Dear Colleague:

Last week Mrs. Clinton launched the White House Millennium Council's newest national program, entitled "Millennium Communities," at the U.S. Conference of Mayors meeting. This program is a partnership of the White House Millennium Council with the Bureau of Indian Affairs and major national intergovernmental associations -- the U.S. Conference of Mayors, the National League of Cities, the National Association of Counties, and the National Association of Towns and Townships. Together we are inviting local elected officials, private citizens, and entire communities to plan meaningful activities around the national theme, "Honor the Past -- Imagine the Future."

At the launch, Mrs. Clinton also announced the release of the White House Millennium Council's *Millennium Communities Handbook*, a guide to commemorating the millennium for communities across the nation. The *Handbook* describes many local projects that can be replicated in other communities and provides information about our national programs in which communities and individuals can participate.

I am pleased to provide you with a copy of the *Millennium Communities Handbook* and will make additional copies available to any office interested in distributing them. The *Handbook* will be sent to local elected officials through the Millennium Communities partnering organizations, non-profit organizations and individuals and groups that have been in contact with our office over the past year. 
