## **Scope and Content Note**

The material in FOIA 2014-0664-F are a selective, not necessarily all inclusive, body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. The Clinton Presidential records processed include responsive photographs taken by White House photographers from November 1995 through March 1997 related to Monica Lewinsky. Photographs from November 17, 1995 are as follows: President Clinton greeting Monica Lewinsky and talking with staff in the Chief of Staff's Office in the West Wing Photographs from November 20, 1995 are as follows: President Clinton attending a staff birthday party in the Outer Oval Office Photographs from December 17, 1996 are as follows: President Clinton and Hillary Rodham Clinton greeting Monica Lewinsky at a Christmas reception in the Diplomatic Reception Room Photographs from February 28, 1997 are as follows: President Clinton greeting Monica Lewinsky following his weekly radio address in the Oval Office
