Summary

The photographs processed in segment 57 were created from July 2, 1993 through July 8, 1993. The segment contains photographs pertaining to: arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President Clinton, Hillary Rodham Clinton, and staff for the time period processed.

Scope and Content Note

The materials in FOIA 2006-1135-F are a selective, not necessarily all inclusive, body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related materials. FOIA 2006-1135-F is a request for all Clinton administration White House photographs taken in 1993. The photographs processed in segment 57 were created from July 2, 1993 through July 8, 1993. The segment contains photographs pertaining to: arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President Clinton, Hillary Rodham Clinton, and staff for the time period processed.
