

## **Extent**

Approximately 2,713 photographs in color and black & white film processed from 35mm negatives.

## **Summary**

The photographs processed in segment 45 were created from May 26, 1993 through May 29, 1993. The segment contains photographs pertaining to: arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President Clinton, Hillary Rodham Clinton, and staff for the time period processed.

## **Scope and Content Note**

The materials in FOIA 2006-1135-F are a selective, not necessarily all inclusive, body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related materials. FOIA 2006-1135-F is a request for all Clinton Administration White House photographs taken in 1993. The photographs processed in segment 45 were created from May 26, 1993 through May 29, 1993. The segment contains photographs pertaining to: arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President Clinton, Hillary Rodham Clinton, and staff for the time period processed. Within this segment, photographs from May 26, 1993 are as follows: President Clinton talking with Paula Zahn and Harry Smith of CBS "This Morning" and looking at the set for the town hall meeting in the Rose Garden, President Clinton meeting with Ambassador Thomas Pickering, Sec. Warren Christopher, Strobe Talbott, Toby Gati, and Nancy Soderberg in the Oval Office, President Clinton conferring with VP Gore, George Stephanopoulos, Howard Paster, & Susan Brophy in the Oval Office. Photographs from May 27, 1993 are as follows: President Clinton talking with Dee Dee Myers, Steve Rabinowitz, George Stephanopoulos, Nancy Hennreich, and others in the Oval Office, President Clinton participating in a CBS "This Morning" Town Hall meeting with Paula Zahn and Harry Smith in the Rose Garden, President Clinton participating

in a budget meeting with Leon Panetta, Roy Neel, Mack McLarty, Howard Paster, and George Stephanopoulos in the Oval Office, President Clinton addressing the U.S. First Competition winners in the Rose Garden, Alexis Herman meeting with representatives from the Black Recording Association in the Roosevelt Room, President Clinton greeting National Security Council (NSC) staff in the Oval Office, Tony Lake greeting NSC staff in his West Wing office, Hillary Rodham Clinton greeting Dave Anderson and his father in the White House, President Clinton greeting George White, Architect of the U.S. Capitol, in the Oval Office, President Clinton talking with George Stephanopoulos in the Oval Office, President Clinton and James Carville reading newspaper clippings in the Oval Office, President Clinton talking and awaiting the results of the budget bill vote with Leon Panetta, Howard Paster, Tim Keating, and Susan Brophy in the Oval Office, Staff working, interacting, watching television, making telephone calls throughout the day of the budget bill vote, President Clinton and VP Gore standing near the President's desk and listening to the budget bill vote results via the telephone, President Clinton and staff celebrating the passing of the budget bill, President Clinton and Mack McLarty greeting a WHCA crew member in the Oval Office, Hillary Rodham Clinton addressing the National Legal Aid and Defender Association dinner at the Washington Hilton and Towers. Photographs from May 28, 1993 are as follows: President Clinton and VP Gore participating on a telephone conference call with the Veterans Administration Medical Centers in Virginia, Albany, NY, Bronx, NY, and Philadelphia, PA, President Clinton signing Executive Order No. 12350 "Conditions for Renewal of Most Favored Nation Status for the People's Republic of China in 1994." (Sen. George Mitchell & Rep. Nancy Pelosi are present) President Clinton greeting Chinese students and Sen. Charles Robb, Sen. Daniel Patrick Moynihan, and Rep. Dan Rostenkowski after the Executive Order signing, President Clinton talking alone with VP Gore and Mack McLarty in the Outer Oval Office, Hillary Rodham Clinton meeting with Sen. Jay Rockefeller, Sen. Tom Daschle, Laura Quinn, and Tamera Stanton in the West Wing, Hillary Rodham Clinton talking with Lisa Caputo and Maggie Williams in the West Wing, Hillary Rodham Clinton meeting with Sen. Wendell Ford, Miles Goggans, Robert Mangas, and Kennie Gill in the West Wing, Hillary Rodham Clinton meeting with Jehan Sadat in the Yellow Oval Room, President Clinton talking with the press on the South Lawn prior to departing for Philadelphia, President Clinton greeting staff and guests along the ropeline on the South Lawn prior to departing to Philadelphia, President Clinton and Sen. Harris Wofford disembarking Marine One after arriving at Philadelphia International Airport,

President Clinton taping his Weekly Radio address at the Wyndham Franklin Hotel, President Clinton inside Philadelphia City Hall preparing for his upcoming speech to the people of Philadelphia, President Clinton addressing the people of Philadelphia outside City Hall, President Clinton greeting the crowd after his remarks, President Clinton greeting police and others prior to departing Philadelphia en route to Andrews Air Force Base and the White House. Photographs from May 29, 1993 are as follows: President Clinton meeting with senior staff in the Oval Office prior to his press conference, President Clinton delivering a press conference regarding White House staff changes in the Rose Garden, President Clinton introducing David Gergen as White House Counselor and George Stephanopoulos as a Policy and Political Advisor during the press conference, Mack McLarty, David Gergen, and Roy Neel briefing the press in the Press Briefing Room, Hillary Rodham Clinton meeting with Congressional leadership and Veterans Administration (VA) officials at the Washington VA Medical Center, Hillary Rodham Clinton talking with medical staff and touring the VA medical center, President Clinton greeting guests on the South Lawn prior to departing for West Point, NY, President Clinton arriving at Stewart International Airport in Newburgh, NY en route to West Point, President Clinton arriving via Marine One at West Point, U.S. Military Academy, President Clinton addressing the United States Military Academy graduation ceremony, President Clinton greeting cadets during the graduation ceremony at Michie Stadium, and President Clinton talking with academy staff and touring the academy campus buildings.
