated report, A.C. of S., G-2, USFA, Subject: "The Ustasha Movement" wherein a letter from the Jugoslav Repatriation Mission in Salzburg addressed to Lt. Col. Stephen of the DP Div., USFA, dated 4 July 1945 is mentioned stating that BLAZEKOVIC and other Ustasha personalities are living in the American Zone of Austria.

AGENT'S NOTES:

It is this Agent's opinion that Subject was successful in crossing the Austro-Italian border since Subject's daughter and his friends in the Ustasha circle have not heard from him since he left Salzburg for Genoa, Italy.

Pursuant to instructions from the Special Agent in Charge, Salzburg Sub-Section, this Agent began an investigation of Subject TURINA Dr. Oskar on the basis of an IRS from the D/I (CIB), USFA, dated 11 February 1948, requesting his apprehension, interrogation, and confinement of the War Crimes Prison, Salzburg, for extradition to Jugoslavia.

Interrogation of Subject's daughter and son-in-law MAYER Dr. Heinrich, born [redacted] P6(b)(6) currently living at Siezenheimerstrasse 1, Salzburg, and MAYER Maria, born [redacted] P6(b)(6) revealed the following information:

Subject TURINA Dr. Oskar had planned for some time to leave Austria since he believed that the Jugoslav government would request his extradition as a War Criminal. On or about 20 February 1948 Subject left Salzburg to get in contact with a commission in Linz that would help him emigrate. He has not returned since. Subject's wife, TURINA Nada, left for Linz to follow her husband approximately one week later and also has not returned. Mr. and Mrs. MAYER stated that they have not heard from either since and they do not know where Subject and his wife went after they left Salzburg for Linz.

An interview with Mr. Charles Clark, Administrative Officer of PC IRO, Area Team No. 1, Salzburg, revealed that Subject is not carried on the files of the PC IRO office as having emigrated as a displaced person from Austria.

Information from a usually reliable informant (B-3) of this office who has close contact with the Jugoslav Ustasha circle in Salzburg, revealed the following information:



1. THE DEVELOPMENTS IN NATIONAL INTELLIGENCE NEGOTIATIONS ARE DISAPPOINTINGLY SLOW, BUT IN THE LONG RUN MORE SUBSTANTIAL THAN IF RADICAL STEPS WERE DECREED BY FIAT. PURSUANT TO THE PRESIDENT'S LETTER TO THE SECRETARY OF STATE OF 20 SEPTEMBER, THE INTERDEPARTMENTAL COMMITTEE OF SECRETARIES HAS UNDER CONSIDERATION TWO DIFFERENT CONCEPTS:

(a) A PLAN NOW AGGRESSIVELY BEING STEERED BY THE INTELLIGENCE DIVISION OF THE STATE DEPARTMENT. THIS PLAN ACCEPTS A NATIONAL AUTHORITY OF THE THREE SECRETARIES: PROVIDES AN EXECUTIVE SECRETARIAT DOMINATED BY STATE DEPARTMENT, WHICH MANIPULATES A COMPLEX OF INTERDEPARTMENTAL COMMITTEES, PRESUMABLY DESIGNED TO COORDINATE THE ACTIVITIES OF EXISTING DEPARTMENTAL AGENCIES. CENTRAL OPERATIONS, WHILE NOT SPECIFICALLY PROVIDED, ARE NOT PRECLUDED. FOR EXAMPLE, THE PLAN IMPLIES THAT THERE MIGHT BE CENTRALIZED CLANDESTINE INTELLIGENCE BUT DEFERS DECISION PENDING FURTHER STUDY. WE FEEL THIS PLAN TO BE INADEQUATE AND A BACKWARD STEP.
