THE PRESIDENT IS CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER OF THE NEW YORK CITY HEALTH AND HOSPITALS CORPORATION. HHC IS A PUBLIC BENEFIT CORPORATION GOVERNED BY A SIXTEEN-MEMBER BOARD OF DIRECTORS. THE PRESIDENT IS NOMINATED BY THE MAYOR AND APPOINTED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS.

HHC IS THE LARGEST MUNICIPAL HEALTH CARE SYSTEM IN THE UNITED STATES. IT COMPRISES 11 ACUTE CARE HOSPITALS; 5 LONG-TERM CARE FACILITIES; 6 DIAGNOSTIC & TREATMENT CENTERS; 6 CERTIFIED HOME HEALTH AGENCIES; OVER 40 OFF-SITE CLINICS AND THE EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICE, THE CITY'S AMBULANCE CORPS. THE CORPORATION, HAS A \$3 BILLION BUDGET, 49,000 EMPLOYEES AND TREATS ANYONE REGARDLESS OF THE ABILITY TO PAY.

THE NEW YORK CITY DEPARTMENT OF MENTAL HEALTH, MENTAL RETARDATION AND ALCOHOLISM SERVICES IS THE LARGEST LOCAL MENTAL HYGIENE SYSTEM IN THE UNITED STATES AND IN THE WORLD. IT RANKS AS THE FOURTH OR FIFTH LARGEST SYSTEM IN THIS NATION.

THE COMMISSIONER, APPOINTED BY THE MAYOR, IS RESPONSIBLE FOR DIRECTING THE NEW YORK CITY DEPARTMENT OF MENTAL HEALTH, MENTAL RETARDATION AND ALCOHOLISM SERVICES AND REPORTS TO THE MAYOR. THE DEPARTMENT IS MANDATED TO PLAN, CONTRACT, MONITOR AND EVALUATE MENTAL HEALTH, MENTAL RETARDATION AND ALCOHOLISM SERVICES. DEPARTMENT PROGRAMS SERVED APPROXIMATELY 425,000 DISABLED PERSONS A YEAR AND ADMINISTERED 807 PROGRAMS THROUGH 320 CONTRACTS WITH MUNICIPAL HOSPITALS, VOLUNTARY AGENCIES, THE CITY'S HUMAN RESOURCES ADMINISTRATION AND ITS CORRECTIONAL FACILITIES. THE DEPARTMENT PROVIDED DIRECT SERVICES TO THE FAMILY AND CRIMINAL COURTS. THE OVERALL BUDGET FOR ALL PROGRAMS ADMINISTERED BY THE DEPARTMENT WAS \$680 MILLION, 2% OF WHICH WAS DEVOTED TO ADMINISTRATIVE COSTS. THE DEPARTMENT ADMINISTERED 185 MENTAL HEALTH CONTRACTS, 93 CONTRACTS FOR THE DEVELOPMENTALLY DISABLED AND 41 ALCOHOLISM CONTRACTS. THE DEPARTMENT HAD A DIRECT STAFF OF APPROXIMATELY 300 EMPLOYEES.

THE PRESIDENT OF THE MEDICAL STAFF IS AN ELECTED OFFICER CHOSEN BY THE MEDICAL STAFF. THE TERM OF OFFICE IS TWO YEARS. THE RESPONSIBILITIES INCLUDE: 1) PROVIDING LEADERSHIP TO THE MEDICAL STAFF; 2) INSURING THE PROVISION OF QUALITY MEDICAL CARE TO PATIENTS; 3) WORKING WITH AND COORDINATING ISSUES, SERVICES, ETC. BETWEEN VARIOUS MEDICAL DEPARTMENTS; 4) REPRESENTING THE MEDICAL STAFF TO THE COLLEGE, HOSPITAL ADMINISTRATION, HEALTH & HOSPITALS CORPORATION, COMMUNITY REGULATORY AND ACCREDITING AGENCIES; AND 5) ADMINISTERING THE OPERATIONS OF MEDICAL STAFF COMMITTEES, TASK FORCES AND FUNCTIONS.

THE HOSPITAL SERVICES THE SOUTH BRONX, A POPULATION OF APPROXIMATELY 500,000 PEOPLE.

ACADEMICALLY, THE DEPARTMENT IS PART OF NEW YORK MEDICAL COLLEGE AND IS ONE OF THE CORE CLINICAL TRAINING SITES FOR MEDICAL STUDENTS WHO ROTATE THROUGH THE DEPARTMENT OF PSYCHIATRY. THE DEPARTMENT HAS A PSYCHIATRY RESIDENCY TRAINING PROGRAM WITH NINETEEN RESIDENTS. THE PROGRAM DIRECTOR FOR RESIDENCY TRAINING FUNCTIONED UNDER MY DIRECTION AND I HAD OVERALL RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE MEDICAL STUDENTS AND RESIDENTS WITHIN THE DEPARTMENT OF PSYCHIATRY, LINCOLN MEDICAL AND MENTAL HEALTH CENTER.

THE DEPARTMENT WAS INVOLVED IN CONDUCTING CLINICAL RESEARCH IN SEVERAL AREAS UNDER MY DIRECTION.


