## **Summary**

The photographs processed in segment 56 were created from July 1, 1993 through July 5, 1993 & July 8, 1993. The segment contains photographs pertaining to: arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President Clinton, Hillary Rodham Clinton, and staff for the time period processed.

## **Scope and Content Note**

The materials in FOIA 2006-1135-F are a selective, not necessarily all inclusive, body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related materials. FOIA 2006-1135-F is a request for all Clinton administration White House photographs taken in 1993. The photographs processed in segment 56 were created from July 1, 1993 through July 5, 1993 & July 8, 1993. The segment contains photographs pertaining to: arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President Clinton, Hillary Rodham Clinton, and staff for the time period processed. Warren Christopher in the Oval Office, Nelson Mandela greeting staff and interns in the West Lobby and on the North Grounds, President Clinton taping his radio address in the Roosevelt Room, and President Clinton greeting radio address guests in the Oval Office Photographs from July 3, 1993 are as follows: President Clinton jogging at Potomac Park in Washington, DC, and President Clinton golfing with Webb Hubbell and Thomas Friedman at ArmyNavy Country Club in Virginia.
