Approximately 2,881 photographs in color and black & white film processed from 35mm negatives.

Summary

The photographs processed in segment 46 were created from May 28, 1993 through May 29, 1993 and May 31, 1993 through June 2, 1993. The segment contains photographs pertaining to: arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President Clinton, Hillary Rodham Clinton, and staff for the time period processed.

Scope and Content Note

The materials in FOIA 2006-1135-F are a selective, not necessarily all inclusive, body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related materials. FOIA 2006-1135-F is a request for all Clinton Administration White House photographs taken in 1993. The photographs processed in segment 46 were created from May 28, 1993 through May 29, 1993 and May 31, 1993 through June 2, 1993. The segment contains photographs pertaining to: arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President Clinton, Hillary Rodham Clinton, and staff for the time period processed. The responsive photographs from May 28, 1993 are closed under exemptions of the Freedom of Information Act. Within this segment, photographs from May 29, 1993 are as follows: President Clinton arriving at Stewart International Airport in Newburgh, NY en route to West Point, NY, President Clinton arriving via Marine One at West Point, U.S. Military Academy, President Clinton addressing the United States Military Academy graduation ceremony, President Clinton greeting cadets during the graduation ceremony at Michie Stadium, and President Clinton talking with academy staff and touring the academy campus buildings, President Clinton greeting people on departing Newburgh, NY, Hillary Rodham Clinton talking

with medical staff and touring the Washington VA Medical Center, President Clinton meeting with David Gergen, Roy Neel, George Stephanopoulos, and others before giving a Rose Garden press conference, President Clinton announcing to the press White House staff changes including announcing David Gergen as White House Counselor and George Stephanopoulos as Policy and Political Advisor, President Clinton meeting with VP Gore, Mack McLarty, David Gergen, and George Stephanopoulos in the Old Family Dining Room, and Mack McLarty briefing the press with David Gergen and Roy Neel in the Press Briefing Room. Photographs from May 31, 1993 are as follows: President Clinton and Hillary Rodham Clinton hosting a Memorial Day Breakfast in the State Dining Room for representatives from Veterans organizations, President Clinton meeting in the Oval Office with Sec. Jesse Brown and representatives from Veterans organizations, President Clinton meeting with Marvin Runyon, Postmaster General, in the Red Room, President Clinton greeting Gen. Colin Powell in the Oval Office, President Clinton addressing a Memorial Day service at the Vietnam Veterans Memorial in Washington, DC, President Clinton participating in a wreath laying ceremony at the Vietnam Veterans Memorial, President Clinton viewing and taking in the Vietnam Veterans Memorial, President Clinton addressing a Memorial Day ceremony at Arlington National Cemetery in Arlington, VA, President Clinton talking with Tony Lake, Mark Gearan, Stan Greenberg, and Mandy Grunwald on the South Lawn after returning from Arlington, President Clinton in the Oval Office with Mark Gearan, Tony Lake, Dee Dee Myers, and others, views of a floral arrangement in the Blue Room, Mark Gearan crossing the Rose Garden with John Podesta, President Clinton participating in a signing ceremony for a World War II commemorative proclamation and coin and stamp commemoratives in the East Room, President Clinton and Hillary Rodham Clinton greeting veterans and guests in the East Room, and President Clinton meeting with Tony Lake, Dee Dee Myers, Mark Gearan, and David Watkins in the Oval Office. Photographs from June 1, 1993 are as follows: President Clinton greeting staff and visitors along the South Lawn rope line on departing to Milwaukee via Marine One en route to Andrews Air Force Base, President Clinton talking with Dee Dee Myers and Bruce Lindsey on Marine One en route to Andrews Air Force Base, President Clinton arriving at General Mitchell Field in Milwaukee, President Clinton disembarking Air Force One with Sec. Donna Shalala and greeting people at the airport, President Clinton delivering a speech on the economy to the people of Milwaukee at Bruce Hall at the Milwaukee Exposition and Convention Center and Arena (MECCA), President Clinton participating in local interviews with Cincinnati radio, television, and print

outlets in the Walker Room, Bruce Hall in Milwaukee, President Clinton visiting Langer's Pharmacy in Milwaukee with Sec. Donna Shalala, President Clinton greeting pharmacy personnel and shopping at Langer's Pharmacy, President Clinton addressing a crowd outside of Langer's Pharmacy from a fire truck, President Clinton greeting the crowd outside of Langer's Pharmacy, President Clinton greeting drivers, police, and greeters on departing Milwaukee, and President Clinton with staff aboard Air Force One en route to Andrews Air Force Base. Photographs from June 2, 1993 are as follows: President Clinton meeting with Canadian Prime Minister Brian Mulroney in the Oval Office, President Clinton and Prime Minister Mulroney having breakfast in the Oval Office Dining Room, Prime Minister Mulroney signing the guest book in the Cabinet Room, President Clinton talking with Eli Segal next to the Presidential Limousine on the South Grounds, President Clinton participating in a community service project with the Georgetown Class of 1968 and Marshall Heights community members, President Clinton pushing a lawn mower, raking and helping clean up the grounds at Watts Branch Park in Washington, DC, President Clinton conferring with Gene Sperling, George Stephanopoulos, Alexis Herman, and Marcia Hale, President Clinton participating in a lunch with Corporate Executive Officers in the Old Family Dining Room, Hillary Rodham Clinton and Tipper Gore attending the Congressional Club First Lady's luncheon in Washington, DC, and Hillary Rodham Clinton meeting with Walter Shapiro of Esquire Magazine in the White House Library.
