Summary

Scope and Content Note

The materials in FOIA 2006-1135-F are a selective, not necessarily all inclusive, body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related materials. FOIA 2006-1135-F is a request for all Clinton administration White House photographs taken in 1993. The photographs processed in segment 49 were created from June 9, 1993 through June 12, 1993. Photographs from June 12, 1993 are as follows: President Clinton jogging on the National Mall in Washington, President Clinton greeting Correspondence Office volunteers in the West Lobby, President Clinton greeting hundreds of volunteers on West Executive Ave. and on the steps of the Old Executive Office Building, President Clinton delivering his weekly radio address in the Oval Office with George Stephanopoulos, Mark Gearan, Sandy Berger and Richard Strauss, President Clinton greeting radio address guests in the Oval Office, President Clinton golfing with Tim Chorba, Rep. Bill Hefner and David Dunn at the Army-Navy Country Club in Virginia, and President Clinton greeting Rhodes Scholar classmates at an Oxford University class reunion in the Rose Garden.
