TO : Chief,
Foreign Exchange Depository
APO 757, US Army

1. Pursuant to letter, subject: "Removals from Foreign Exchange Depository, Reichsbank Building, Frankfurt", dated 1 March 1948, you are hereby authorized to release to the duly accredited representative of the International Refugee Organization the assets listed in detail in the attached Joint Inventory Annex A-1. This letter and Annex A-1, consisting of thirty-two pages, each bear my original signature.

2. Further, the FED is hereby authorized to retain in its possession the assets listed in detail in the Joint Inventory Annex A-2, with respect to which the duly accredited representative of the International Refugee Organization, acting for and on behalf of the International Refugee Organization, is to release and waive all rights and claims whatsoever in accordance with paragraph 4 below. Annex A-2, consisting of six pages, bears my original signature.

3. It is understood that the assets in question constitute "non-monetary gold" within the meaning of Article 8 of Part I of the Paris Reparation Agreement of January 14, 1946, and the Agreement Pertaining to Reparation Funds for Non-Repatriable Victims of German Action made at the Five-Power Conference of June 1946.

4. You will prepare and have signed by the duly authorized representative of the International Refugee Organization the official receipt and shipping ticket for the assets listed in Annex A-1. You will also prepare and have signed by the duly authorized representative of the International Refugee Organization your official rejection form by which the International Refugee Organization waives and releases all rights and claims whatsoever to the assets listed in Annex A-2.

5. This release has been authorized by Cable WX-85682 AGWAR from JCS to USFET for McNarney, dated 16 November 1946.

The portion thereof comprising Item No. 33 was described in our IRS of 10 Aug 1948, subject: "Assets set aside for delivery to IRO" to which you replied on 25 August 1948, authorizing this office to undertake preparatory steps for release. Subsequently Item No. 42 comprising silver bullion as listed on page 2 of the Annex A opposite Fed Form No. 1104 was ascertained to be of Melmer loot origin, unidentifiable as to ownership, and therefore also properly deliverable to IRO.</p> <p>2. The above Annex A does not include all the material which was offered IRO inasmuch as various assets of low intrinsic value were rejected by their representative. A listing in duplicate of the rejected material is also attached with draft of statement to be signed by IRO representative.</p> <p>3. Pursuant to a recent discussion at this office during which the F.A. gave verbal authorization to effect delivery to IRO against signature, however, of properly empowered representative, this office phoned IRO and in reply received cable from W. Hallam Tuck, IRO Director General, authorizing George Wenzel to receive, and also, in latter's discretion, to reject "Non-Monetary Gold" assets. It is understood that similar cable was also received by OFA.</p> <p>4. Trusting that proposed action and supporting documents meet with approval of F.A. this office would appreciate written authorization as promptly as possible in order to cooperate with IRO to meet an early sailing date.</p>

In order to accomplish a speedy and economical transfer of the additional non-monetary gold briefly described in the memorandum which you left at this office on May 6th, and which your representatives at the F.E.D. have discussed with Mr. George Wenzel, PCIRO Reparations Officer, it is suggested that the following procedure will be satisfactory to PCIRO.

1) With respect to looted currencies, Mr. Wenzel will verify the amount of US dollars, Swiss francs, and any other currencies which he deems of some value. With respect to the remaining currencies, the F.E.D. count will be accepted. Footnotes A. and B. of "Schedule B" of the receipt dated 17 March 1948, covering previous looted currency transfer, should be incorporated in the receipt for the present transfer of looted currencies.

2) With respect to the jewellery, including diamonds, semi-precious stones and other items, PCIRO will accept the description of such items as given by F.E.D., and will agree upon a "tentative agreed valuation", if the receipt for such jewellery items includes a footnote along the following lines:

"The quality and description as listed is that of the Foreign Exchange Depository only, and is accepted by PCIRO subject to their subsequent verification upon examination by PCIRO experts. The valuation is agreed to by PCIRO as a "tentative agreed evaluation", and is subject to subsequent verification by US Customs appraisers and PCIRO appraisers."

- 3) With specific reference to valuation of jewellery, especially diamonds and semi-precious stones, it is requested that F.E.D. do not insist upon high valuations which have no relation to current US market prices, since no useful purpose is served either to PCIRO or F.E.D. It has been PCIRO's experience in connection with Customs entry of diamonds and semi-precious stones, previously transferred by F.E.D., into the U.S. that the valuations were excessively high in relation to US current market prices and served no purpose except to retard and make more difficult the entry of the goods into the United States. It required weeks of extensive re-examination of all the gems by the Customs appraisers. This resulted in a reduction of more than 40% of the tentative agreed valuations in order to conform to current US market prices.
- 4) With respect to silver coins, PCIRO will agree to valuation based upon the weight of fine silver content times present market value (approx. \$24 per kilo of .999 fine)
- 5) With respect to previous metals, PCIRO will accept a tentative agreed valuation based upon weight of gold and approximate fineness times present market value (approx. \$35 per ounce of 24 carat gold.)
- 6) With respect to numismatic coins, PCIRO will accept the F.E.D. evaluation as a "tentative agreed evaluation".
- 7) With respect to other metal items, valuation will be tentatively agreed with F.E.D. by PCIRO representative George Wenzel.
- 8) With respect to securities, the form followed in "Schedule C" of the receipt dated 17 March 1948 is satisfactory to PCIRO, with the exception that PCIRO feels that it is not within the terms of the JCS non-monetary gold directive for it to accept securities which are in the name of any individual, since such securities do not appear to be unidentifiable as to ownership and PCIRO has found that they cannot be disposed of in any market. It prefers, therefore, not to accept transfer of any securities in the name of any individual.
- 9) With respect to such items as alarm clocks, pocket books, and certain types of tableware, it is PCIRO's experience, based upon liquidating the property previously transferred by F.E.D. that most of such items have no intrinsic value and therefore should be excluded from transfer to

SUBJECT: Release of Silver for Export (ED 410.2)

TO : Mr. Freeman

1. This carrier sheet from Economics Division would indicate that they have gone far toward planning to use silver now in the Depository, based on presumed clearance from the Finance Division. I am concerned, however, that the conditions as outlined in my memorandum of 9 July 1946, two copies of which were sent to the Economics Division, have not been entirely met. There would appear to be these problems:

- a) The SS loot silver belongs to IARA as "non-monetary gold" and permission must be obtained from IARA or it must be clear that the Reparations Branch of the Economics Division assumes responsibility to IARA for this property which is "subject to reparations".
- b) An agreement to replace silver taken from the Depository for this purpose would be subject to the limitations of importing within "essential requirements". We should be satisfied, therefore, that there would be no problem about utilizing proceeds of exports for this purpose, and also that commercial silver would be readily available in Europe for purchase.

2. My present disposition is not to release silver from the Depository unless we have a clear release from Washington which will have taken into account the prior claims of IARA.

3. My previous understanding with the Economics Division was that in their program they would utilize silver not within the Depository and then only on the basis of its release by the Reparations and Restitutions Branch.

The Other Gold, so-called because while definitely not Monetary Gold, it may or may not be Non-Monetary Gold, consists of crude bars said to have been melted down from jewelry settings by a Prague jeweler under German authorization. The remaining gold has been designated as Industrial Gold since for the most part it was in form of bars of known fineness and as customarily used for dental, jewelry, and other purposes and was largely held by firms utilizing gold. The press on Friday carried a report that \$5 million of gold was to be shipped from Paris to Canada. In addition it was reported that \$2.5 million will be shipped from London to Canada and that it is expected that further shipments will follow. It seems probable that the \$5 million shipment consists of British gold which was held in France and which is being shipped to Canada to be placed under earmark at the Bank of Canada. Since gold exports from Canada require the specific license of the Canadian Finance Minister, it is unlikely that private holders of gold would ship it to Canada for storage even though the European situation remains uncertain. Thus it seems likely that both the reported shipments as well as those which may follow are gold which will be placed under earmark at the Bank of Canada for the account of foreign central banks or governments.

The attached table presents the production, exports, imports, monetary stocks, and earmarking of gold in Canada since the Bank of Canada began to hold gold under earmark for foreign account in the beginning of 1956. It will be noted that, although there are certain temporary discrepancies from month to month caused by lags in reporting the data, over the whole period through February 1958 the net amount of gold available for earmarking, \$72 million, agrees very well with the total of gold placed under earmark, \$68 million. It will further be noted that except for one small import of \$600,000 of gold placed under earmark for the account of the Banco Central de Reserva de El Salvador, all the rest of the gold now held under earmark consists of Canadian production purchased by foreign central banks or governments and placed under earmark at the Bank of Canada. It seems likely that most if not all of this amount was purchased and is held for the account of the Bank of England. It also seems probable that most or all of the amounts reported as to

It will be recalled that prior to the World War the British shipped gold to Canada.

The Bank of Canada offers greater attractions than this Bank in the matter of complete safety of gold held under earmark in that Canada is one of the nations which agreed to the Convention of The Hague of 1930 which guarantees the immunity of B. I. S. assets, while the United States is not. Under this immunity a foreign central bank may choose the Bank of Canada for the maintenance and custody of gold deposited with the B. I. S. with absolute assurance that it will at all times retain complete control over the metal. The Annual Report for 1930 of the Banco Central de Reserva de el Salvador stresses this point:

"The Board of Directors chose the Bank of Canada for the maintenance and custody of the 'depositum regulare' which we maintain with the Bank for International Settlements for the following reasons: the location of its Ottawa vaults in the American continent; because Canada is one of the nations signatory to the Convention of The Hague, whose Article 10 states 'The bank (referring to the BIS), its property and assets and also deposits and other funds entrusted to it, in the territory or administrative dependencies of the Parties, shall be immune in time of peace and in time of war from any disability or restrictive measure such as expropriation, requisition, seizure, confiscation, prohibition or restriction of gold or currency export or import, or any other similar measures.' The Board of Directors has acted consequently with the greatest care and precautions and has assured for this deposit the guaranty of two central banks of the first class, one of those of international character, besides the juridical guaranty of the 'depositum regulare' by which there remain the property of the Banco Central de Reserva de el Salvador precisely the same here which were deposited, which have been described minutely in the respective documents."

It will be recalled that some time ago the Banco Central applied to us for a loan against gold thus held at the Bank of Canada, and, when we specified that the gold must be held within the United States, dropped the matter.

Pursuing our telephone conversation on your memorandum of June 5 regarding the amount of the French gold held under earmark in Ottawa, I wish to draw your attention to the following:

In the course of the recent negotiations, Mr. Monick supplied us at my request with information regarding, *inter alia*, the location of, and the recent changes in, France's gold holdings (see memorandum of mine on this subject to Mr. Knobbe, dated May 15). However, while the French statements showing the gold sales to Canada in January and February of this year correspond, on the whole, with the actual shipments of the French gold by the Bank of Canada to us,^{1/} there is a huge discrepancy between the figures supplied by the French as to the amount of their gold held in Ottawa and the information obtained yesterday from Mr. Turk. According to the French (see page 5 of my memorandum of May 15), 195 million dollars of the French gold were

Since the middle of 1941 foreign monetary authorities have increased their gold held under earmark here by \$519,000,000, primarily through the conversion of dollar assets. Although as yet this apparent preference for gold over dollars has resulted in no actual export of gold, it is conceivable that in the absence of restrictions and shipping difficulties a large part might have been repatriated. This is evidenced by the recent attempts by Switzerland to ship gold to Portugal and by the inquiry made by Uruguay regarding the importation of \$3,000,000 in gold from the United States. However, whether the foreign gold is repatriated or left under earmark here has little economic significance, per se. The importance lies rather in the underlying motives for the recent heavy buying. To the extent the acquisition of gold reflects a return of refugee capital which came here during the years leading up to the war or reflects a reduction in our previous heavy merchandise export surplus, the result would be the beginning of a salutary redistribution of our huge stock of gold. Such a redistribution would go far in aiding the restoration of an orderly system after the war. If, on the other hand, the gold purchases represent the beginning of a large-scale flight from the dollar involving the conversion of long existing dollar reserves, the result is not an approach toward "equilibrium" in our balance of payments, but the creation of new disequilibria. In addition to these economic considerations, the possibility of enemy manipulations must, of course, also be kept in mind in analyzing the current foreign buying of gold.

The conversion of foreign-held dollars into gold falls into two main groups - purchases by the European neutrals subject to our freezing control and purchases by Latin American groups.

European Neutrals

With respect to this group, it is significant to note that the general preference for gold did not become widespread until after the freezing of all continental accounts in June, 1941. To examine the purchases by the Swiss National Bank, which has been the heaviest buyer, it is necessary to go back to the collapse of France in June, 1940. It will be recalled that as soon as it was felt that Switzerland would be bypassed in the German expansion on the continent, there began a return flow of private Swiss capital which previously had fled the country. This repatriation of Swiss funds presumably was augmented by a flight of non-Swiss capital from the United States in anticipation of an extension of our freezing control. It is not unlikely that some of this capital was of Axis origin. However, although at first the Swiss National Bank apparently absorbed unlimited amounts of dollars offered in connection with this movement, by January, 1941 it was obliged to announce that while it would continue to supply Swiss francs against dollars arising from offerings by Swiss holders and from certain commercial transactions, it was unwilling to facilitate the flight of funds from the United States by others anxious only to avoid a possible blocking. Even despite the limitations imposed, the Swiss National Bank continued to accumulate dollars, with the result that by the time Swiss accounts were frozen in June, 1941 the Swiss authorities held over \$300,000,000 in this market, or about three times the amount in May, 1940 when the above-mentioned repatriation began.

Although small amounts of gold meanwhile had been purchased and earmarked, it was not until after the freezing that the large-scale buying program really was inaugurated. It is also significant to note that the amount of gold purchased and earmarked since June, 1941 corresponds rather closely with the amount of dollars accumulated by the Swiss authorities since May, 1940. In other words, the purchases of gold thus far have represented a conversion only of the "wind-fall" rather than of their old existing dollar reserves, which are still at about the level prevailing prior to May, 1940.

Although fears that the dollar might be devalued after the war - either as a means of combating a deflationary spiral or in self-defense against devaluations of other currencies - may be an underlying factor, the rapid accumulation of dollars by the Swiss National Bank between May, 1940 and May, 1941 and their subsequent blocking here would appear to be the factors determining both the timing and the magnitude of the gold buying. Gold held in New York, of course, is no more freely transferrable than blocked dollar assets. From a psychological point of view, however, the Swiss National Bank probably would be subject to less criticism for holding gold in New York than for having a large part of their assets in blocked exchange. Furthermore, with money rates in this market comparing unfavorably with those in many other countries, the uses to which their dollar assets can profitably be put are limited. For a time the Swiss authorities invested in U. S. Treasury bill holdings, accumulating a total of \$60,000,000 by the end of 1941. However, when the yield on these investments declined to below 1/4 of 1 per cent last January the Swiss allowed their holdings to run off -

possibly indicating that the return on short term investments suitable to their requirements was not sufficient to offset the advantages of holding gold.

The position of the monetary authorities of other European neutrals - Sweden, Portugal, and Turkey - appears to be largely the same as of Switzerland, although the amounts involved are not as large. All have experienced an increase in their holdings of dollars since the war began. As in the case of Switzerland, dollars acquired by the Banco de Portugal and the Riksbank seem to have come, in some part, from accounts held in this country by their own nationals, either through the requisition of private holdings or a voluntary repatriation. *The possibility cannot be overlooked, however, that, again, as in the case of Switzerland, some of the dollar exchange has been acquired, either wittingly or unwittingly, from Axis sources. Evidence of this is given by the British report, outlining in detail the devious method whereby Germany acquires escudos against looted U. S. currency and Portugal receives blocked dollars through the sale of the banknotes in South America.

As to Sweden, it will be recalled that the Riksbank was obliged to lose about \$150,000,000 of its gold reserve during 1940 largely in supporting the krona in the face of a flight of funds from Sweden. Even though the Riksbank has increased its earmarked gold holdings by about \$80,000,000 since May, 1941 (\$50,000,000 of which occurred during the last four months), the total gold reserves are still about \$30,000,000 below the level of December, 1939 and about \$80,000,000 below the amount held at the outbreak of the war. Its current dollar reserves, on the other hand, are about double the amount

held at the end of 1939. It is therefore evident that Sweden's recent conversion of dollars into gold does not as yet represent a large-scale flight from the dollar, but rather a rebuilding of her gold reserves.

The dollar and gold reserves of Switzerland, Sweden, Portugal, and Turkey are given for various dates since the war, in Appendices I, II, III, and IV.

Latin American Countries

As in the case of the European neutrals, the substantial acquisition of gold by the Central Bank of Argentina appears to reflect more the conversion into gold of new dollar receipts than a flight from the dollar. During the past eighteen months, when gold purchasing and earmarking operations have been most pronounced, gold held under earmark here for the Central Bank has increased about \$153,000,000. Meanwhile, reported official dollar funds have actually increased by about \$4,000,000 net.

In considerable part, these earmarking operations no doubt reflect a reversal of the passive trade balance with the United States which Argentina previously experienced. Beginning with the fourth quarter of 1940, the trade balance became favorable to Argentina, and continued so through most of 1941. In the fourteen months ended November, 1941 (the last month for which data are available), Argentine exports to this country exceeded their imports of our products by approximately \$55,000,000. This export surplus is no doubt reflected in the Central Bank's acquisition of additional gold under earmark here.

It is not unlikely that some part of the dollar receipts which have been converted into gold arose from the movement of capital from this country to Argentina on behalf of foreigners anticipating the imposition of/freezing regulations here. A further substantial source of the official funds used in the gold purchasing and earmarking operations is to be found in the net decline of \$50,700,000 in reported private Argentine accounts during 1941, presumably reflecting in part sales of dollars to the central bank in connection with the conversion into pesos of dollar deposits previously held by Argentine commercial banks. In view of the close supervision exercised by the Argentine authorities over foreign exchange operations of commercial banks and other firms, the rather substantial transfer of dollar balances from private to official Argentine account and their subsequent conversion into gold might possibly lend itself to the interpretation that official policy reflected a fear of dollar devaluation. This interpretation, however, would not appear to explain the larger part of the gold acquisitions.

The movement of Argentine gold and dollar funds and trade statistics are given in Appendix V.

Other Latin American countries, notably Venezuela, have also increased the amount of gold held under earmark for their accounts here. These earmarking operations have not been accompanied by any corresponding declines in dollar balances and, as in the case of Argentina, appear to reflect in considerable part the conversion into gold of new dollar receipts arising from an improved trade position vis-a-vis the U. S. and possibly from an inflow of capital.

Conclusion

It seems reasonable to conclude on the basis of the foregoing that our loss of gold to foreigners to date has been brought about by changes in the two factors which had been primarily responsible for our large accumulation of gold - namely, the favorable trade balance and the flight of capital to this country from Europe. The repatriation of at least some of this capital, together with our extensive buying of strategic materials, has provided dollar exchange to the neutrals, and it has been largely these newly-acquired dollars which have been used for acquiring gold.

As to the future, it would appear that the acquisitions of dollars through a repatriation of capital will be on a smaller scale than that which preceded the freezing of European assets here. Assuming continued availability of shipping facilities, it seems likely, however, that our purchases of Latin American products will continue to provide an increased volume of dollar exchange, which the Latin American countries may in turn convert into gold.

For the first time since the dollar was devalued in 1933, recent months have witnessed a significant movement of foreign funds out of dollar exchange. In a world less shackled with restrictions and controls, this flight would probably have taken one of two forms: (1) purchase of foreign currencies against dollars, or (2) shipment of gold out of the United States. However, prohibitions against such forms of transfer have resulted in a net accumulation of unearned gold in this Bank. Although I am limiting this discussion to Switzerland, Sweden, and Portugal, several of the Latin American countries have been pursuing a similar policy.

The shift from dollars to gold appears rather enormous, when we realize that there is very little price scale difference between them today, as a result of our gold and foreign exchange regulations. Neither the gold nor the dollars can be moved outside this country or to the account here of another nation without a special licence from the Treasury - and the Treasury has not been overly generous with such authorizations. From the short run viewpoint, therefore, dollars and unearned gold are, to all intents and purposes, identical.

If we limit ourselves to the short run aspect of the question, there is only one possible explanation for the shift. That is the position of the foreign banks' note coverage. However, an examination of the data and of the note coverage regulations gives little indication that this has anything to do with the situation. Switzerland is required to hold gold within the country equal to 40 per cent of its note issue. Whether she is doing so is not known precisely,^{*} but the fact remains

that India, Swiss holdings of gold (in Switzerland and abroad) have been at least 100 per cent of the note issue during the past year. Portugal is required to hold reserves of 30 per cent - but in either gold or foreign exchange. Sweden can expand her note issues to twice her total gold holdings plus 350 million kroner. During 1941, the unused right of note issues varied between 400 million and 500 million kroner, but significant increases in gold held in the United States did not occur until December 1941. At that time, the unused right of issues was at about 500 million kroner, and purchases of gold since then have been much too large to be carried out merely for note issue purposes.

The only other short run possibility would be that these countries have been losing gold in large amounts in Europe and are purchasing here in order to maintain the total gold figure on the central bank statement. However, on the basis of data available to us, there is no indication of any appreciable loss in Europe.

No merit, therefore, such an explanation for the shift in the January factors involved. The attached table shows net changes in gold and dollar balances in the Second Federal Reserve district for the past year. The gold figures have been adjusted for net increases due to shipments or to transfers of unmarked gold from other countries; in other words, they represent only purchases of gold from the Treasury. Two significant facts are shown in this table: (1) All three of the countries shown have engaged in purchases of considerable magnitude, and (2) they all started to buy at approximately the same time - in the third quarter of 1941.

It will be recalled that at that time the likelihood of this country's entrance into the war was becoming increasingly certain, while the odds on a Hitler victory were rising as a result of what was then an offensive in Russia. By December we were in the war and suffering serious reverses.

The coincidence of these events and the sale of dollars is significant. At first it may appear that, like a hawing pinto, the central banks are returning to gold in time of crisis. Centuries of traditional respect for the tangible metal as compared to deposits, currency, or securities cannot easily be erased by statements by the Germans that money will no longer be "backed" on gold after the war. Even though it is mostly locked in vaults across the seas, gold is still considered a "safer" asset than anything else.

Although this instinctive move may be conditioned on underlying factors in the flight from the dollar, the more practical and tangible cause would appear to be based on the common sense and financial common sense of the foreign central banks. For there is a definite possibility that the end of the war will see a depreciation in the foreign exchange value of the dollar - no matter which side wins - and in that case the purchase of gold represents an excellent hedge. Even the most radical economic thinkers have conceded that gold will continue to have value as a means of settling international balances; thus, in an environment of currency depreciation, those who bought gold in 1941-1942 will be able to sell it at a good profit when the war is over. Even though the dollar should depreciate less than other currencies - resulting in a relative appreciation - any absolute decline will yield a profit to holders of gold. It is obvious that the United States has a tremendous stake in maintaining the value and use of gold after the war, as there

Is very little chance that its dollar price will fall.

The basis for believing that the dollar will depreciate may be said to rest on four lines of reasoning:

- (1) The relaxation of American freezing regulations after the war will probably result in some repatriation of the funds which came here during the 1930's.
- (2) The strong possibility of price inflation is always connected in the minds of Europeans with currency depreciation.
- (3) If the United States should lose the war, the value of its currency is sure to fall precipitously.
- (4) It happened "last time" to most important currencies, and, even though the dollar was exempted then, it might not escape this time.

Thus, the purchase of gold appears to be a hedge against the perfectly possible eventuality that there will be a drop in the gold value of the dollar in the future. Underlying this is a spontaneous aversion to the currency of a country which is still on the defensive side of the battle. So say, therefore, expect these purchases to vary with our success in the fortunes of war, but no matter what the rate of gold accumulation, there is every indication that its trend will be persistently in one direction.

1. Insufficient distinction is made between a change in the exchange value of the dollar and in its gold value. If dollar depreciates in terms of foreign currencies, it is highly probable that dollar price of gold will remain same while its foreign price falls. In short, gold or dollars will still constitute an equal risk.
2. Assuming our losing war would mean fall in exchange value of dollar, foreign price of gold would probably fall even faster. Who is going to support it, especially in view of expressed Axis ~~policy~~ attitude toward the metal.





BRIEF ON LETTER TO PRESIDENTS OF STATE RESERVE BANKSCONFIDENTIAL

Inasmuch as time did not permit an adequate discussion of developments in the foreign field at the recent Presidents' Conference, I am again writing in order to review recent trends in the international movement of gold and capital and in the foreign exchanges, and to report on the foreign operations of the Federal Reserve Bank of New York since my last letter of February 13.

The predominate factor in the international movement of gold continues to be the conversion into gold of the dollar funds of an increasing number of foreign countries. As a result of these conversions, the total amount of gold held under earmark here for foreign account has increased about \$150,000,000 further since the middle of February to a level over \$500,000,000 above that prevailing when all continental European accounts were frozen in June, 1941. In view of the magnitude of these foreign acquisitions of gold, most of which would, no doubt, have been exported had it not been for the present restrictions and shipping difficulties, I should like to deal in some detail with the underlying motives and economic considerations involved.

The explanation for the heavy buying of gold by foreigners seems to lie in changes in the two factors which have been primarily responsible for our previous large accumulation of gold - namely, the flight of capital to this country from Europe and our favorable balance of trade. The first factor applies principally to the remaining European neutrals, almost all of whom have been acquiring gold in recent months. It will be recalled that in the months leading up to the invasion of Normandy and the Low Countries many neutral European countries experienced a large-scale flight of capital to the United States and in supporting their currencies in the face of this movement the monetary authorities of these countries were obliged to draw on their gold

I would like to call your attention to a passage in a cable dated 10 JUN 1964 which may be relevant to the issue of Brazil last week. It reads as follows:

"In view of the existing situation in Brazil, it is recommended that you advise the Director to instruct the appropriate offices to take all necessary steps to prevent the disclosure of information concerning our agents in Brazil. This is particularly important in view of the recent developments in Argentina."

"It is believed that, because of the sensitive nature of the information held by your office, the release of unverified data causes substantial harm whatever the source of the information. It is also believed that such information could be used to discredit your office. Therefore, it is recommended that you advise the Director to instruct the appropriate offices to take all necessary steps to prevent the disclosure of information concerning our agents in Brazil."

The 10 JUN 1964 cable was signed by the Director of the FBI at the time, J. Edgar Hoover, and was countersigned by the Director of Central Intelligence, George F. Kennan. The cable was addressed to the Director of Central Intelligence, the Director of the FBI, and the Director of the CIA. It was also copied to the Director of Defense, the Secretary of State, and the Director of the Central Intelligence Agency. 


"Including acquisitions of gold not included in the regular gold stock figures."
