Approximately 3,436 photographs in color and black & white film processed from 35mm negatives.

## **Summary**

The photographs processed in this segment 6 were created from January 18, 1993; January 20, 1993 through January 21, 1993. The segment contains photographs pertaining to: arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President Clinton, Hillary Rodham Clinton, and staff for the time period processed. The majority of the photograph content for this segment includes photographs of the Inauguration ceremony, parade, balls, and the White House Open House.

## **Scope and Content Note**

FOIA 2006-1135-F is a request for all Clinton administration White House photographs taken in 1993. The photographs processed in this segment 6 were created from January 18, 1993; January 20, 1993 through January 21, 1993. The segment contains photographs pertaining to: arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President Clinton, Hillary Rodham Clinton, and staff for the time period processed. The majority of the photograph content for this segment includes photographs of the Inauguration ceremony, parade, balls, and the White House Open House. Photographs prior to January 20, 1993 consist of Pre-Inaugural activities which are considered non-record and closed as Personal Record Misfile (PRM). Photographs from January 20, 1993 are as follows: President-Elect Clinton participating in the swearing-in ceremony for President of the U.S. President Clinton delivering his Inaugural Address at the U.S. Capitol The Clintons attending the Inaugural Luncheon at the U.S. Capitol The Clintons departing the Capitol and beginning the Inaugural Parade route back to the White House The Clintons arriving at the reviewing stand at the Inaugural Parade on

Pennsylvania Ave. The Clintons posing for a formal photograph in the Residence before departing the White House for the Inaugural Balls The Clintons attending Inaugural Balls around Washington, D.C. Further description for events above are described below: The inaugural ceremony at the U.S. Capitol includes the traditional swearing-in of the oath of office for the President and the Vice-President, President Clinton's Inaugural address, and the Inaugural luncheon with Congress in Statuary Hall at the Capitol. Notable guests and performers at the Inaugural ceremony: President George H.W. Bush, former President Jimmy Carter, Maya Angelou, Rev. Billy Graham, and Marilyn Horne. (Photographs include overall views of the U.S. Capitol and Inaugural ceremony, and black and white photos and panoramic views.) Photograph contact sheets for this segment include coverage of the Inaugural parade that follows the Inaugural Ceremony at the Capitol. The Clintons ride from the Capitol in the presidential limousine. During the ride, the Clintons decide to walk down Pennsylvania Ave. to the parade reviewing stand. The Clintons and the Gores greet family and friends and watch the parade entertainment from the reviewing stand. (Photographs include views of the inaugural floats and marching bands.) This segment includes photographs of the traditional Inaugural balls in Washington D.C. Hillary Rodham Clinton poses for formal portrait photos of her Inaugural gown in the residence. The Clintons make the rounds to the various states' balls. The Clintons dance and President Clinton plays the saxophone with the various bands at the balls. The Clintons greet various guests at the balls, including: Nelson Mandela, Harry Thomason, Barbara Streisand, and David Dinkins. Photographs for January 21, 1993 are as follows: President Clinton, Hillary Rodham Clinton, VP Gore and Tipper Gore greeting the public at the White House Open House event in the Diplomatic Reception Room Photographs for January 21, 1993 Continued... The Clintons and Gores standing on the South Portico stairs and addressing the line of visitors awaiting entry into the White House The Clintons and Gores greeting guests from Arkansas at the White House George Stephanopoulos briefing the press in the Press Briefing Room.
